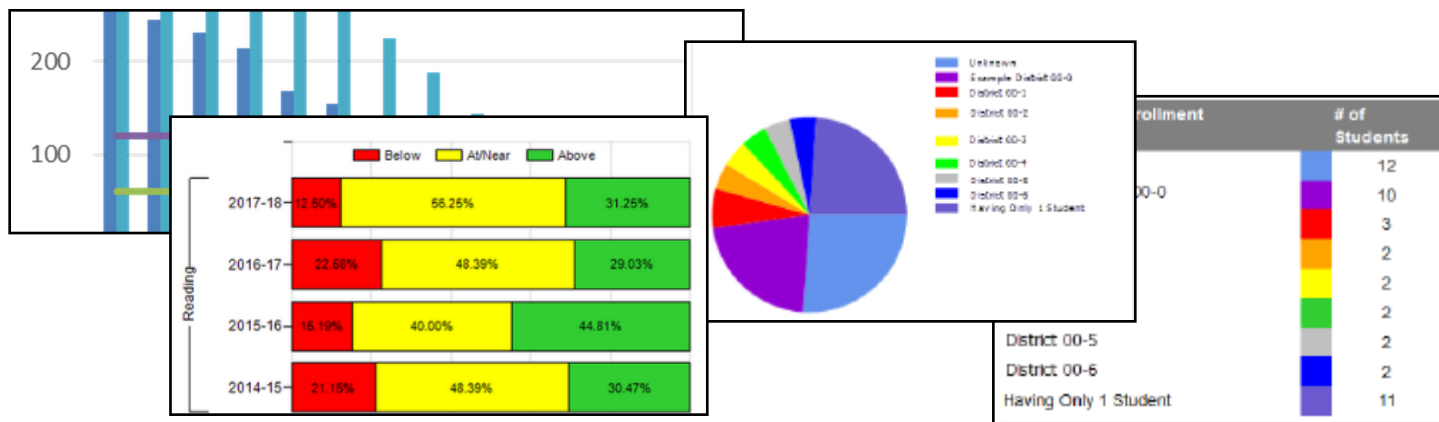


EDFN 592: The Fundamentals of Using Data for Educators
