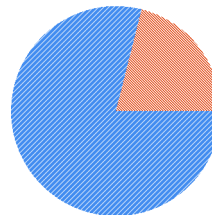

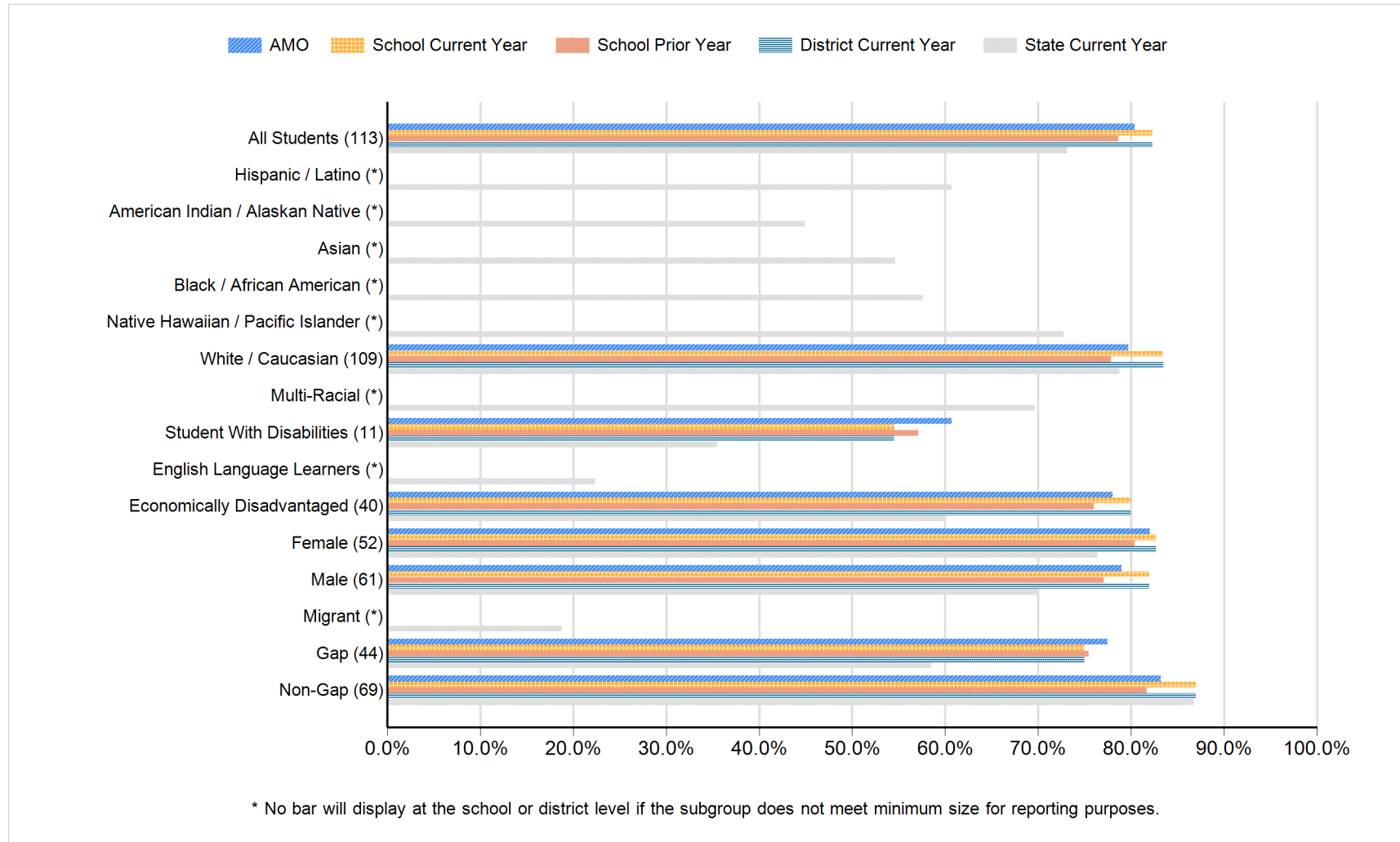
Student Population

