


The following training will provide a brief overview for the 1600-series of the Administrative Review, also known as the School Breakfast and Summer Food Service Program Outreach Module.



About the School Breakfast Program Outreach and Summer Food Service Program outreach:

SFAs are required to inform households of the availability of the School Breakfast Program (if applicable), and the Summer Food Service Program availability, regardless of program participation.

Also, State Agency reviewers will observe documentation demonstrating outreach and program availability



The first question, Question 1600, asks: How did the SFA inform households of the availability of the School Breakfast Program prior to (or at the beginning) of the school year and provide reminders about the availability of the SBP throughout the year?

Some examples of notification of breakfast availability may include: handouts/bulletins sent home, menus, website, etc.




If you do not provide a reimbursable breakfast program, please mark 'Not applicable', and provide 'N/A' in the comments



Next is Question 1601: How did the SFA inform eligible households about the availability and location of free meals for students via the Summer Food Service Program?

Examples of notification of summer meal availability may include: handouts/bulletins sent home, menus, website, etc.



SFAs are required to conduct SFASP outreach (such as providing notice of the USDA Summer Meals webpage) before the end of the school year to ensure families are informed of the availability and location of SFSP meals. This is required for all SFAs – including those which do not operate a Summer Feeding program
