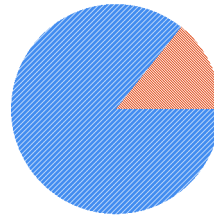

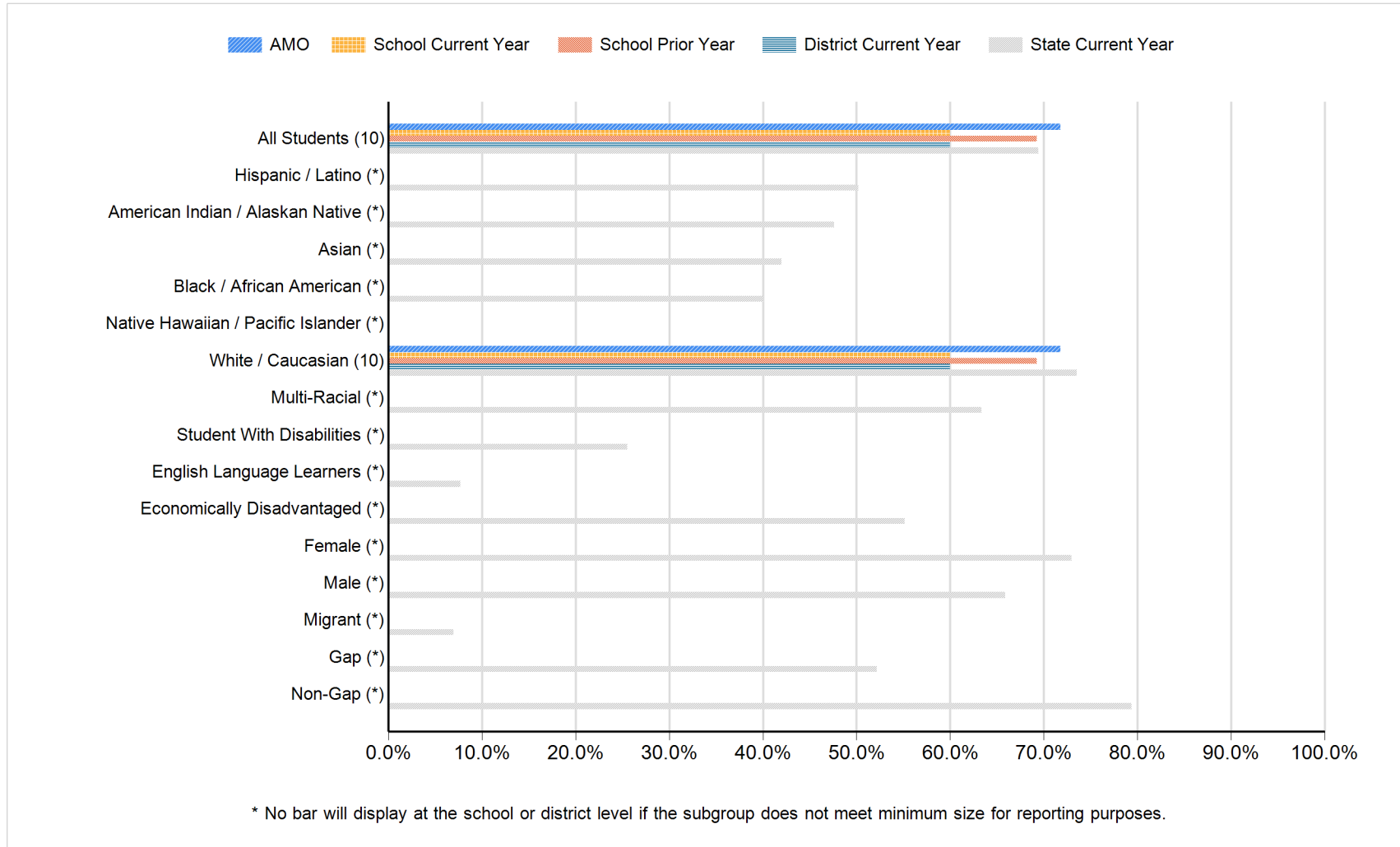
Student Population

