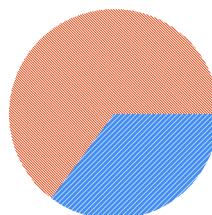

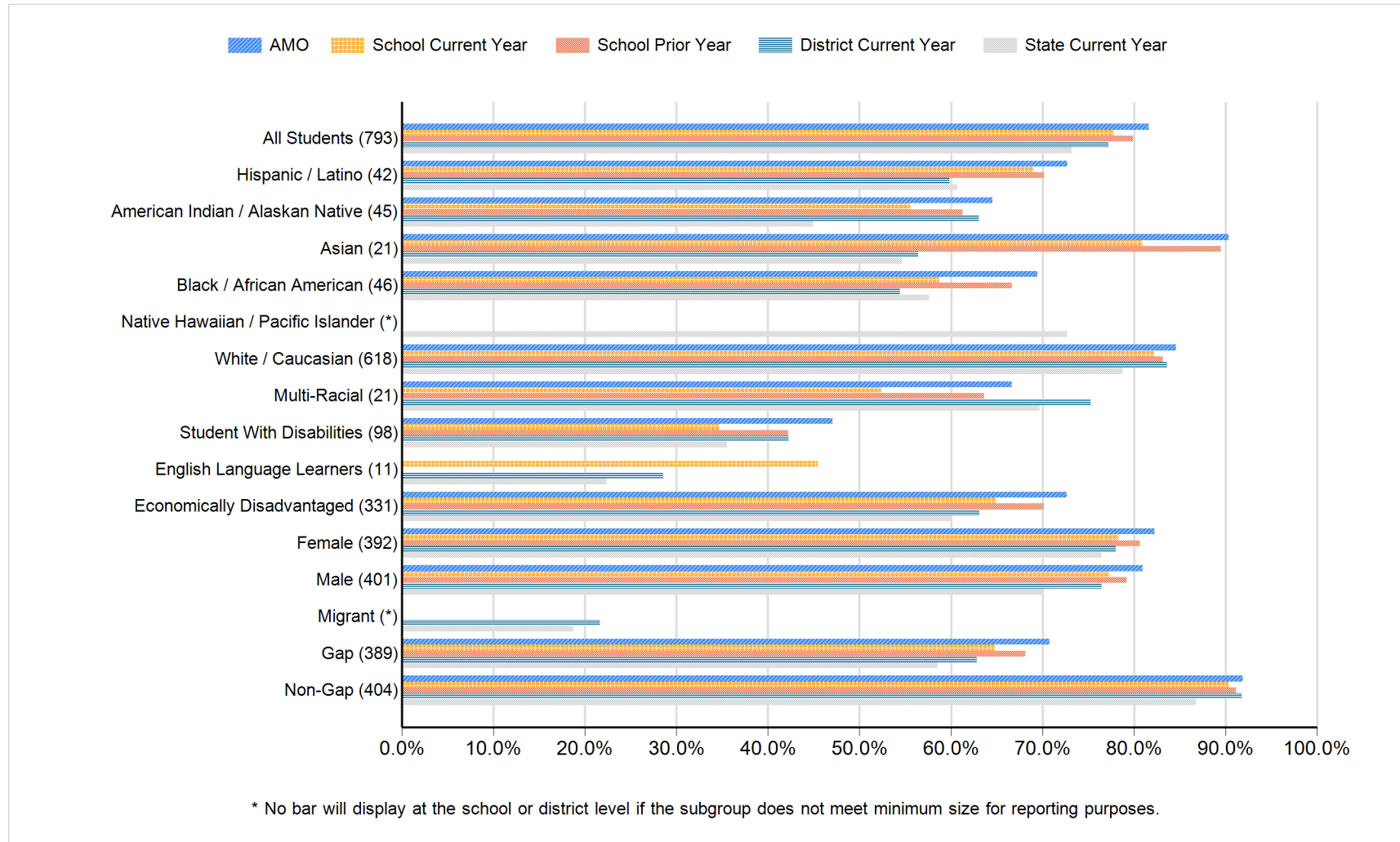
Student Population

