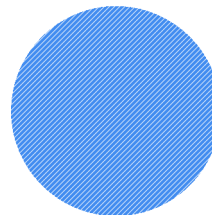

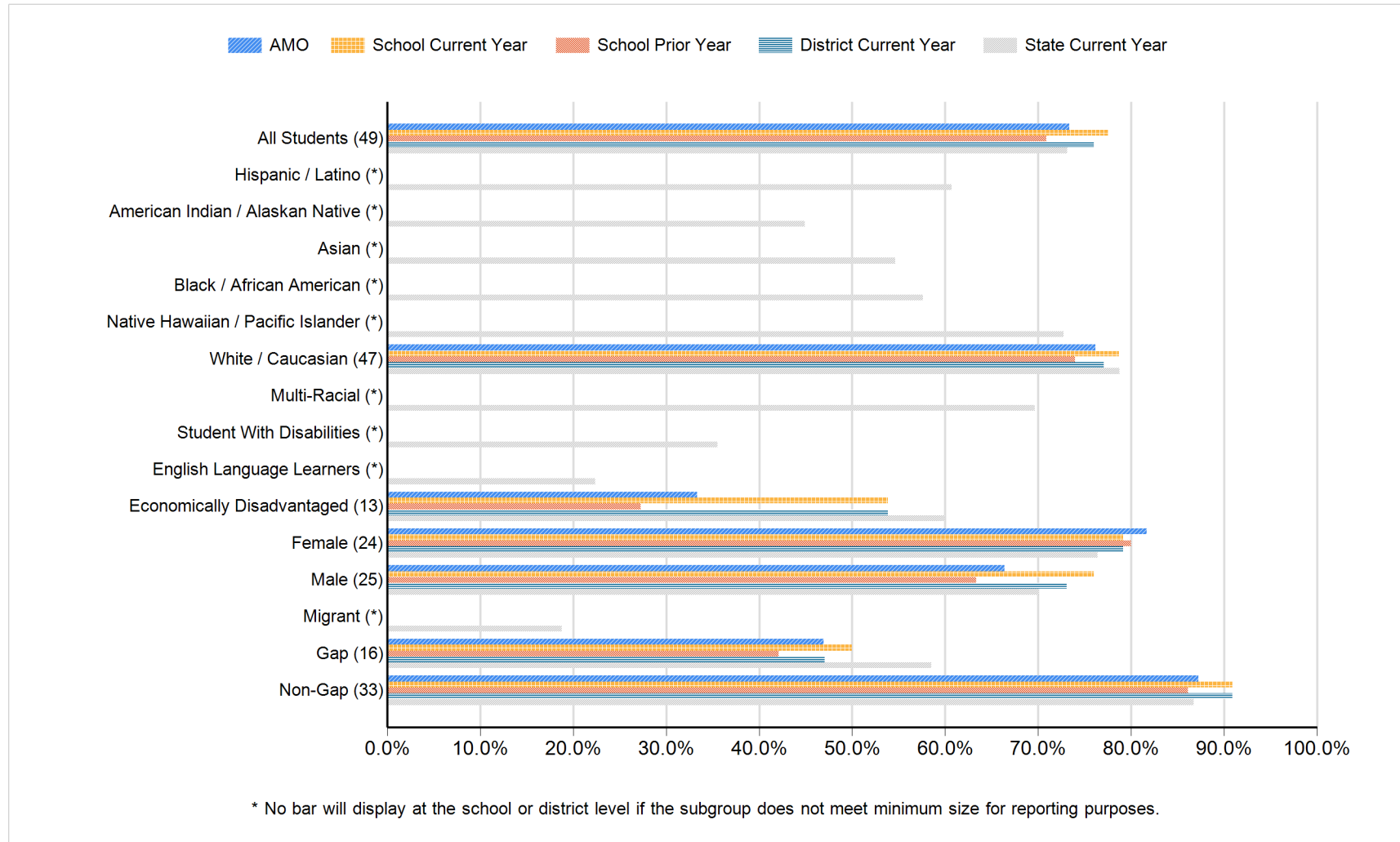
Student Population