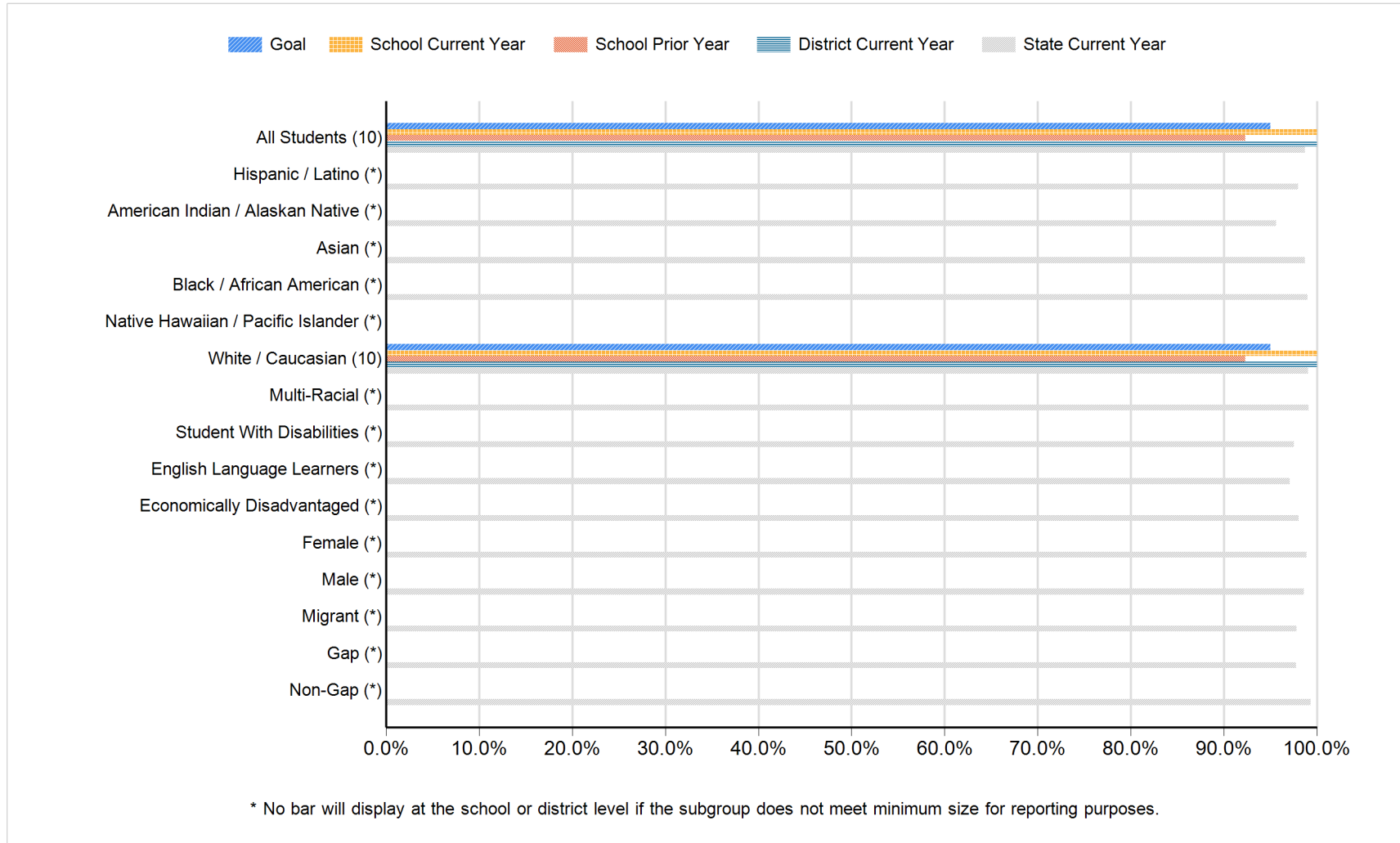