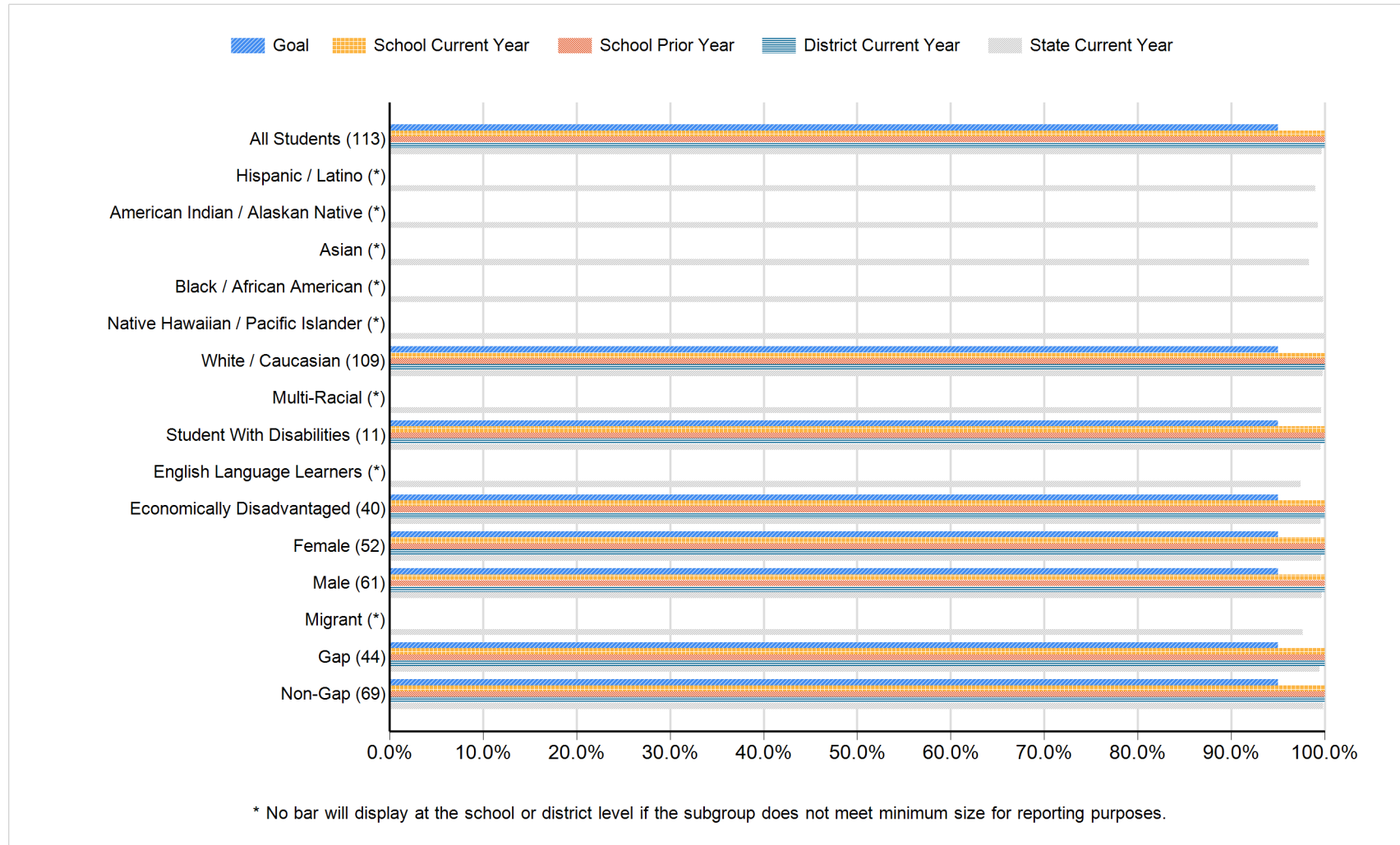

