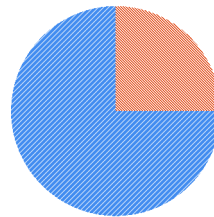

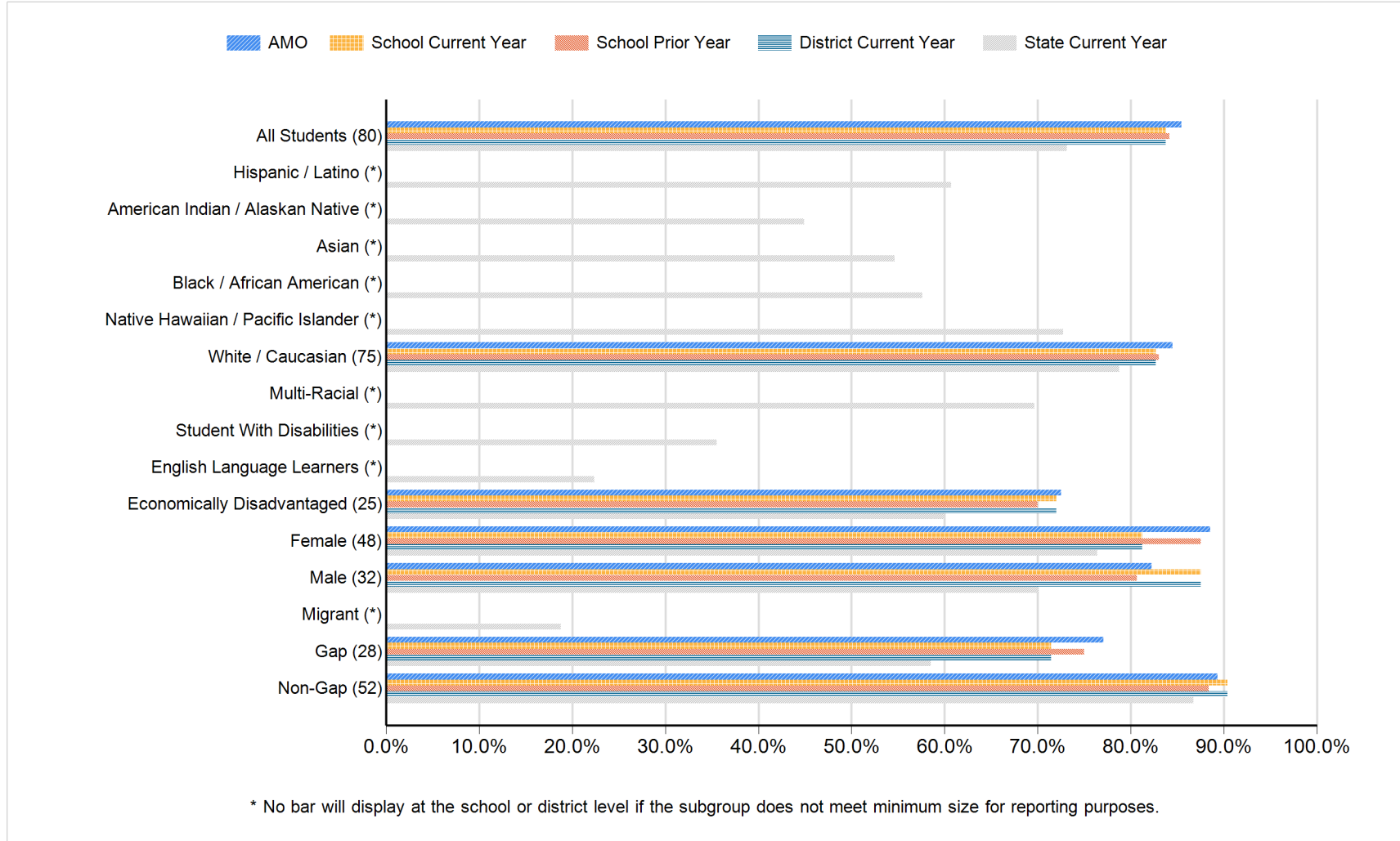
Student Population