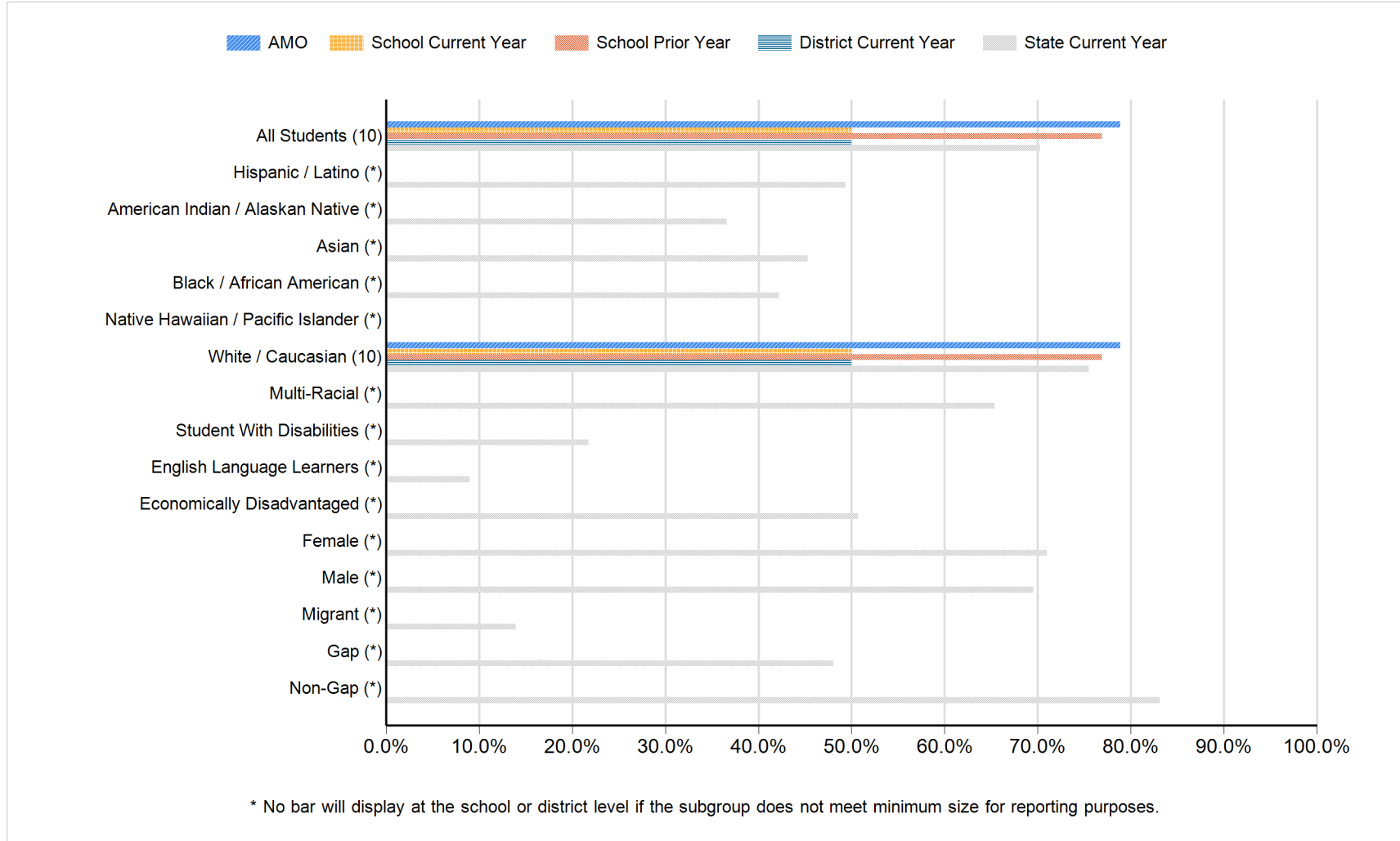