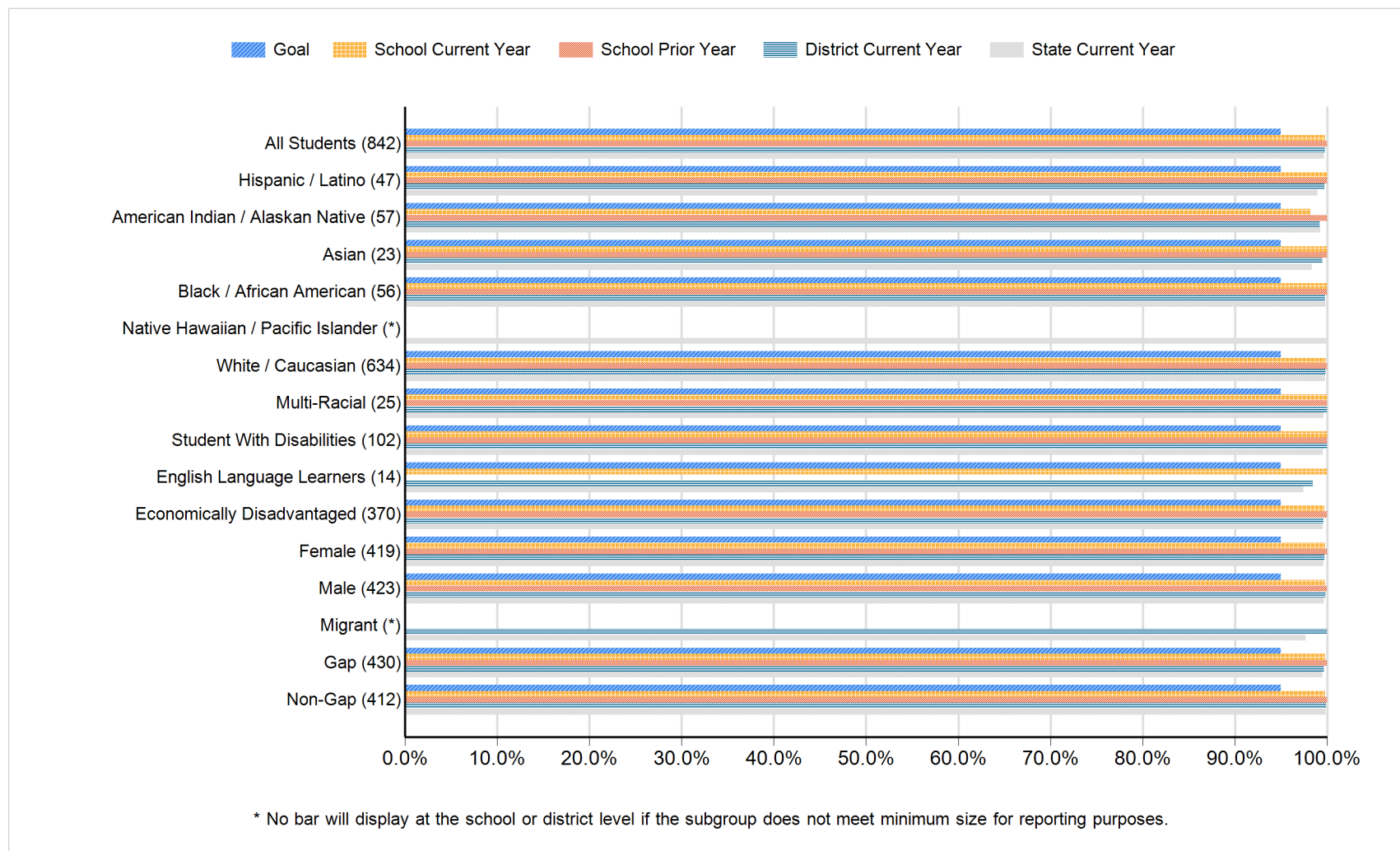

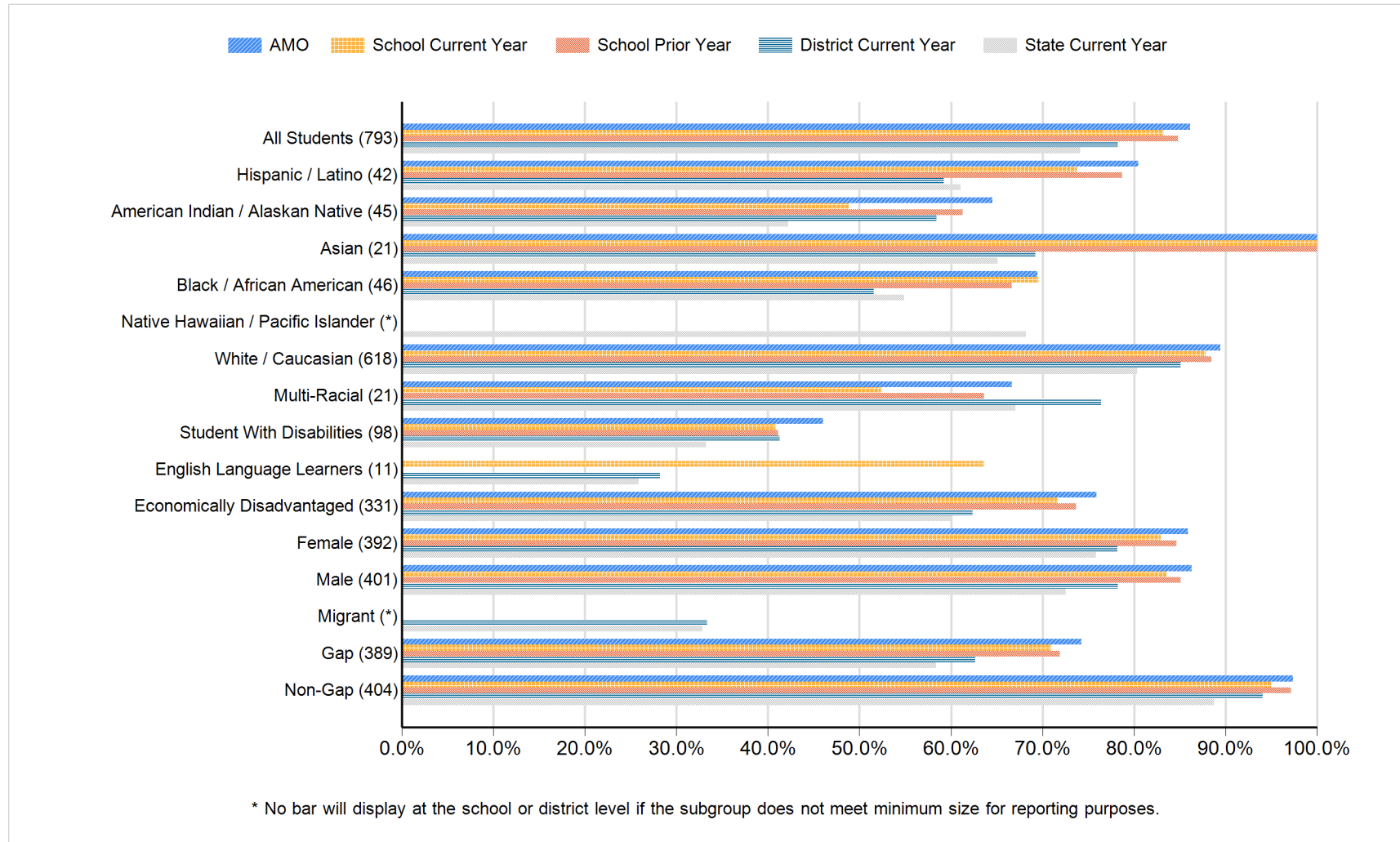