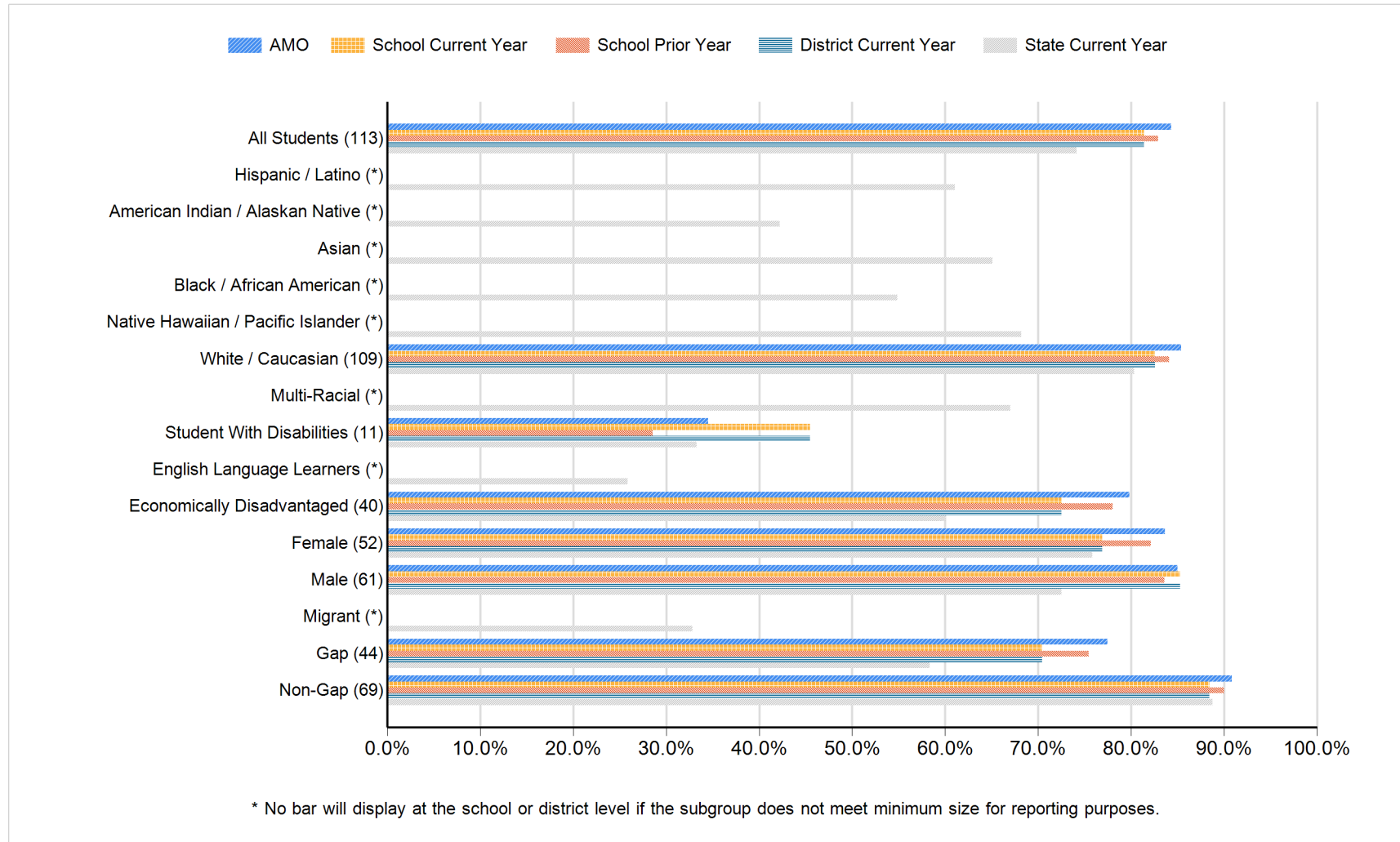

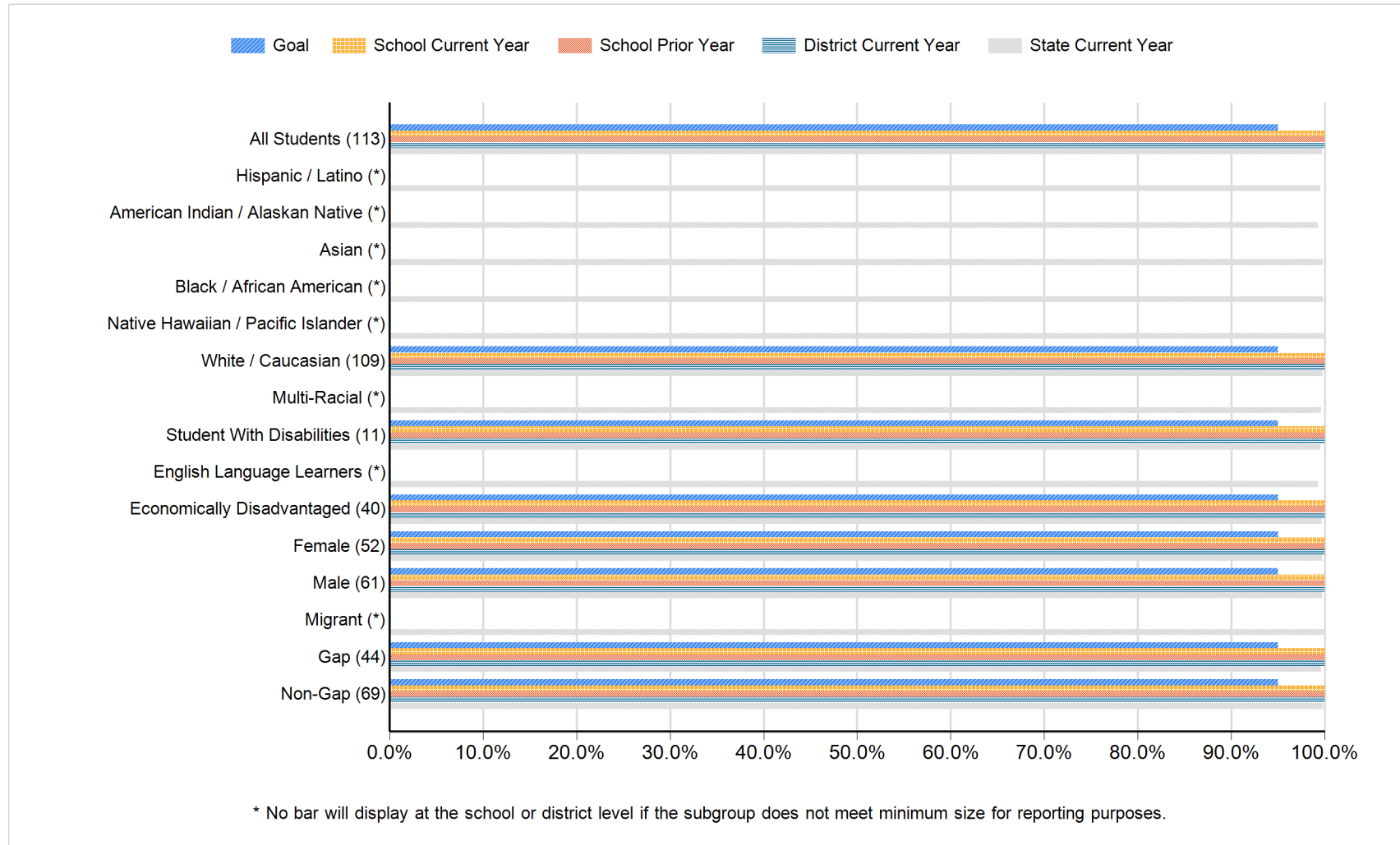

