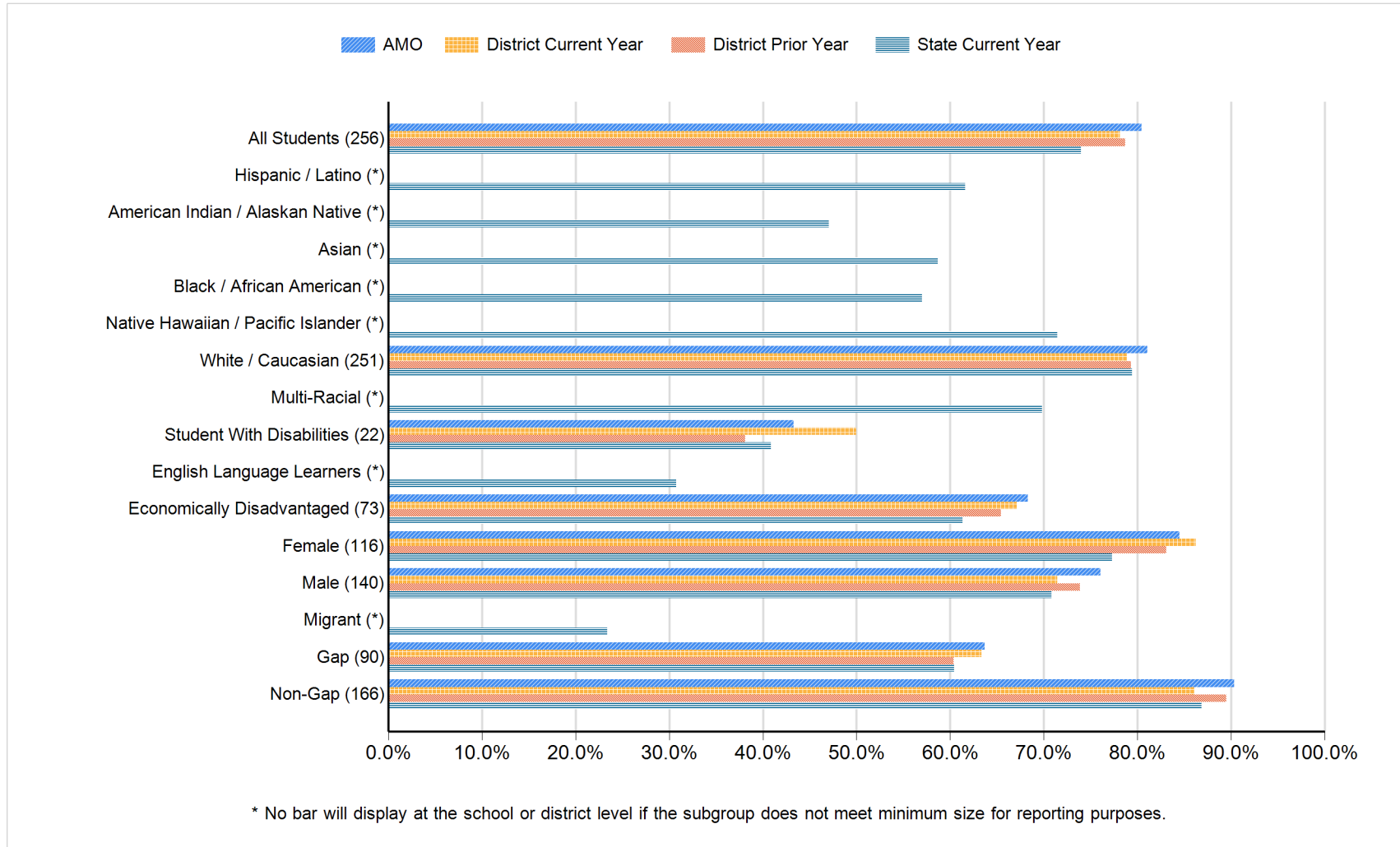

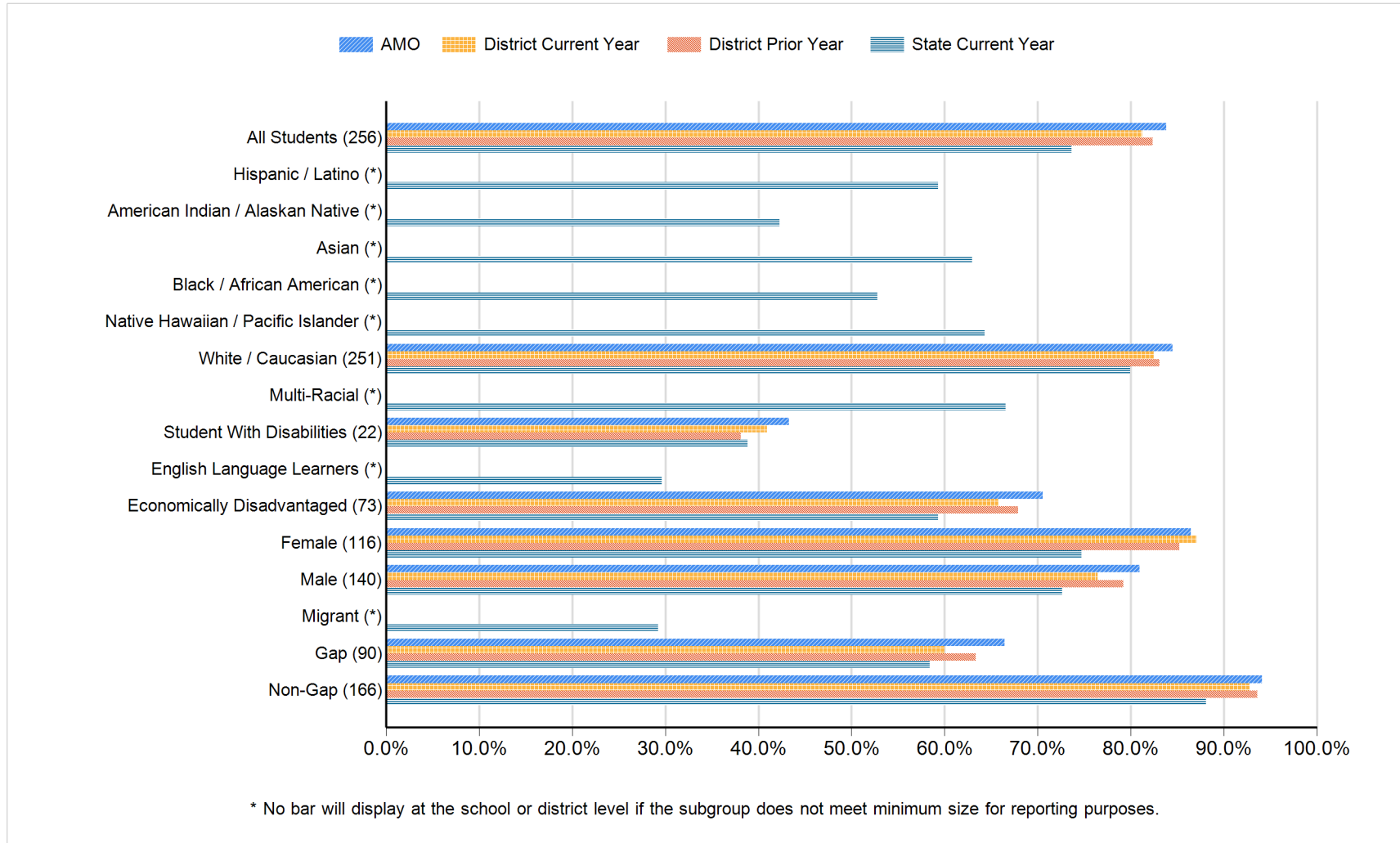

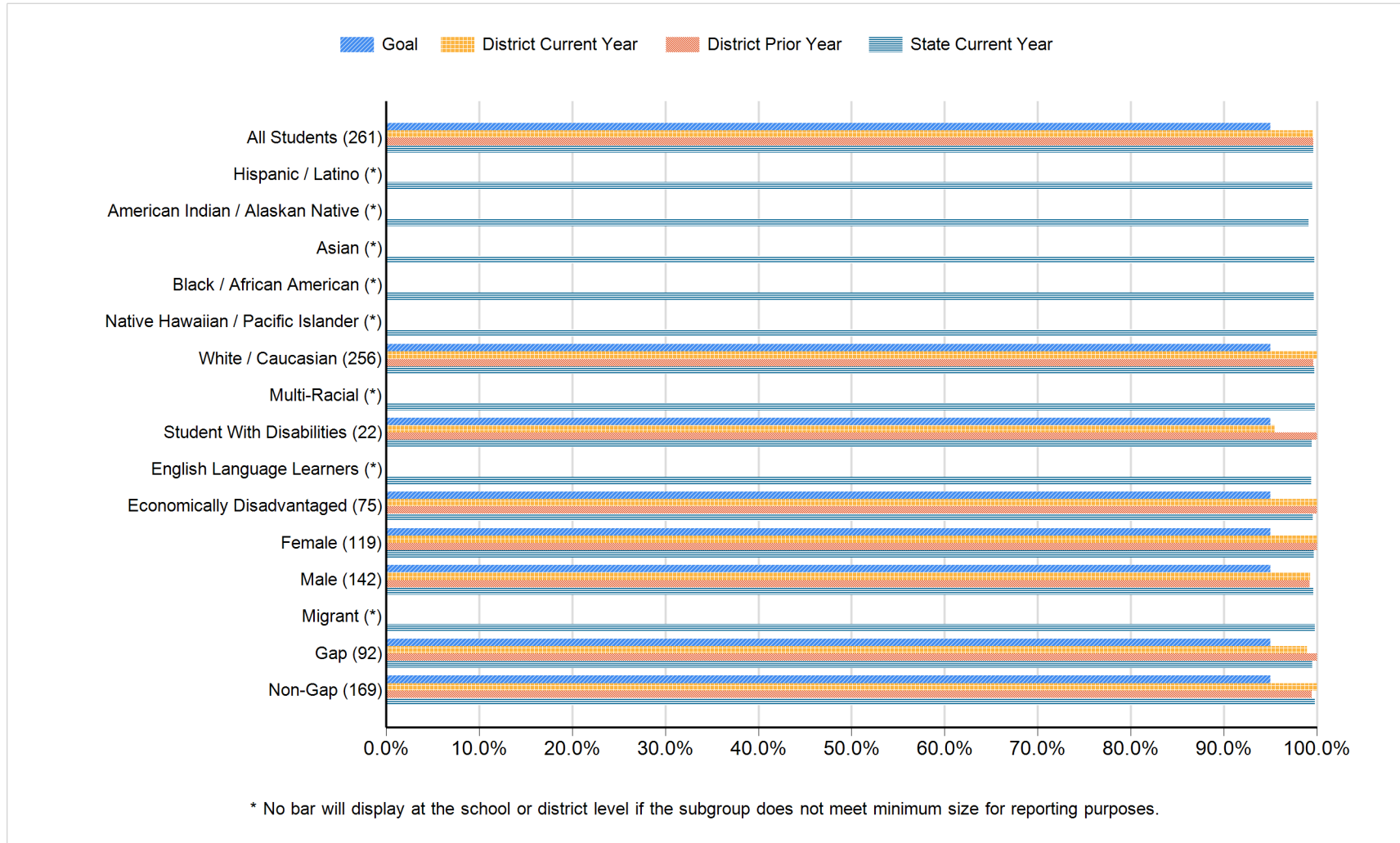