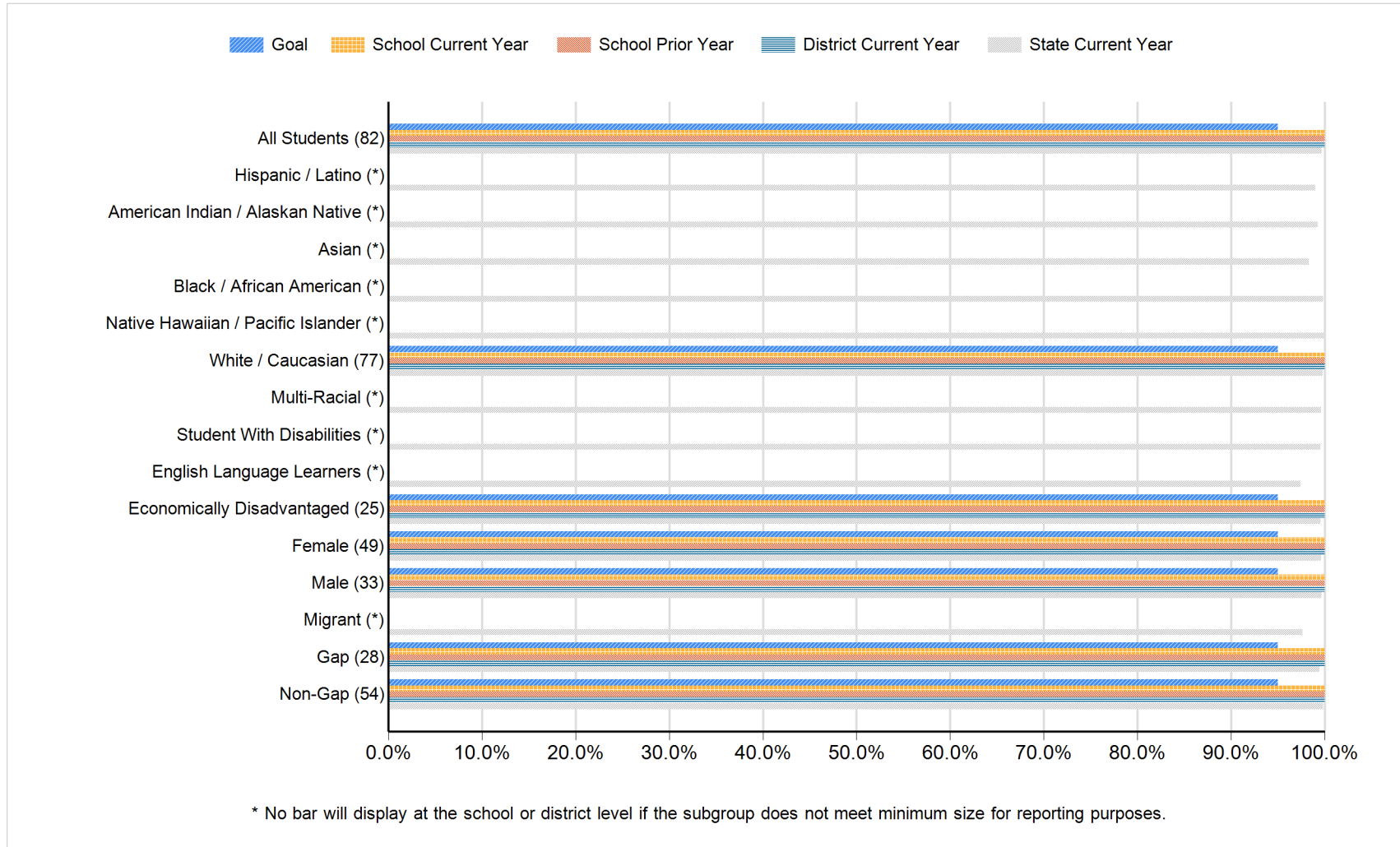