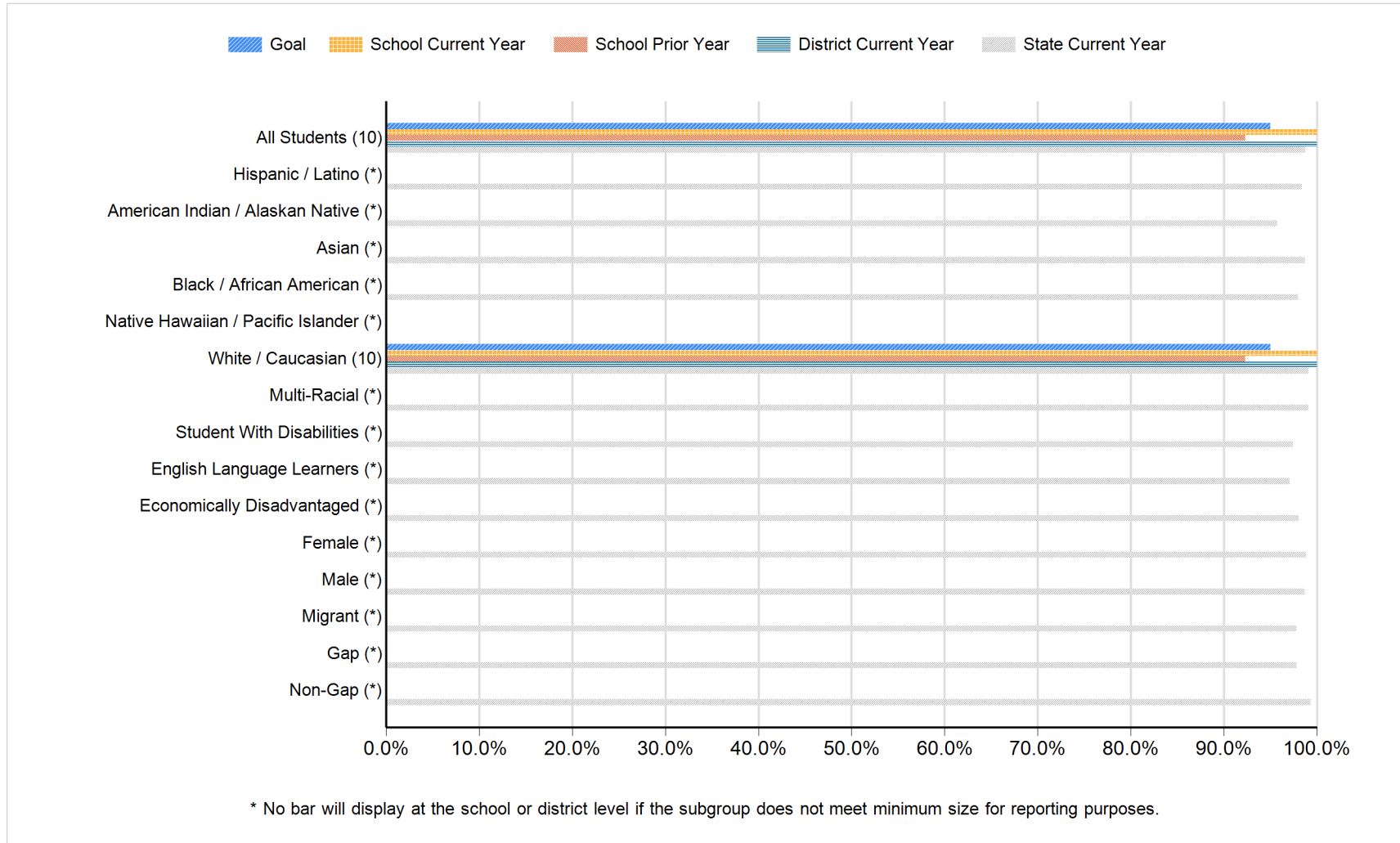

