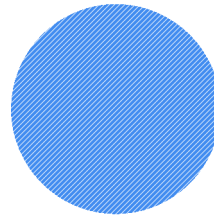

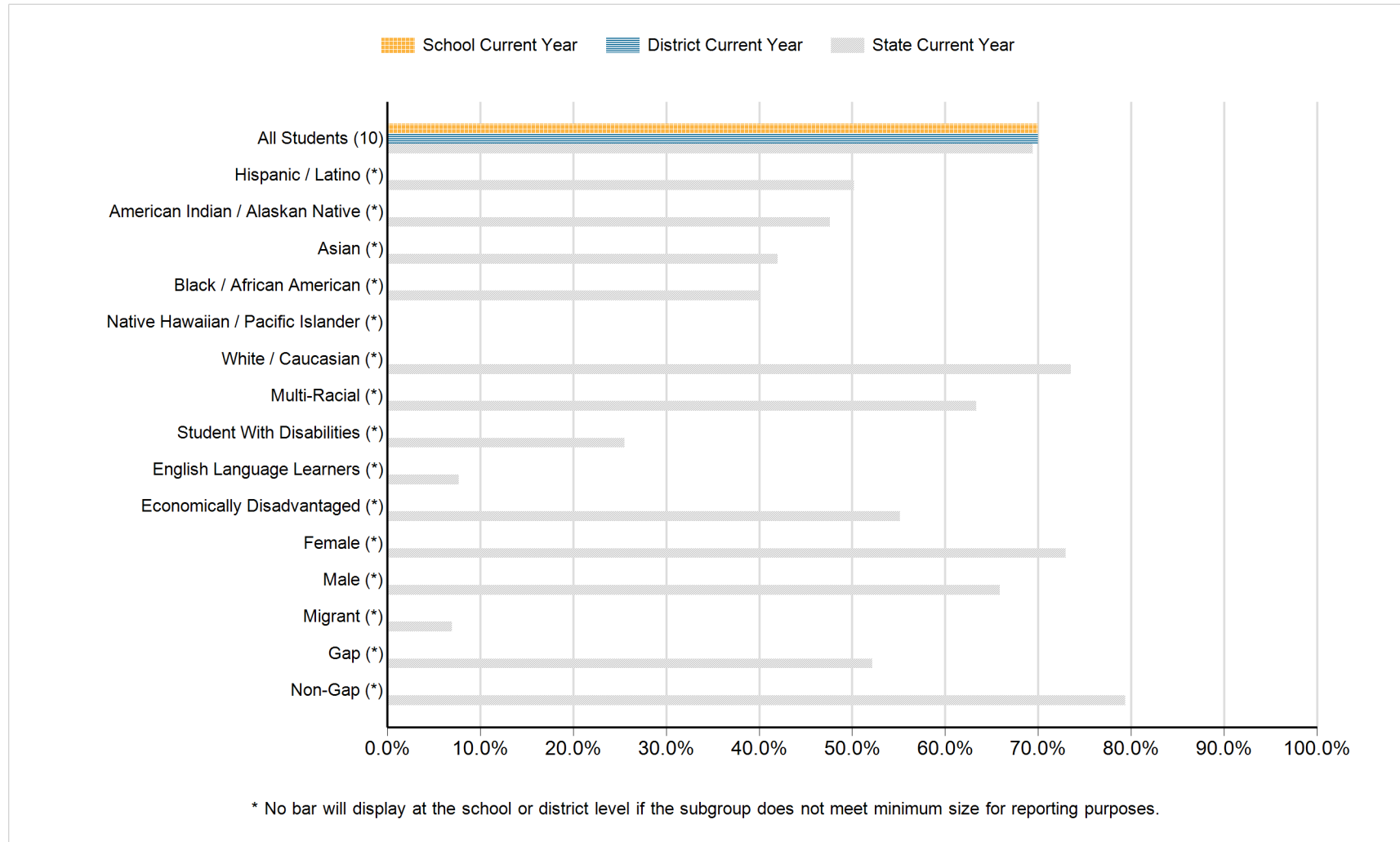
Student Population