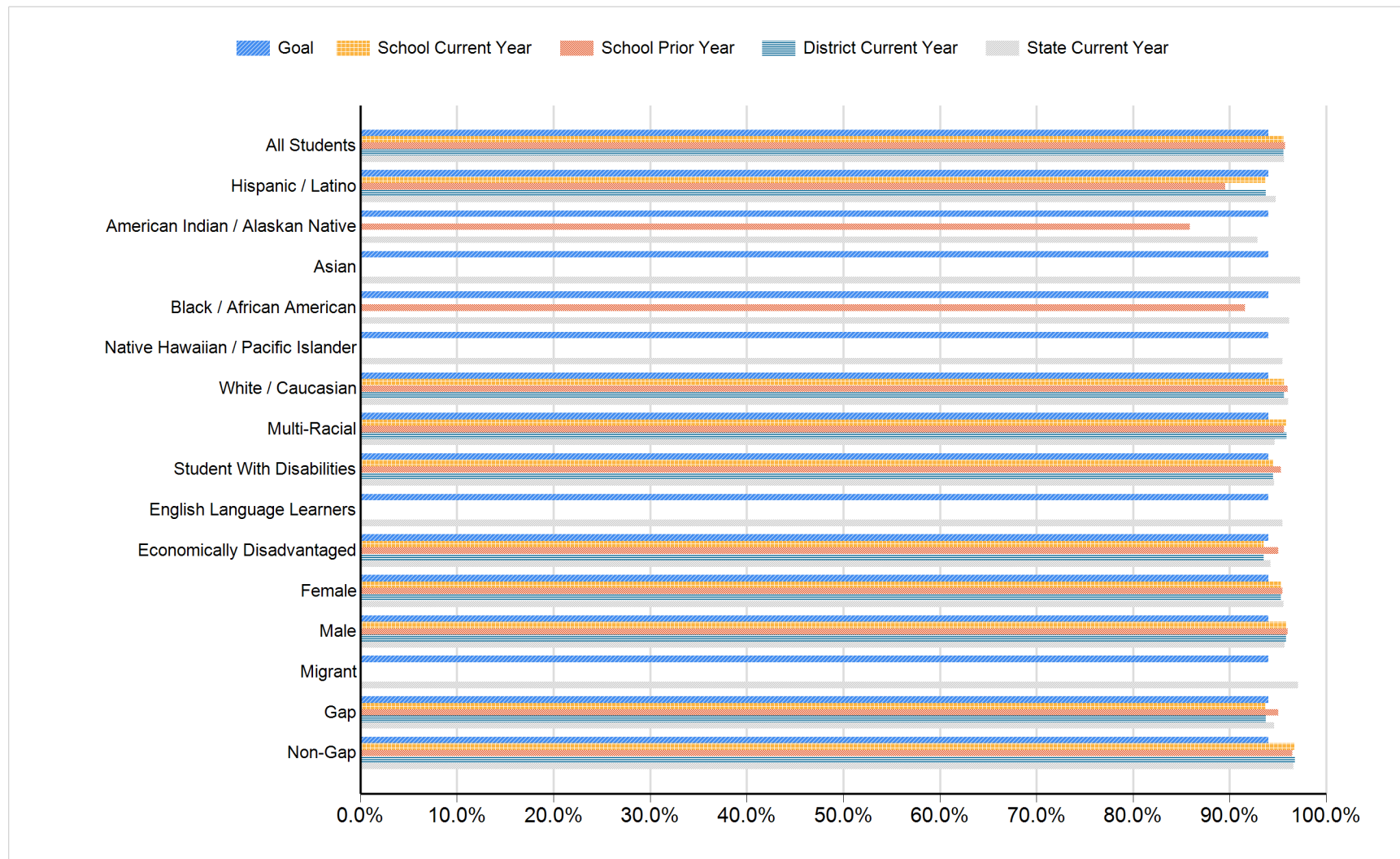
