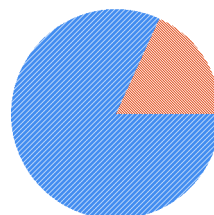

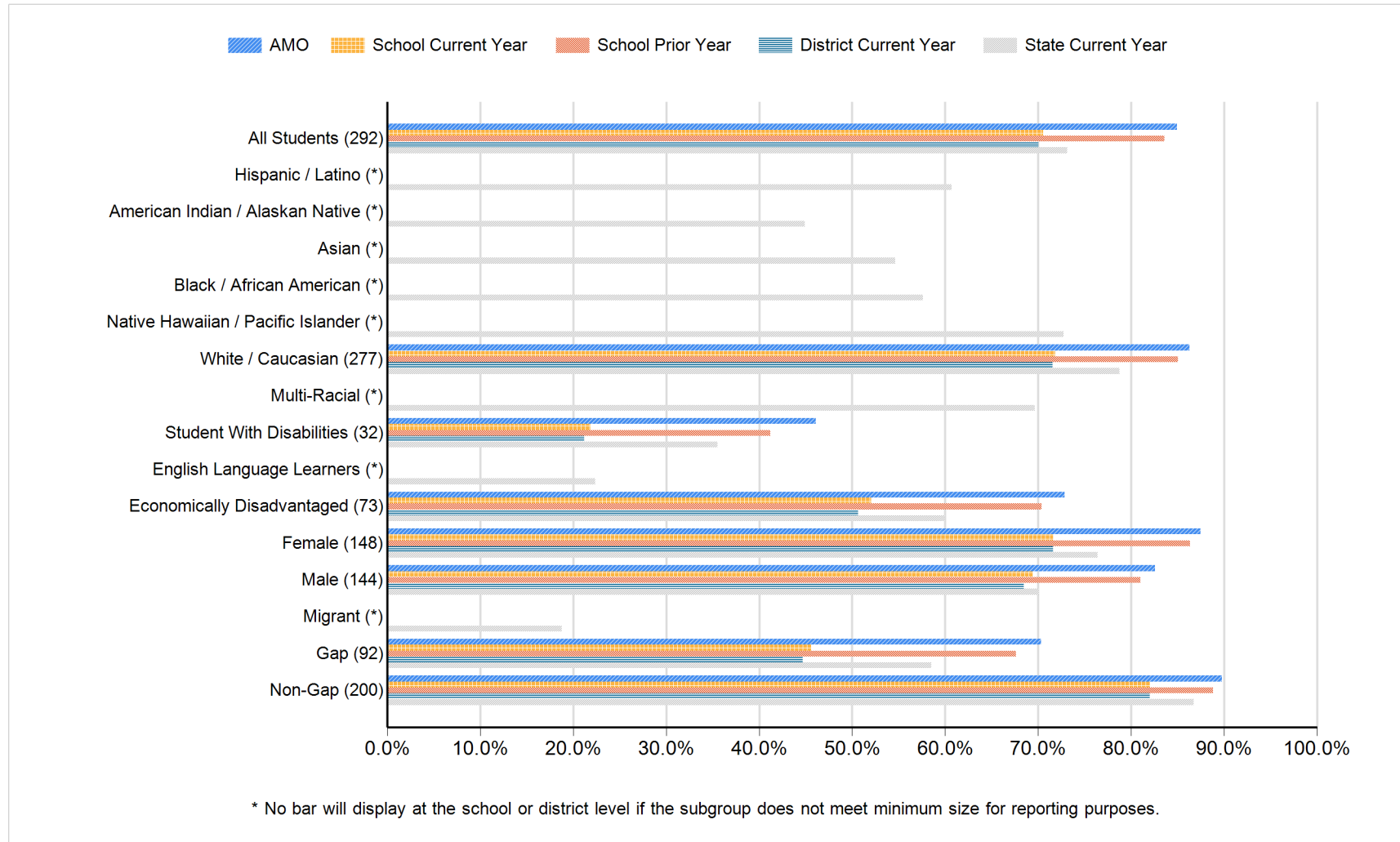
Student Population