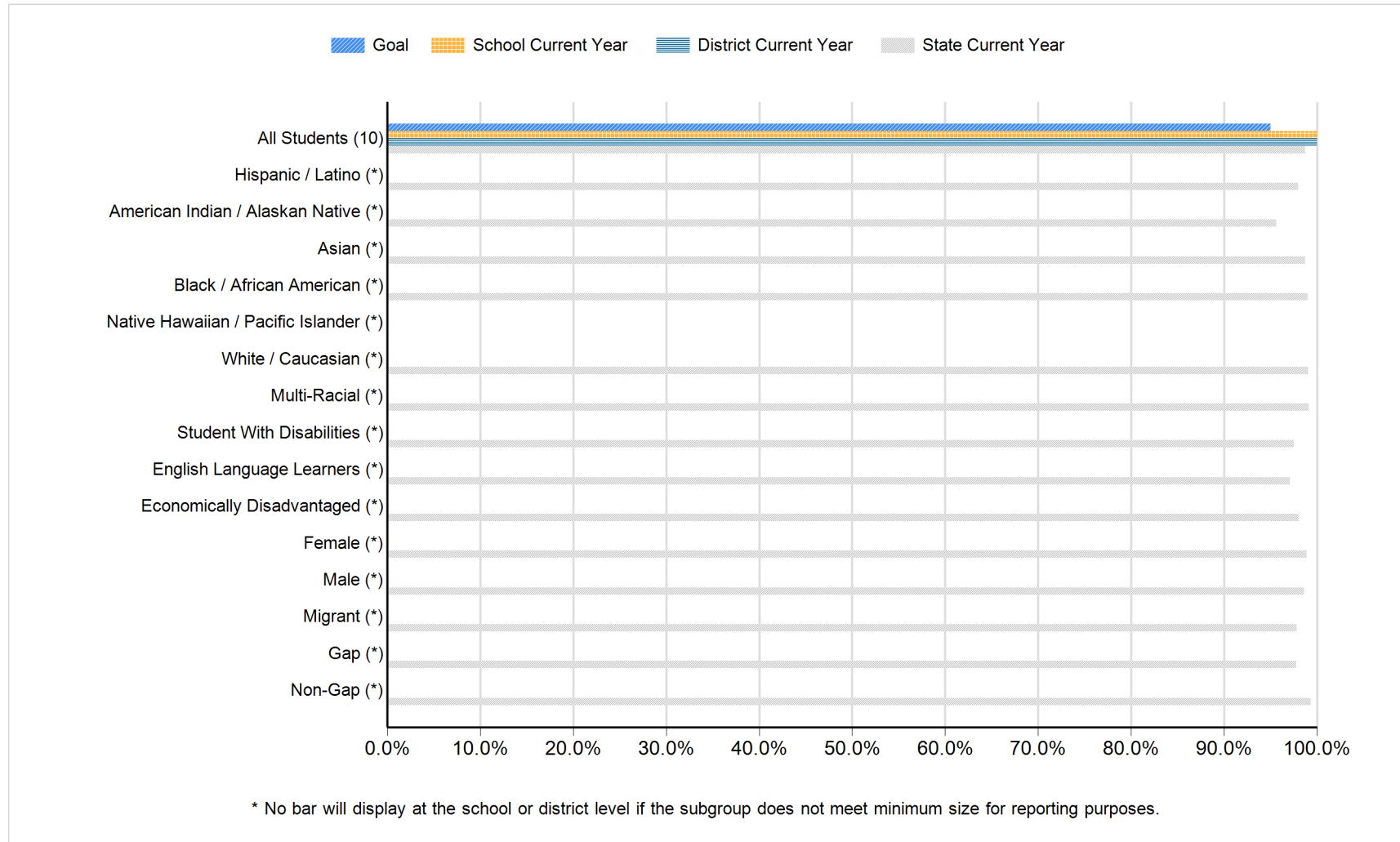