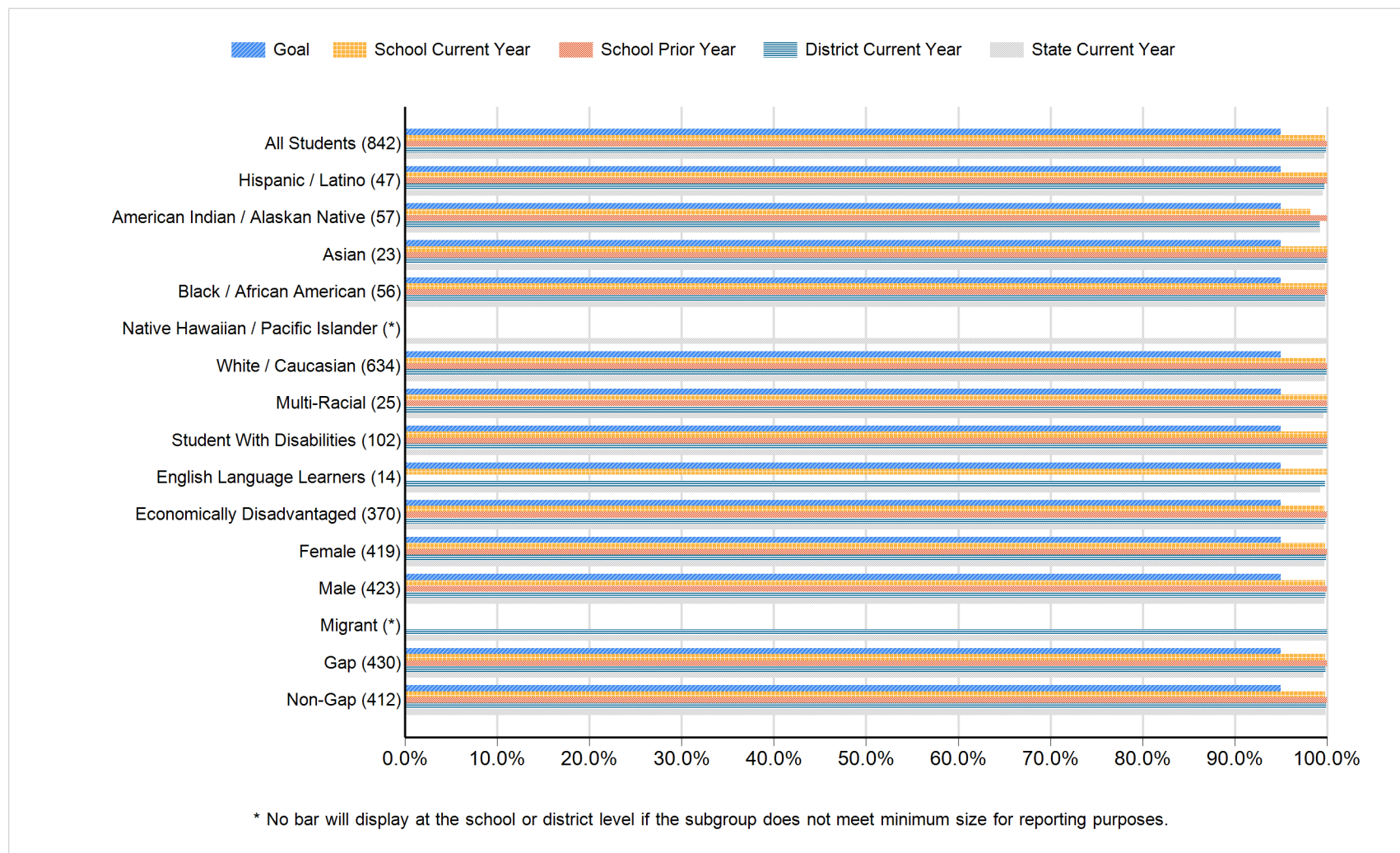