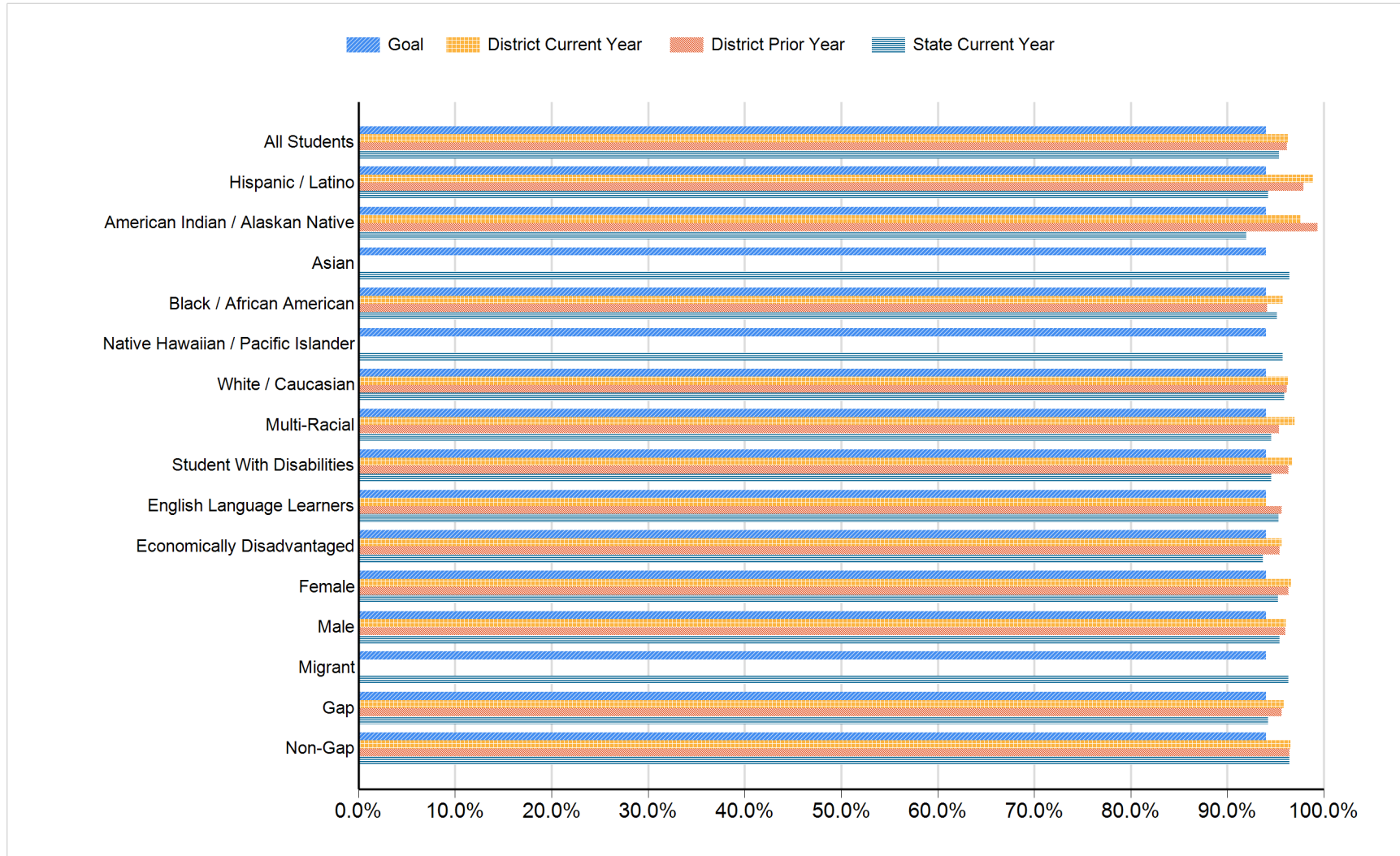

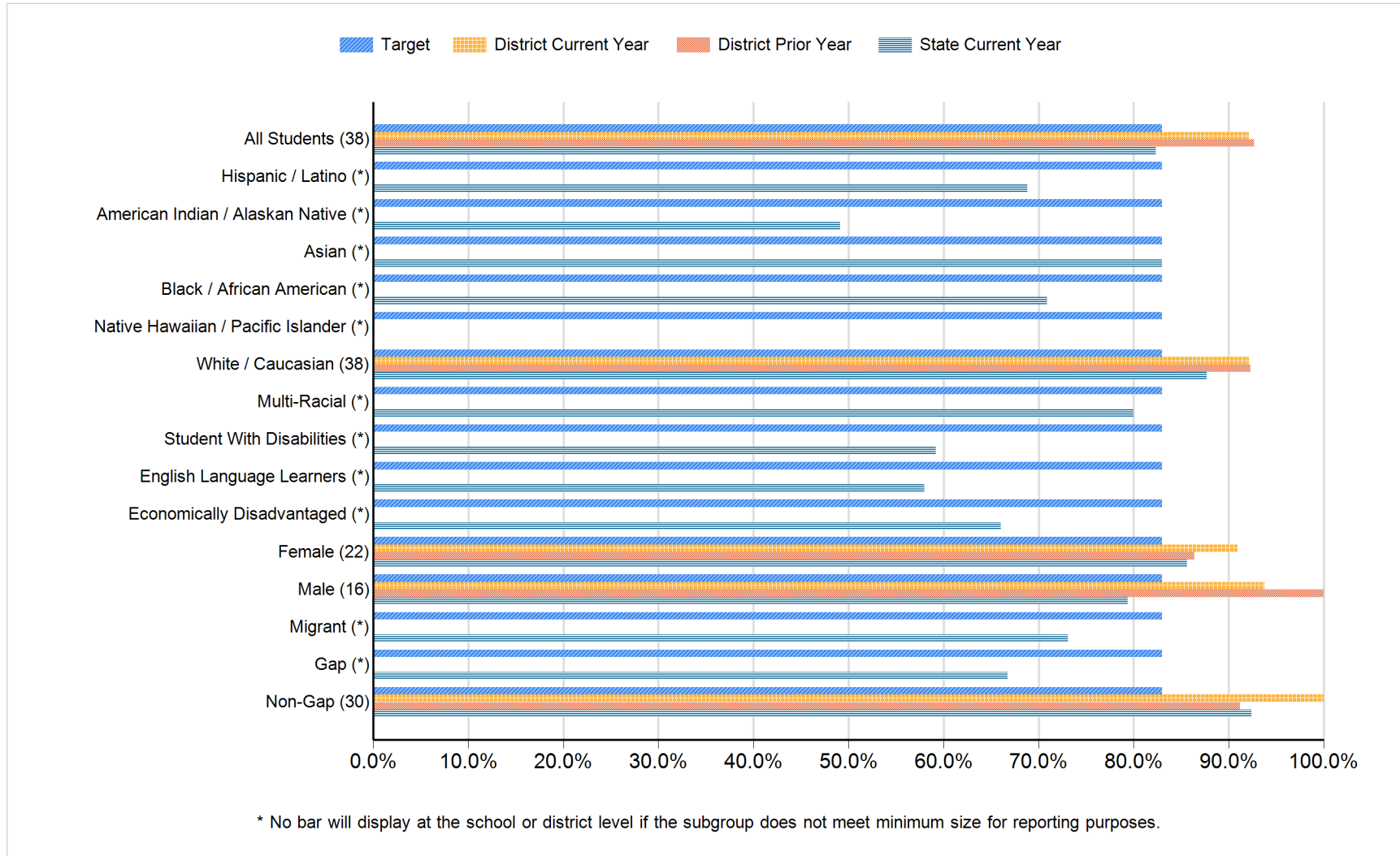

