## What is it?

- Students will complete the program by taking an Accuplacer placement assessment. Those who meet SDBOR <u>benchmarks</u> can enroll into credit-bearing coursework at South Dakota public universities.

Who should take it?

- Students who have skill gaps.
- Recommendation: ACT sub scores of 15-19 in math or 13-17 in English or Level 2 on Smarter Balanced for math or English language arts.