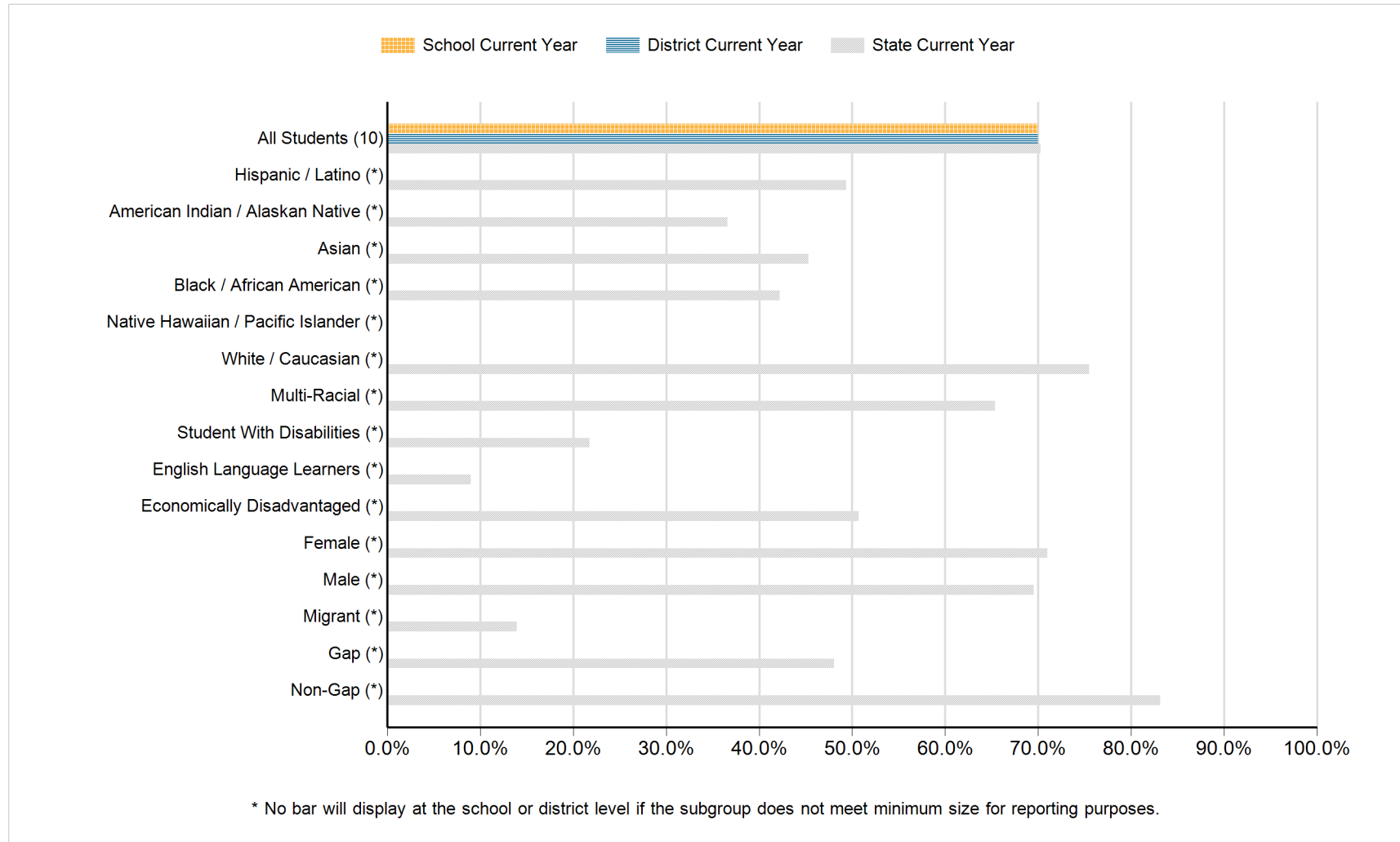

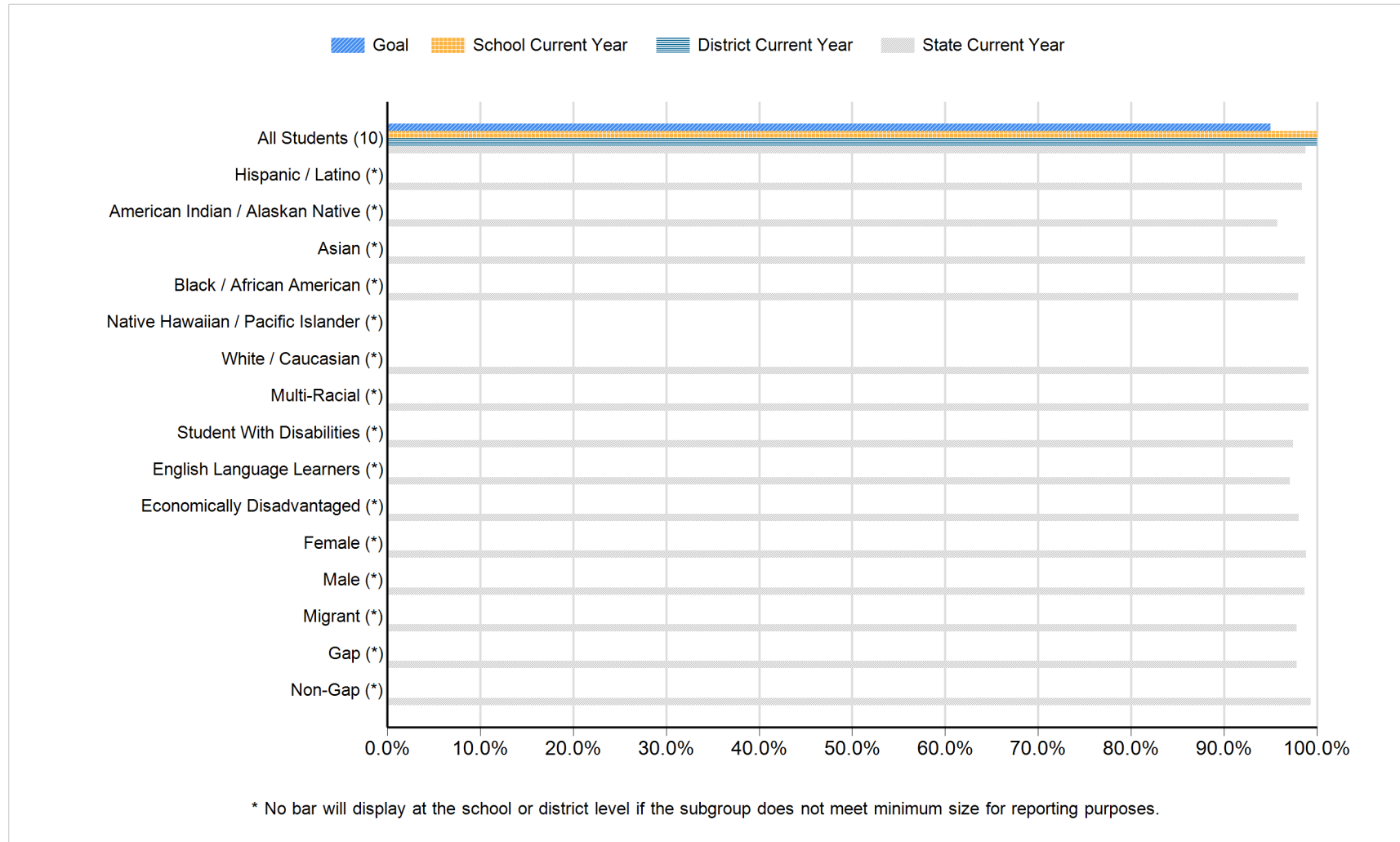