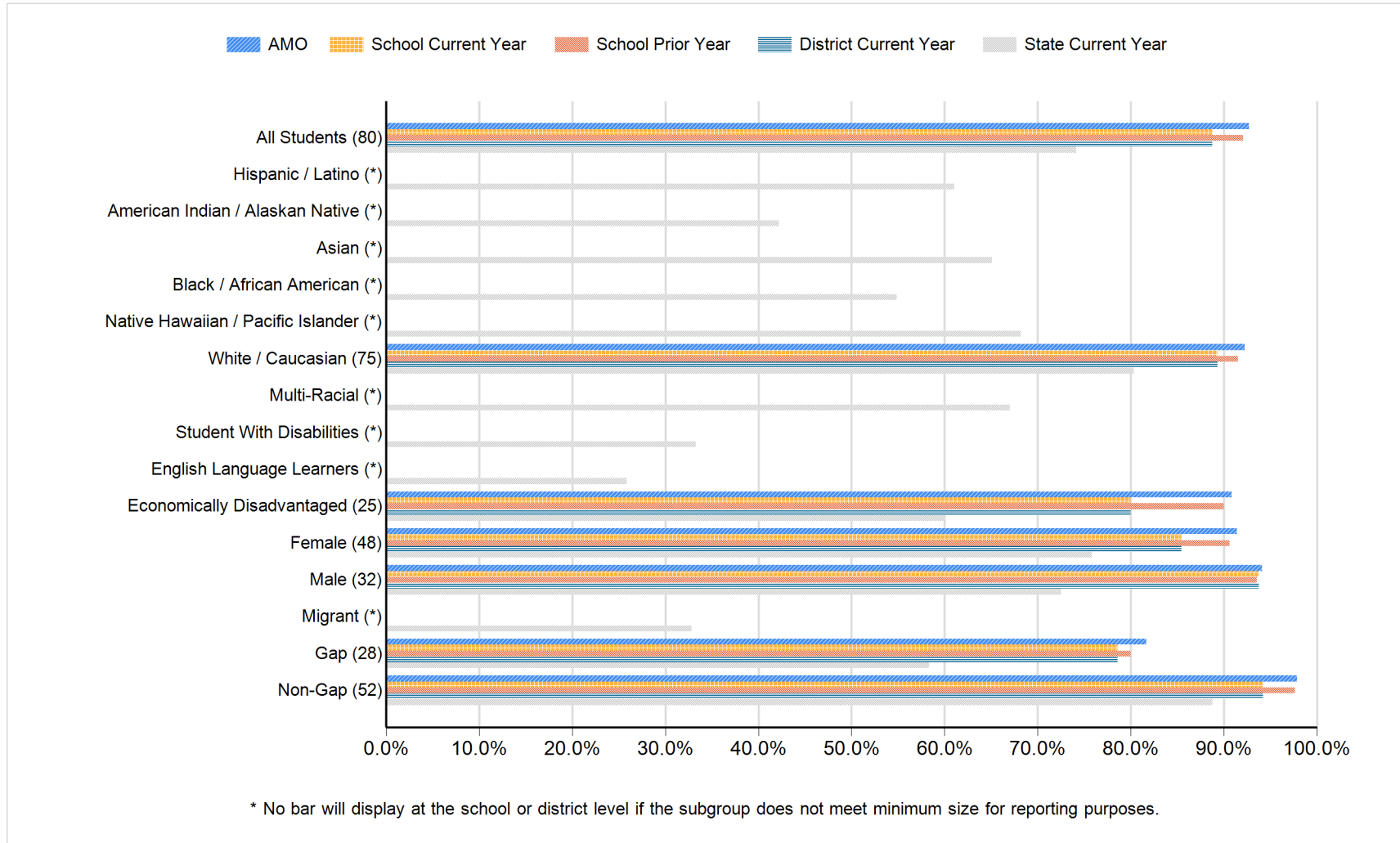

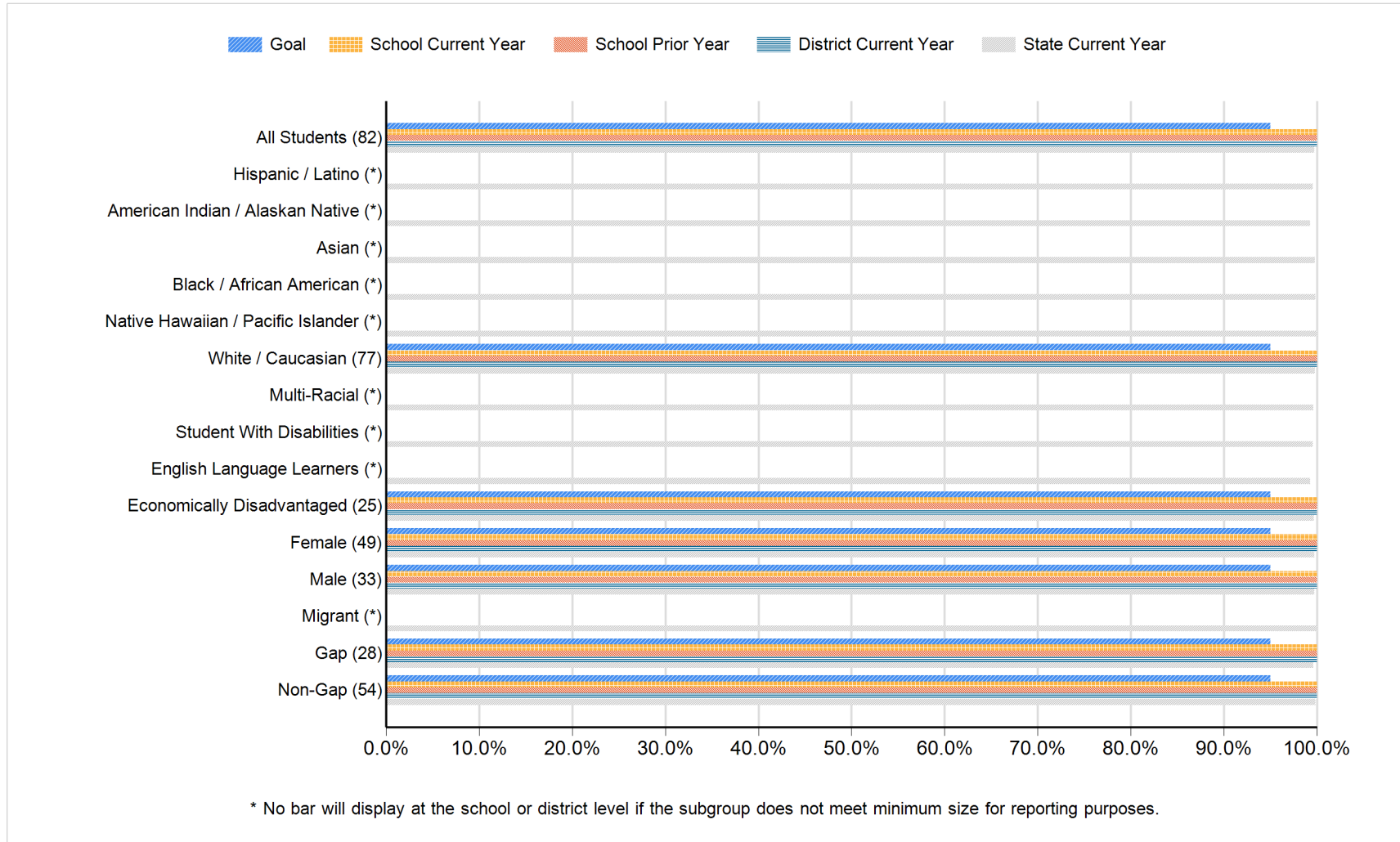