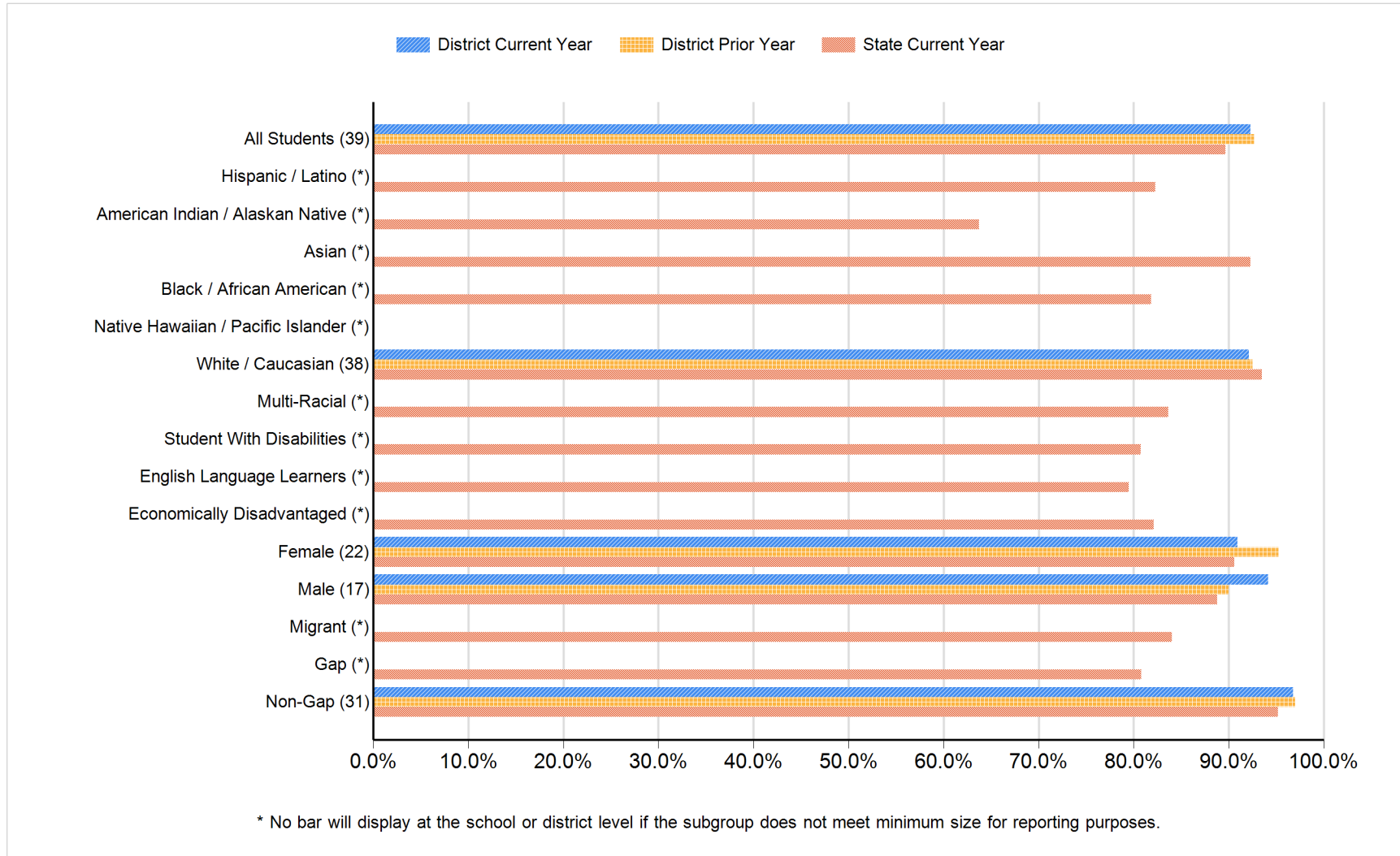

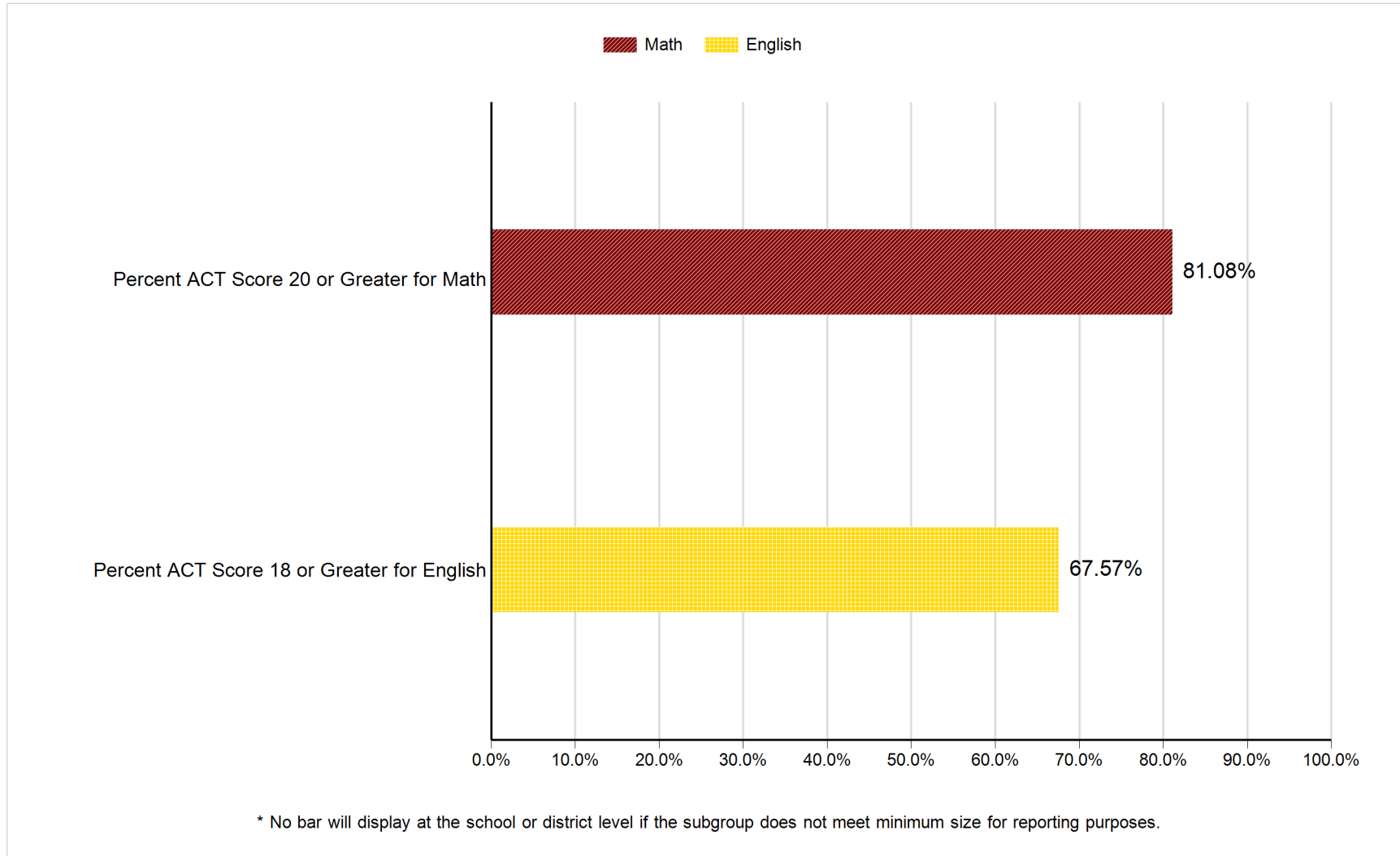

South Dakota Results for NAEP 2011

The National Assessment of Educational Progress (NAEP) or the "Nation's Report Card" is administered on a biannual basis to a sample of 4th and 8th graders in every state. The most recent NAEP data available are for the 2011 administration. Each student takes a portion of a reading or mathematics assessment. The NAEP results are reported for the state as well as the nation and there are no published school or district results.