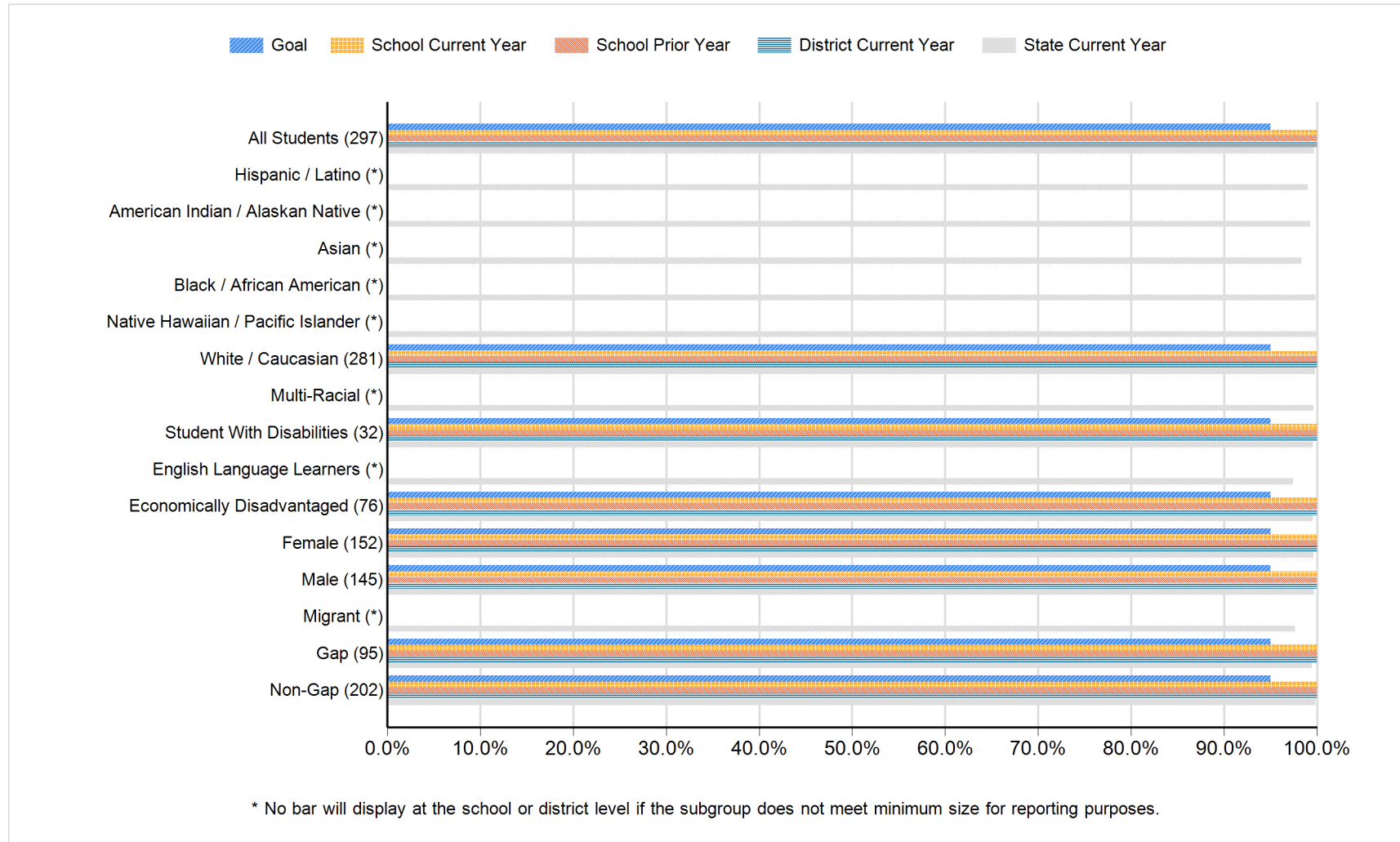