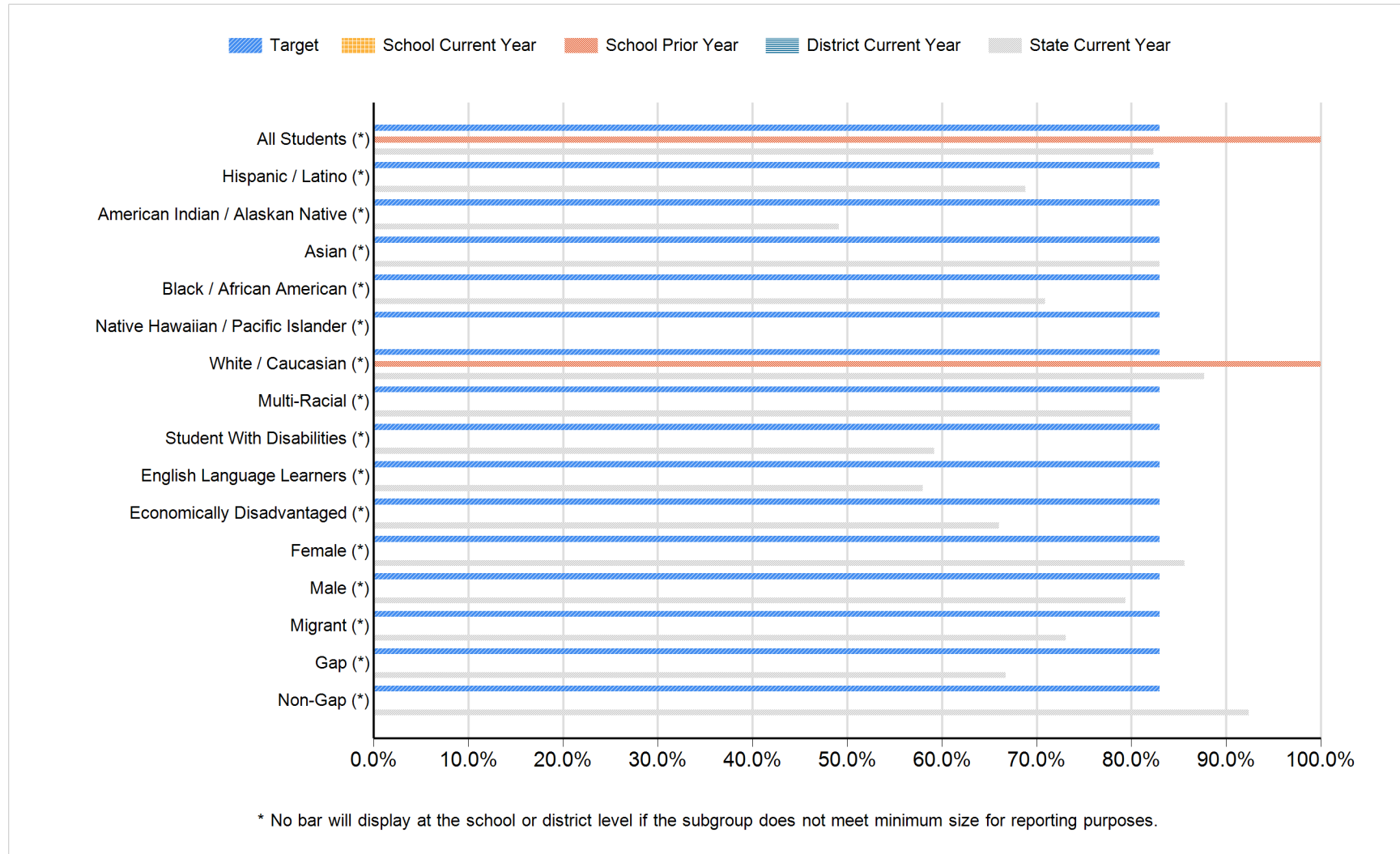