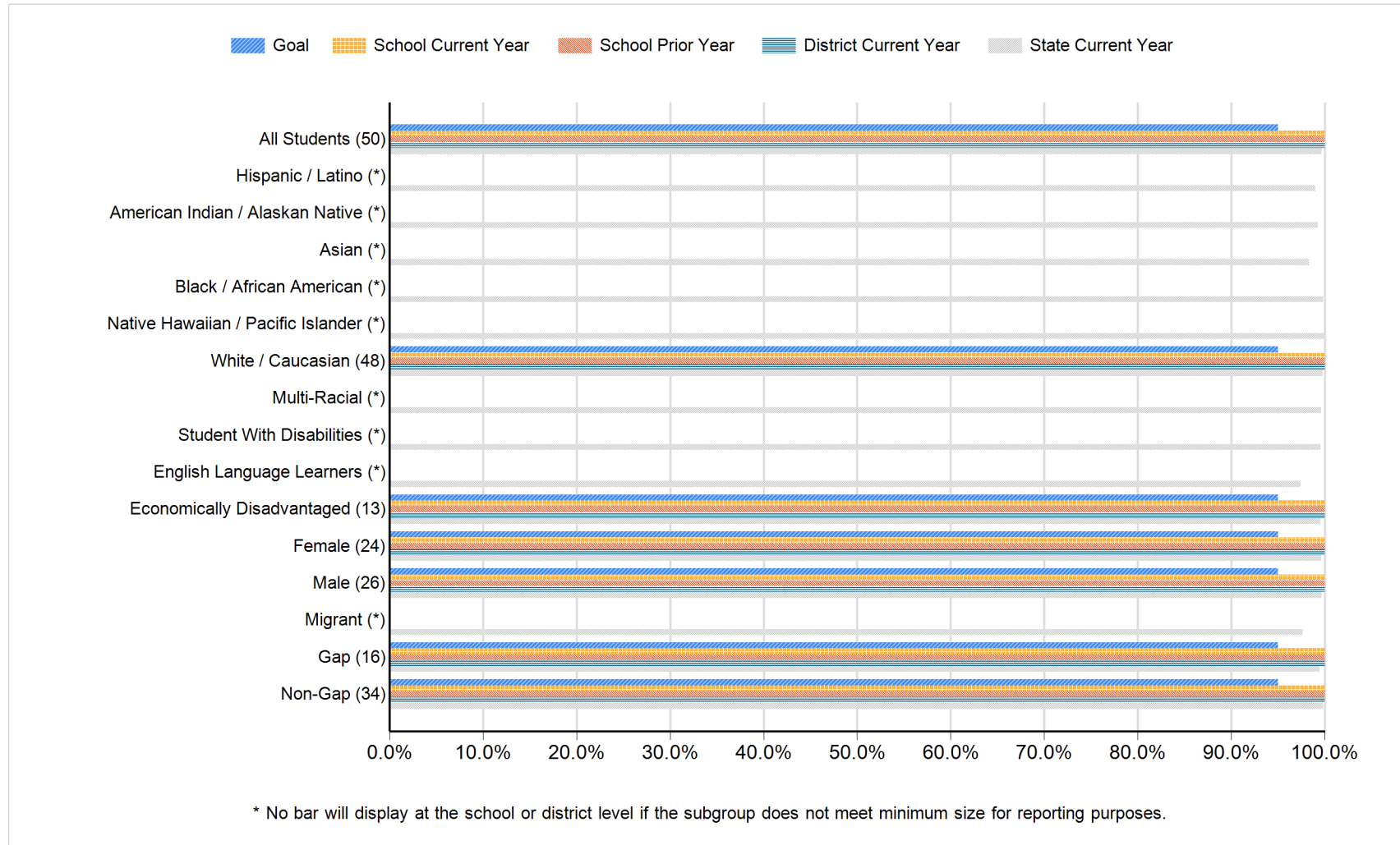