For some small subgroups in South Dakota the reporting requirement is not met and therefore no data are available. Therefore, race/ethnicity and Limited English Proficiency data are not consistent across all the reports. .

NAEP achievement levels are not necessarily equivalent to proficiency levels used with South Dakota's state assessment, DSTEP. For more information on the mathematics and reading achievement levels go to:

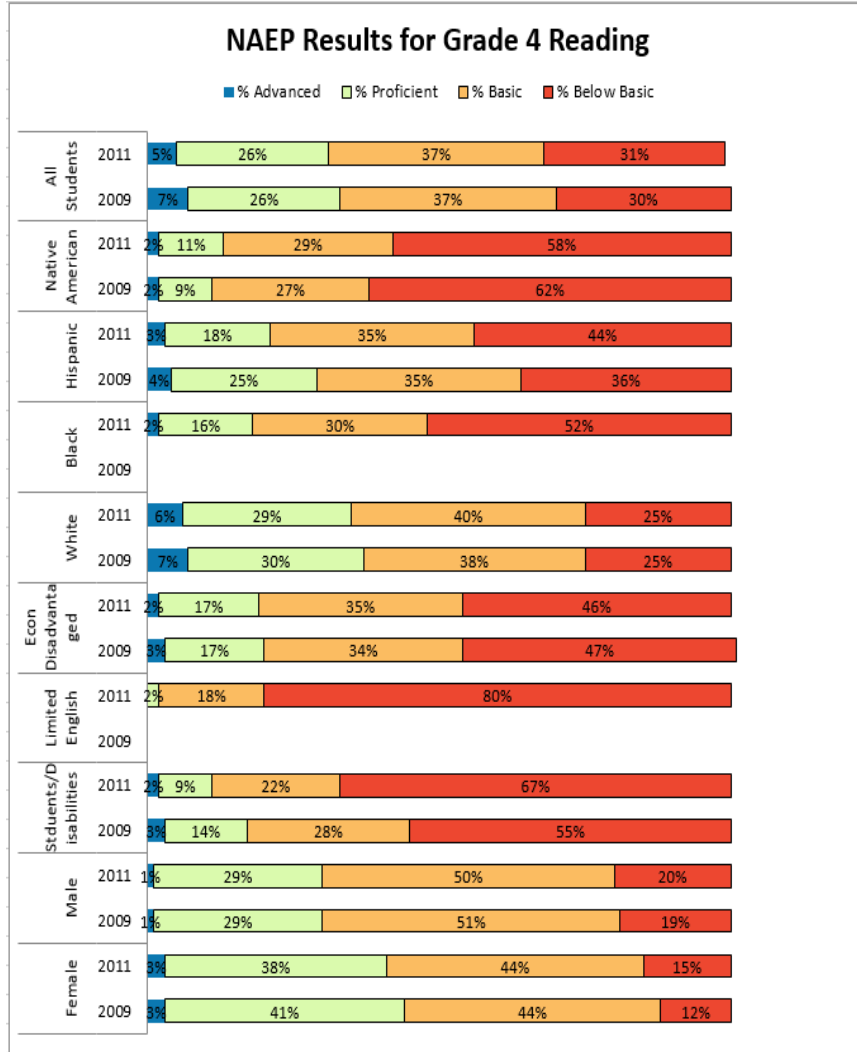
