

## 2021-2022 Nonpublic School Proportionate Share Allocations for Equitable Services

The following equitable services proportionate share amounts for Title I Part A, Title I Part C, Title II Part A, Title III, Title IV Part A, and Title IV Part B are estimates based on the original FY22 LEA allocations prior to any transfer of funds. Final amounts are determined at the LEA level through the consultation and budget approval process. Note the following considerations when reviewing the set-asides calculated below:

- Amounts were calculated based on Fall 2020 enrollment numbers submitted to the South Dakota Department of Education
- These amounts do not reflect private schools that are not participating in the programs
- Calculations are prior to any LEA transfer of funds in or out of the programs
- The amounts do not reflect any administrative set-asides determined during consultation and the completion of the consolidated application process