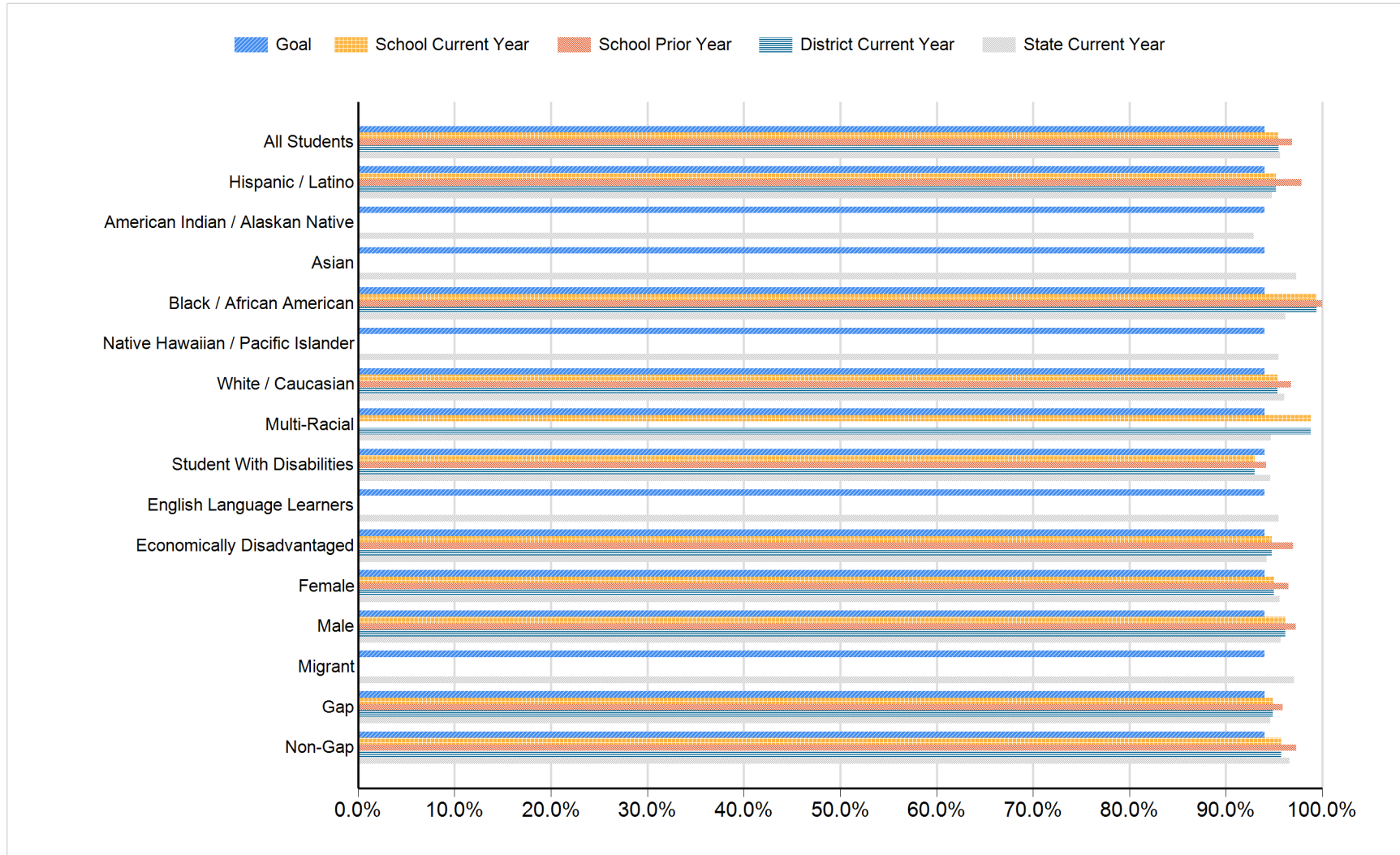
