

CTE Instructor Permit	
ARSD 24:28:09	
Description	 Allows individuals without a teaching degree to teach a limited number of CTE courses. Not considered an alternative route to certification and upon completion of requirements, applicants cannot add any endorsements other than the ones available through this permit. Applicants wanting to receive a full teaching certificate and teach in the area of CTE are encouraged to pursue CTE Alternative Certification.
Duration of Certificate	• 5 years
Applicant Eligibility Requirements	 Completion of an approved suicide awareness and prevention training Associate of applied science degree or higher in a related CTE field OR Hold a minimum of a high school diploma or equivalent and 4,000 hours of work experience in a related CTE field OR National certification in a related CTE field
Fee	• \$25
District Requirements	 Provide mentor teacher to applicant Develop program to assist CTE instructor with academic and classroom support Provide assurance of regular observation, guidance, and evaluation During each renewal, must submit form to South Dakota Department of Education recommending applicant based on performance and progress
Endorsements	 Allows CTE instructor to teach in CTE fields limited to the following endorsement areas: CTE career pathway Education and training career cluster Law, public safety, corrections and security career cluster
Permit Requirements	 Within 3 years of receiving certificate, CTE instructor must complete courses from a regionally-accredited institution of higher education with a grade of C or higher in: 4-credit mentored internship experience 2-credit methods of CTE
Renewal Requirements	 3 continuing education credits (45 clock hours of training) \$25 for 5-year renewal certificate Complete an approved <u>suicide awareness and prevention training</u>