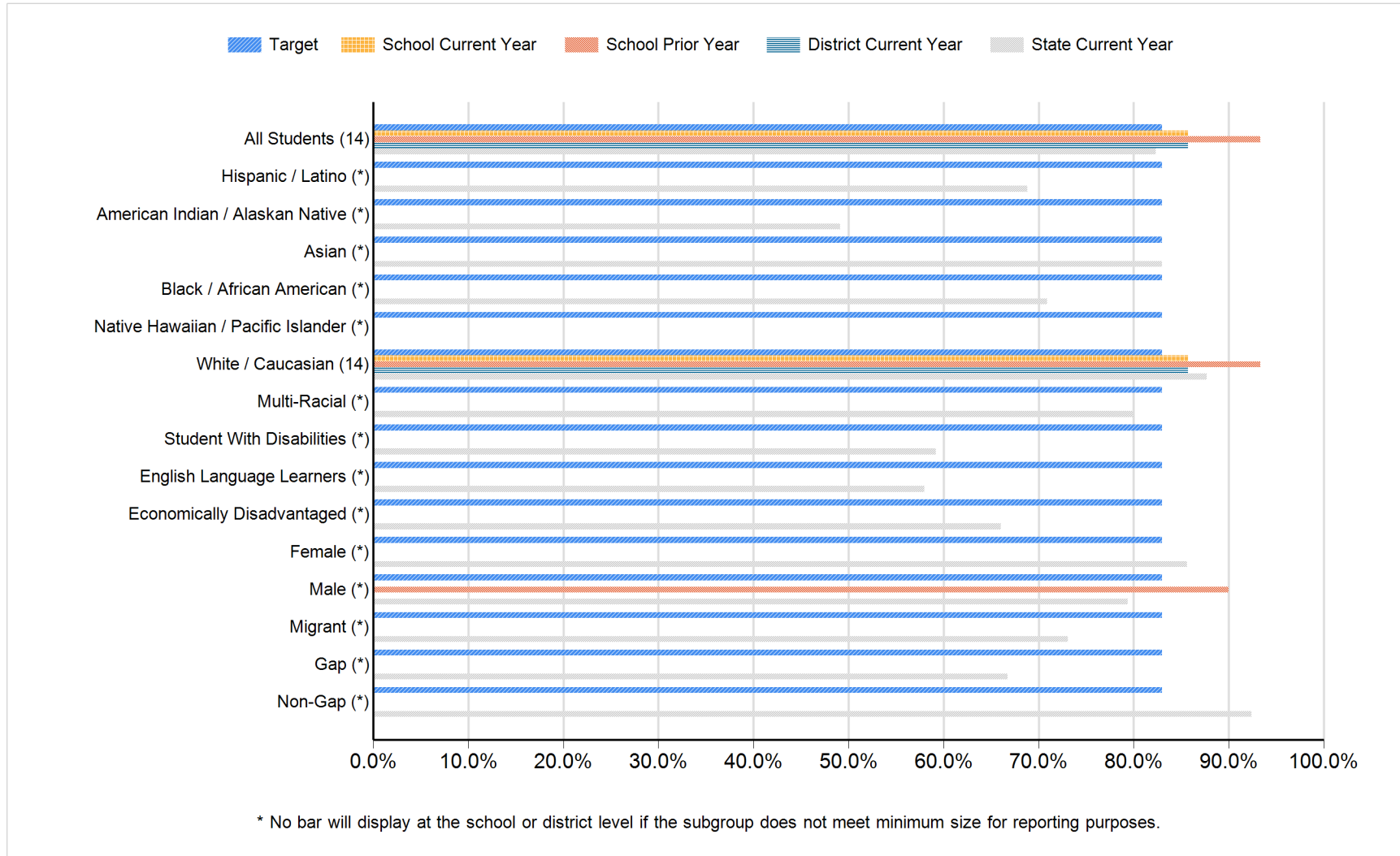

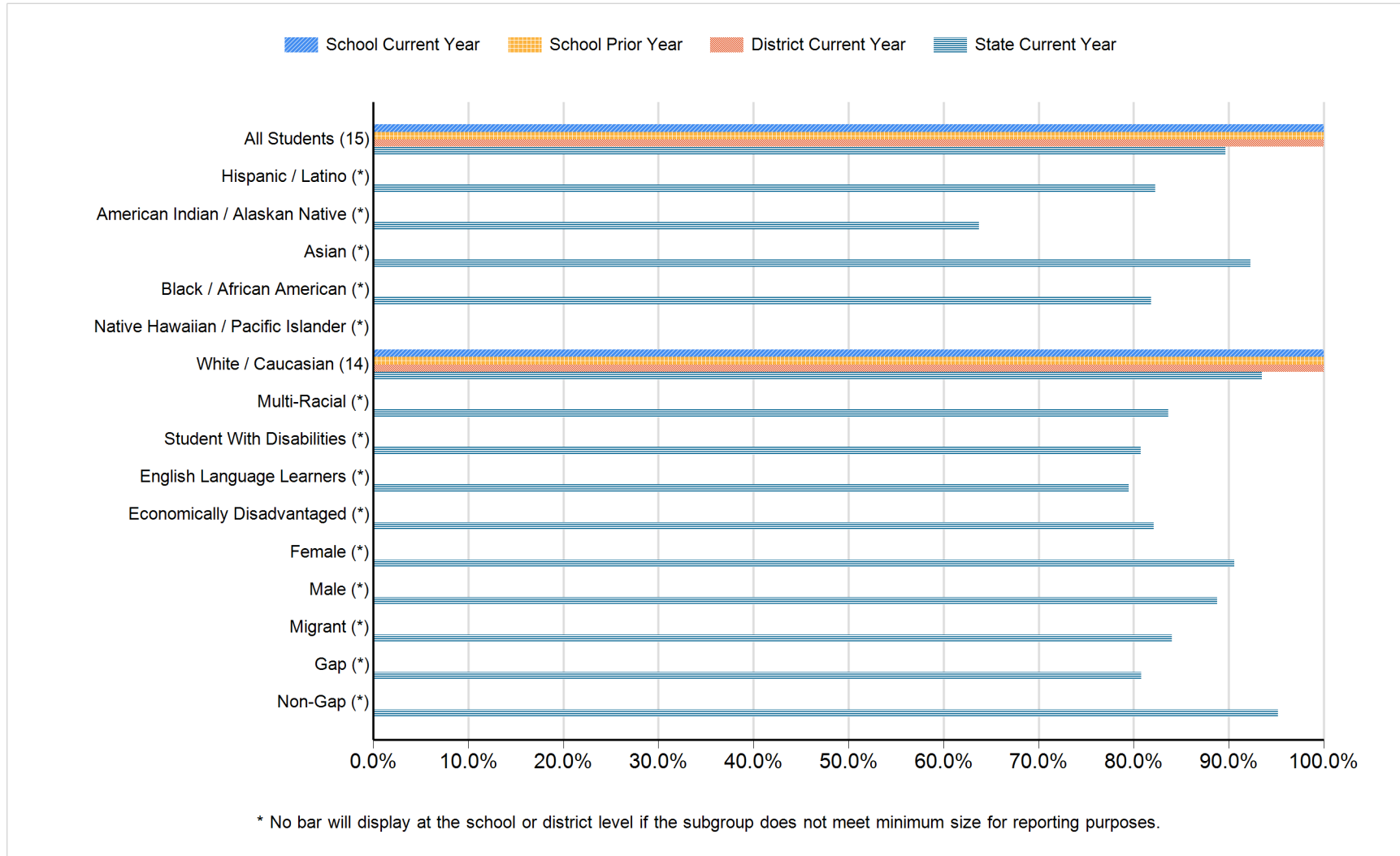

