

Replacing the Elementary and Secondary Education Act Purpose: (ESEA) that was enacted originally in 1965, NCLB is a reform-based law that seeks to close entirely the achievement gap between disadvantaged and minority students and their peers and to increase academic achievement among all students. The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) redesigned the Elementary and Secondary Act (ESEA) programs to emphasize four pillars of reform. 1. Accountability for results 2. Doing what works based on scientific research 3. Local control and flexibility 4. 

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