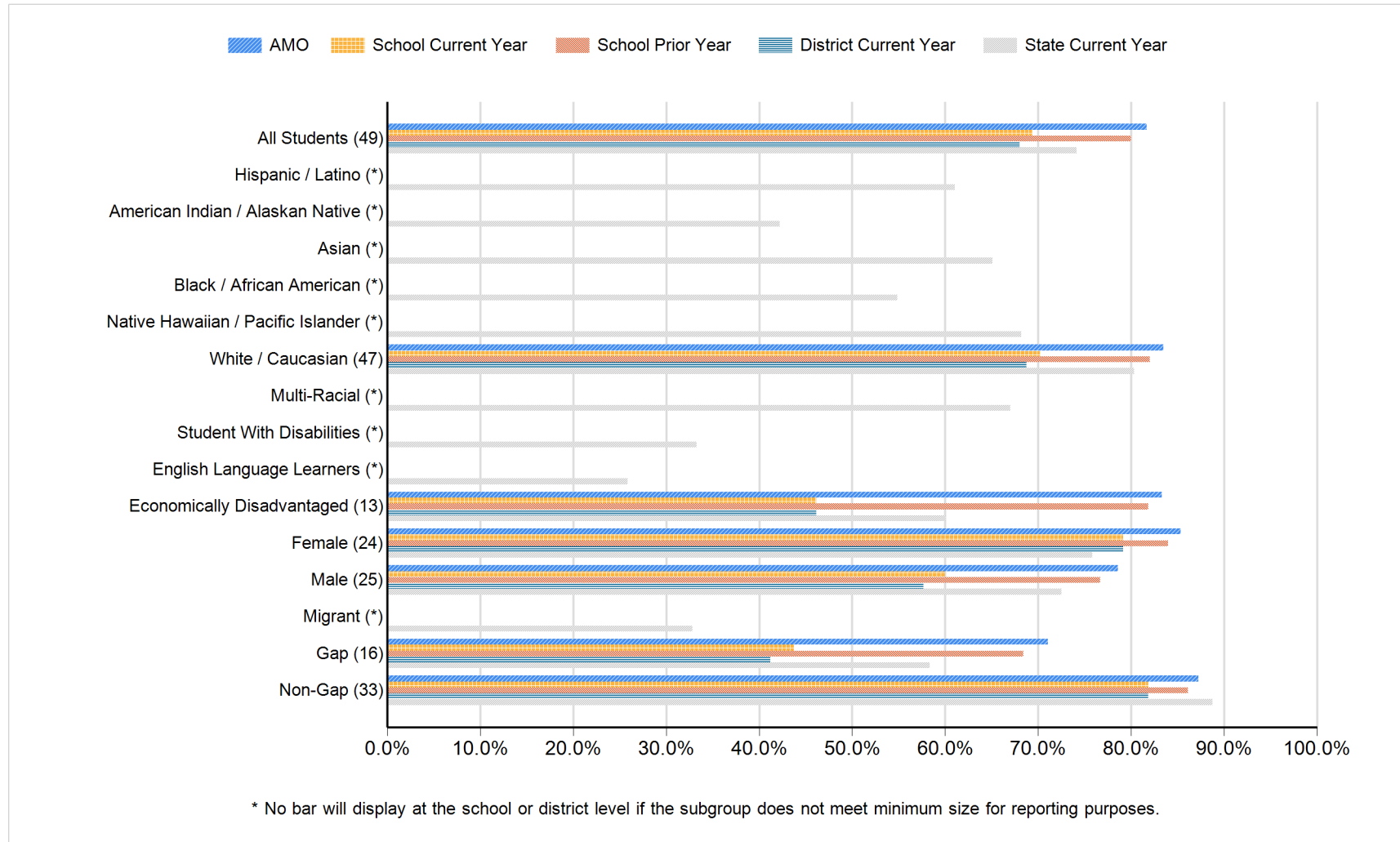

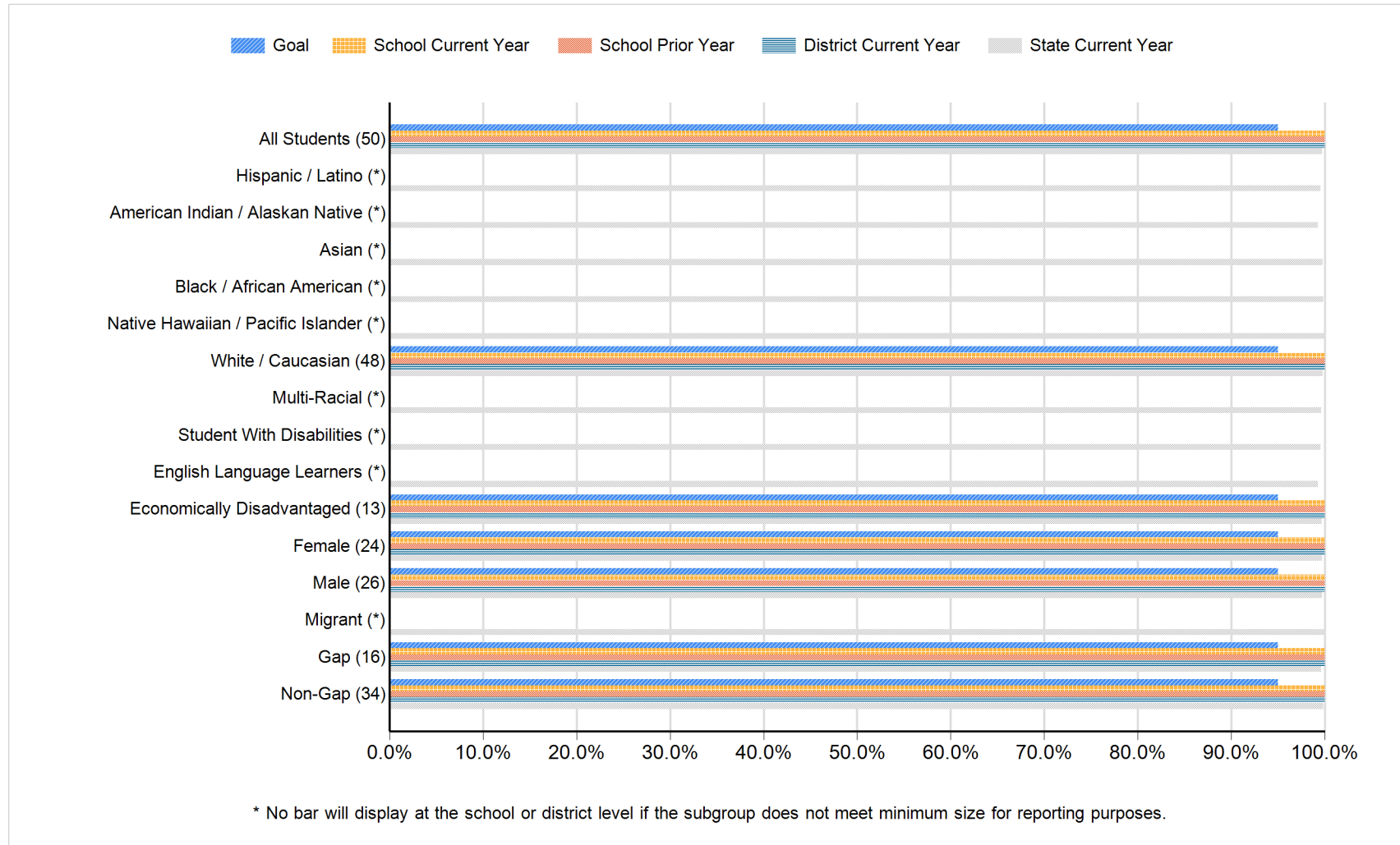