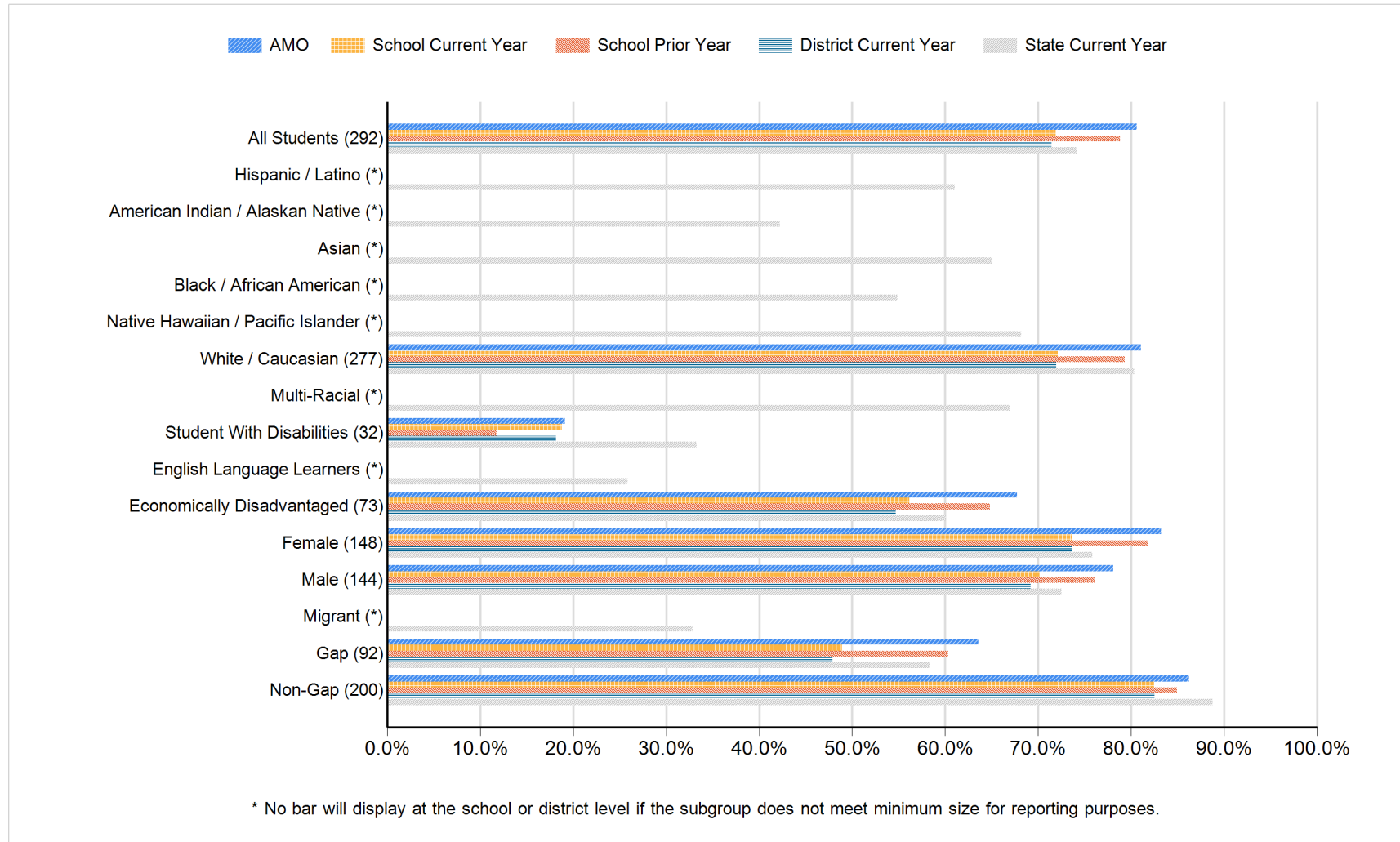

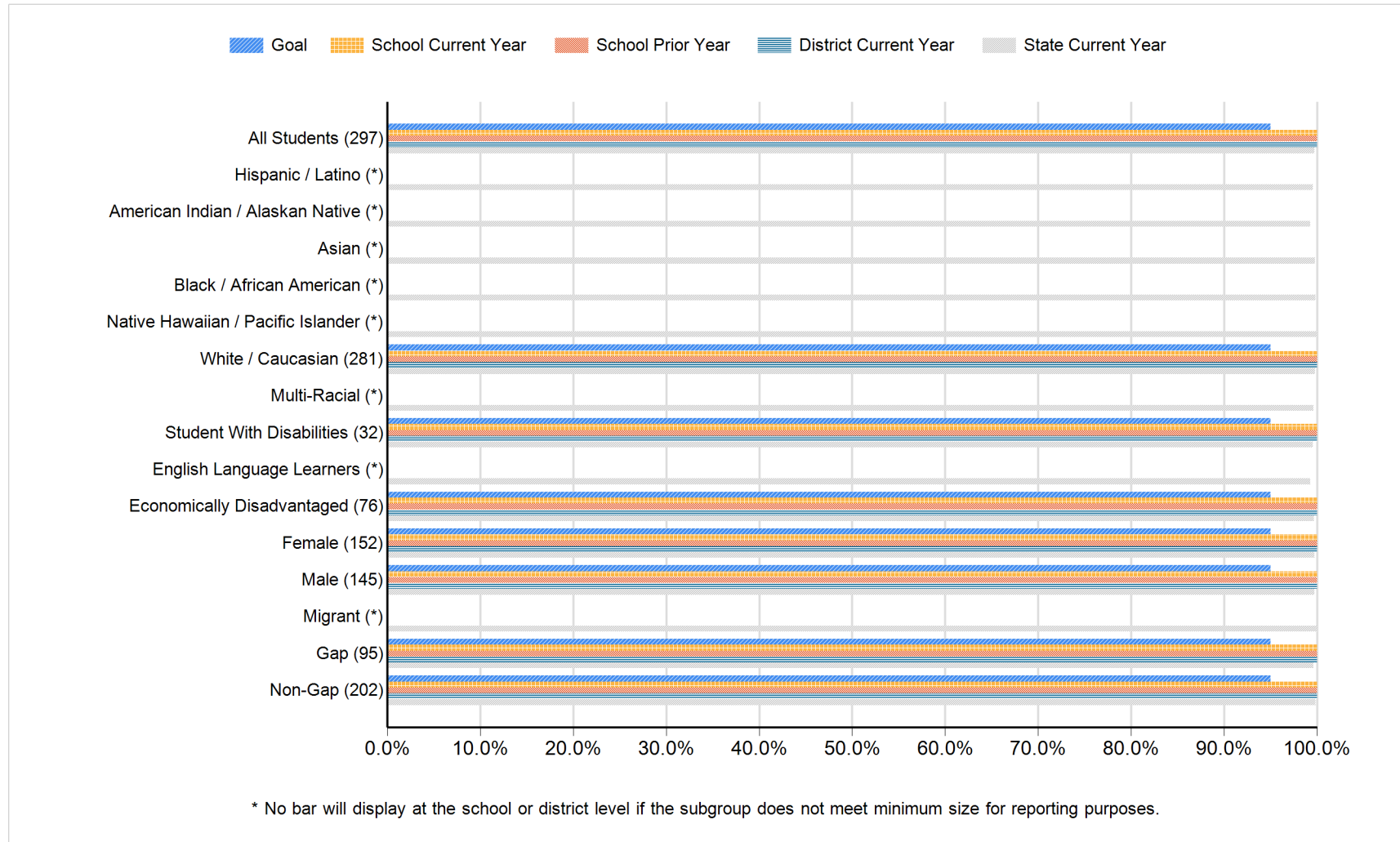