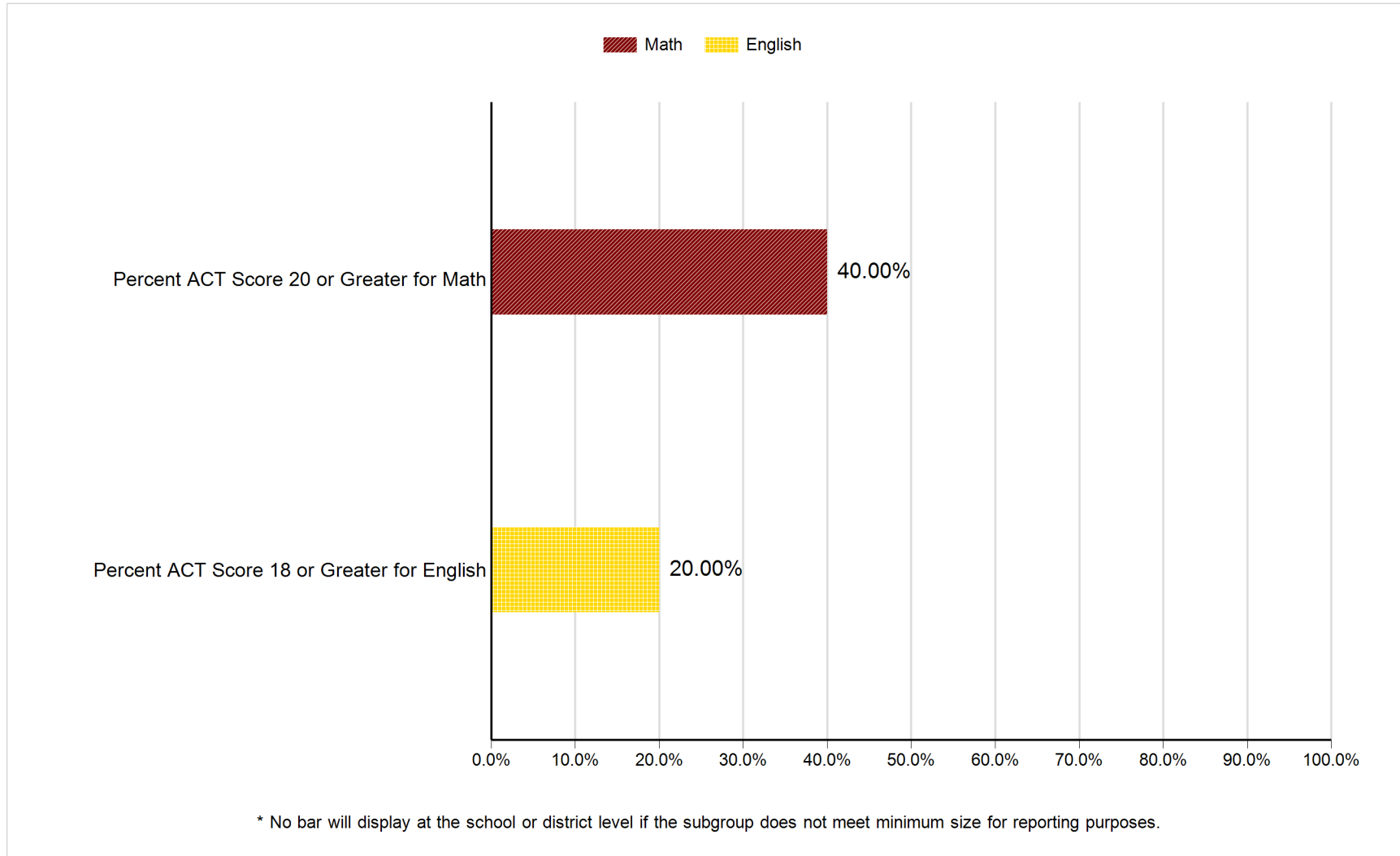

