Purpose:

The NCLB Act, signed into law by President Bush on January 8, 2002, requires that all children have a fair, equal, and significant opportunity to obtain a high-quality education and reach, at a minimum, proficiency on challenging state academic achievement standards and state academic assessments. Replacing the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) that was enacted originally in 1965, NCLB is a reform-based law that seeks to close entirely the achievement gap between disadvantaged and minority students and their peers and to increase academic achievement among all students.

Program

The No Child Left Behind Act of 2001 (NCLB) redesigned the Elementary and Secondary Act (ESEA) programs to emphasize four pillars of reform.

- 1. Accountability for results
- 2. Doing what works based on scientific research
- 3. Local control and flexibility
- 4. Expanded parental choices


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