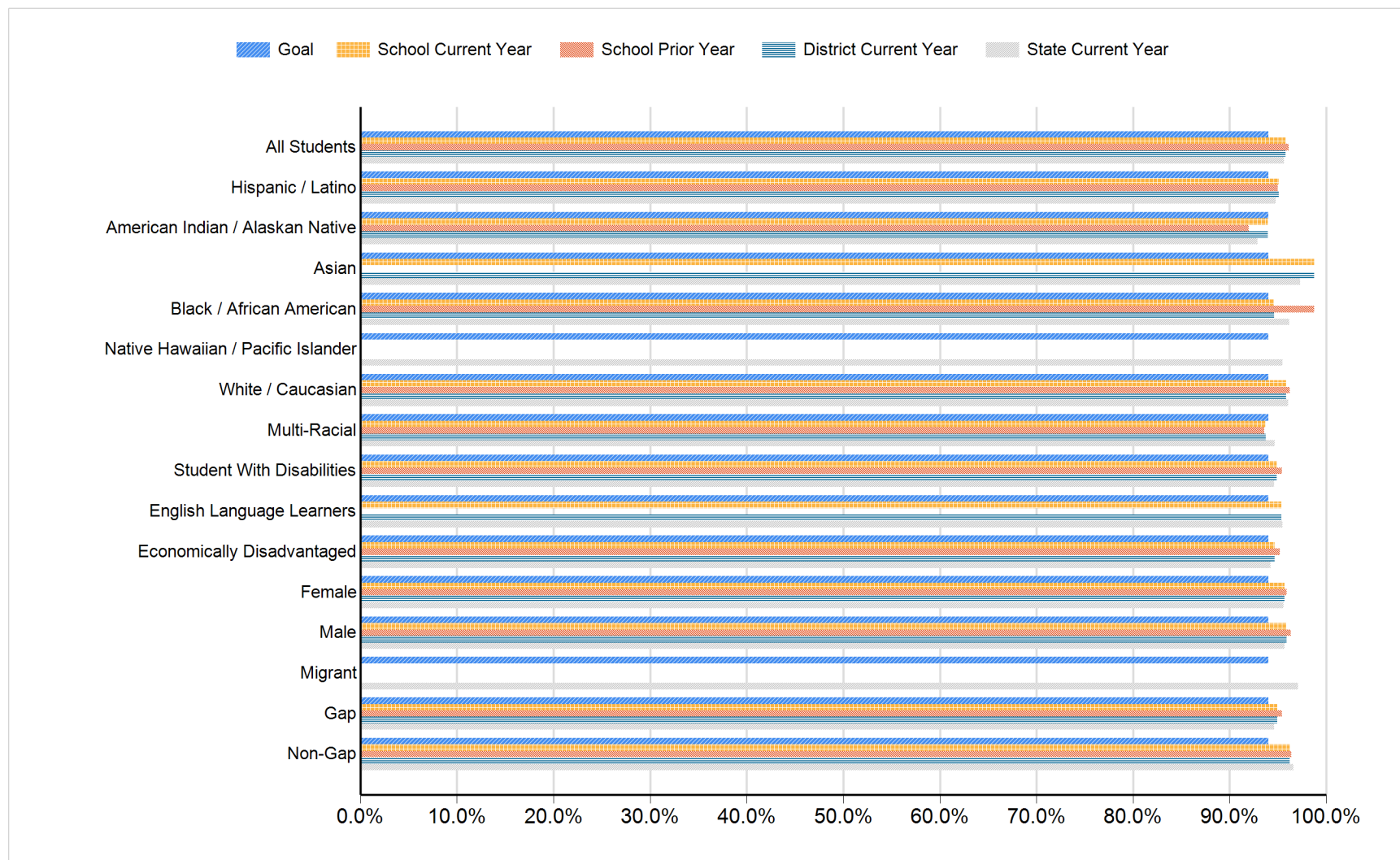