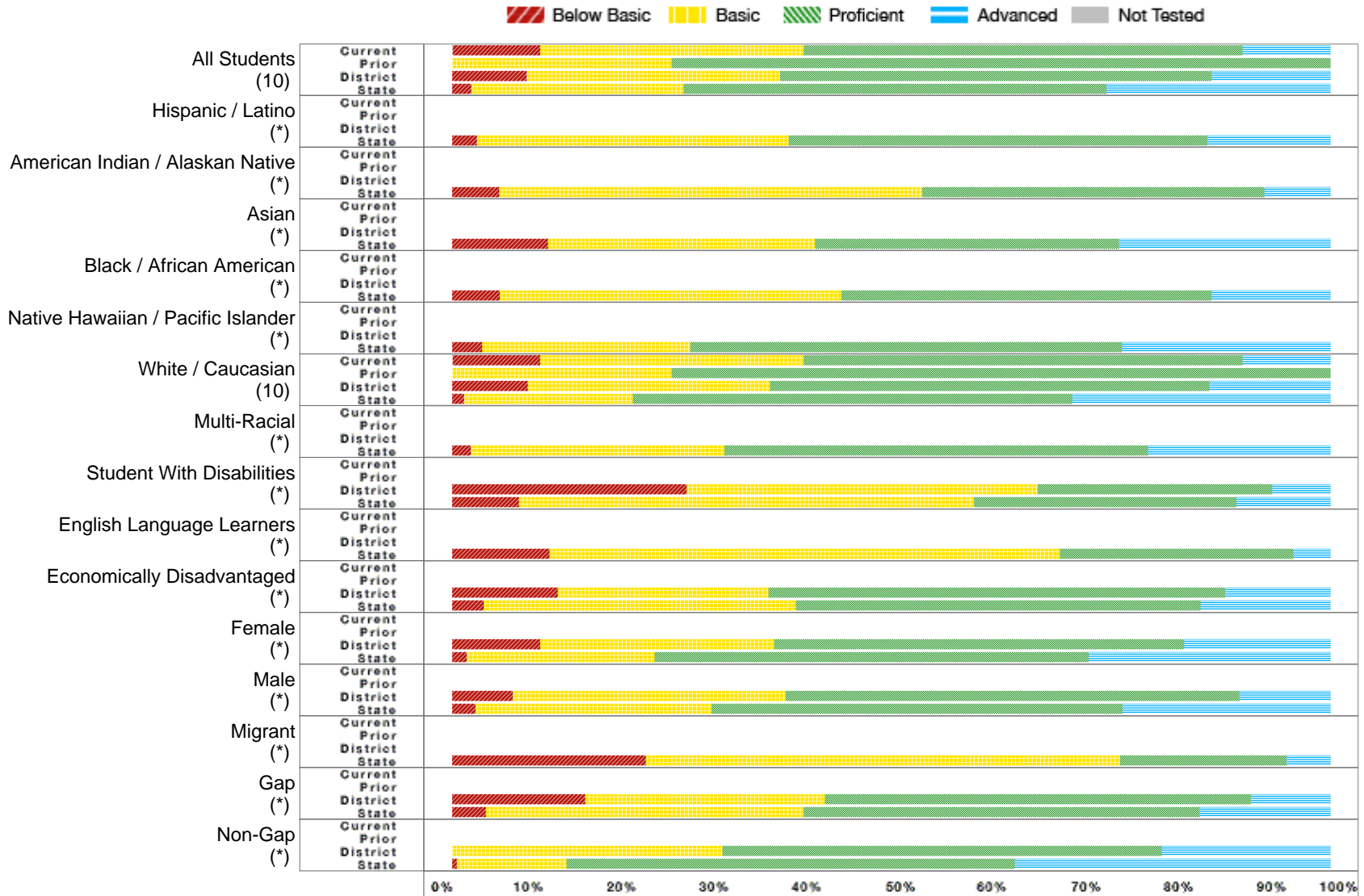
