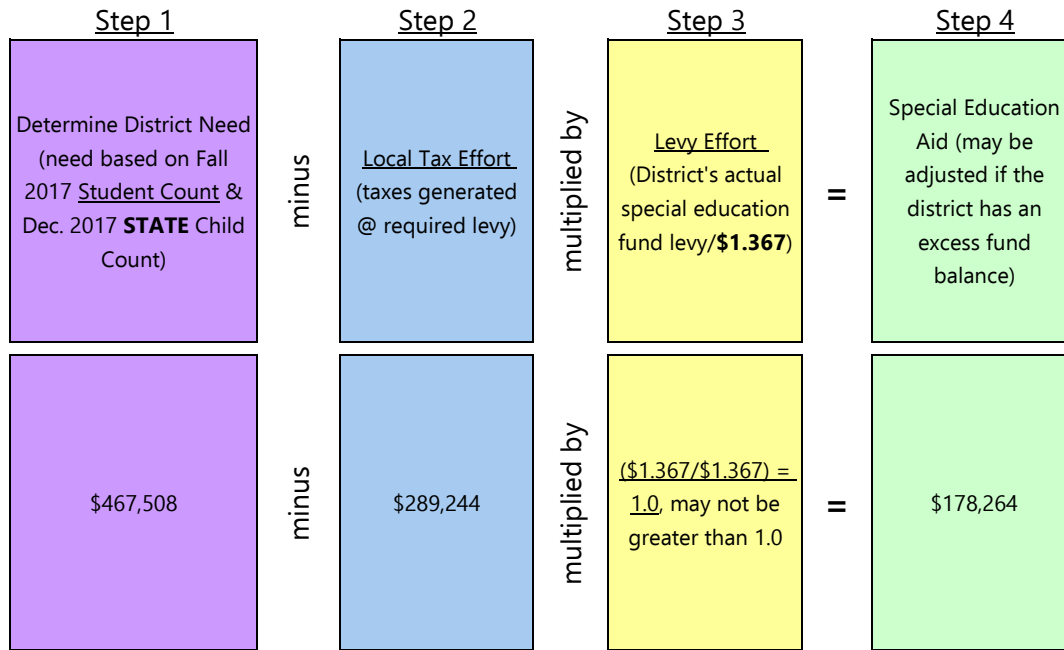


# FY2019 Special Education State Aid:

as of 1/29/2019



Student Count - Public school district's state aid fall enrollment + fall count of home school students + fall count of students in parochial/Christian schools located within the district.

December 2017 STATE Child Count - all MD students must meet the eligibility criteria as outlined in SDCL 13-37-36.2

Local Tax Effort - amount of funds that may be raised by the district if using the required levy (local tax effort would be based on 1/2 of two different calendar years).

Required Levy = \$1.367/per thousand (max levy=\$1.567)

Levy Effort - District's actual SE levy request when compared to required local tax effort (effort factor may not exceed 1.0).

Excess Fund Balance - \$100,000 or 25% of annual expenditures, whichever is greater. A 10% limit is imposed on districts receiving Extraordinary Cost Funds.

Level 1 Disability (10% of student count)	\$5,527
Level 2 Disability (child count)	\$12,756
Level 3 Disability (child count)	\$16,258
Level 4 Disability (child count)	\$15,766
Level 5 Disability (child count)	\$28,161
Level 6 Disability (child count)	\$8,111

Each funding level is rebased triennially. All funding levels will be adjusted based on average actual cost for previous three years. The next rebase year is FY2021, last rebase year was FY2017.

<u>Level 1</u> = Mild Disability (count is calculated by determining 10% of Student Count identified above)
<u>Level 2</u> = Cognitive Disability, Emotionally Disturbed
<u>Level 3</u> = Hearing Loss, Deafness, Vision Loss, Deaf-Blind, Orthopedic Impairment, Traumatic Brain Injury
<u>Level 4</u> = Autism
<u>Level 5</u> = Multiple Disability (must include 2 or more disabilities in levels 2, 3 or 4, not including Deaf-Blind)
<u>Level 6</u> = Prolonged Assistance