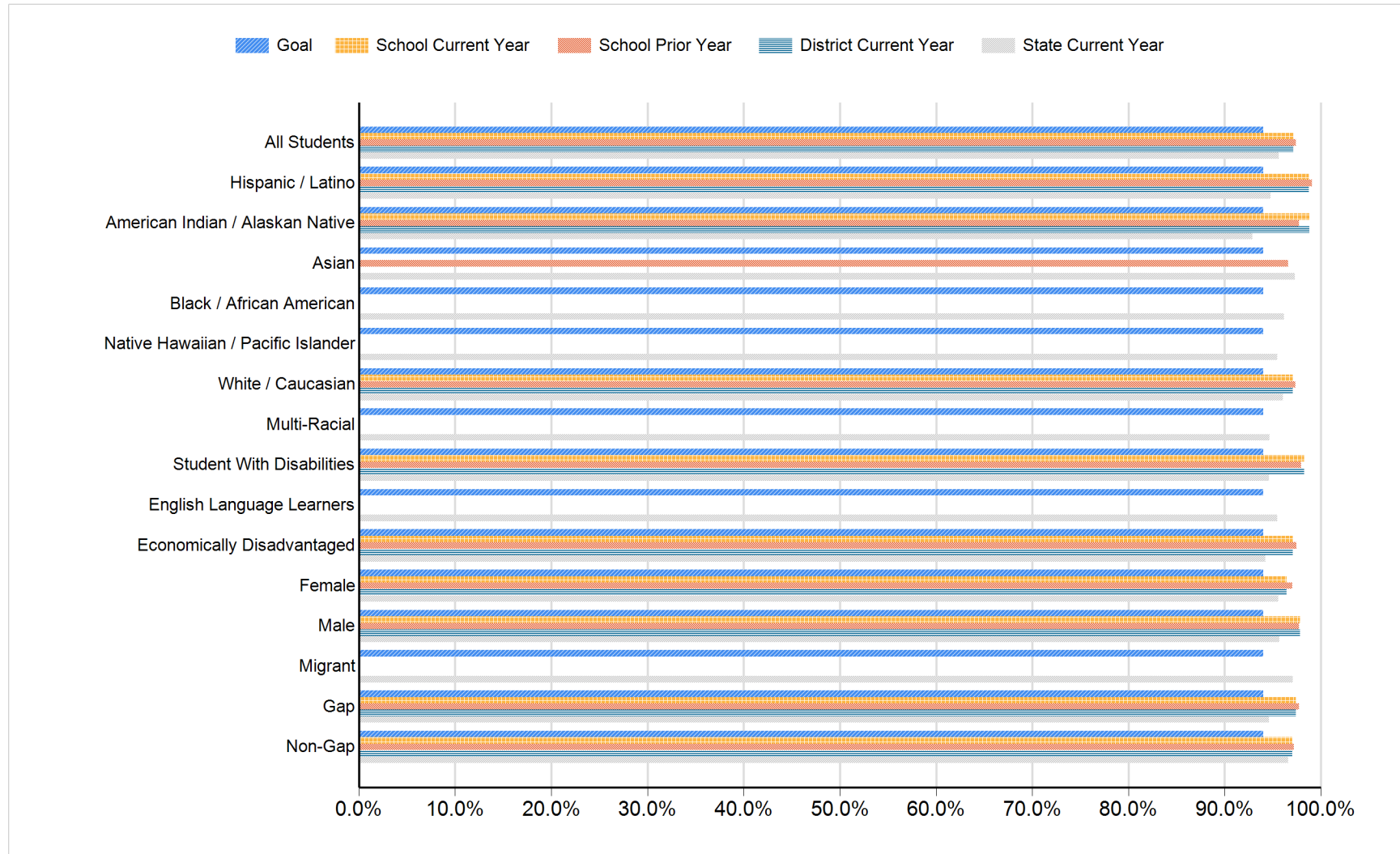