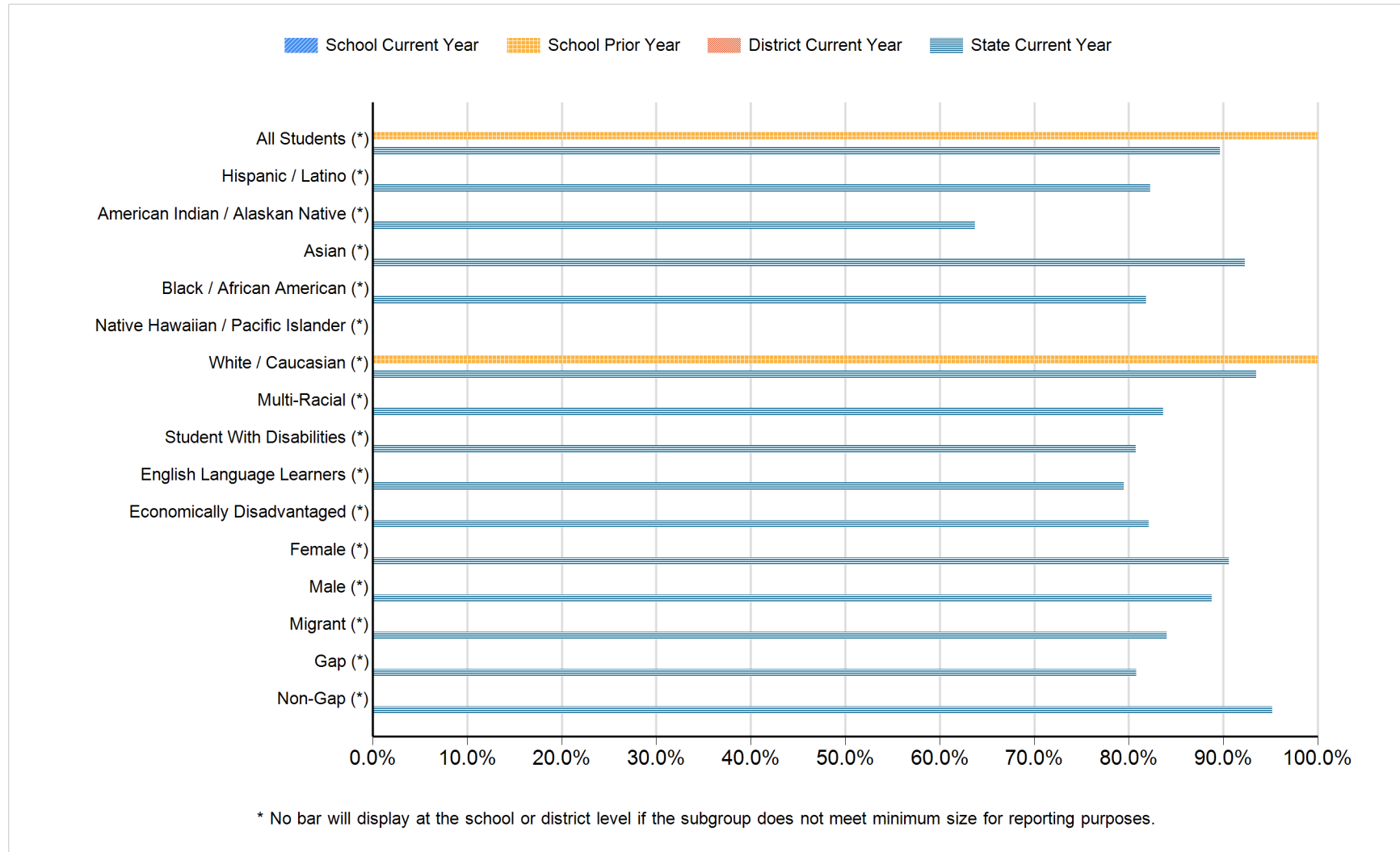

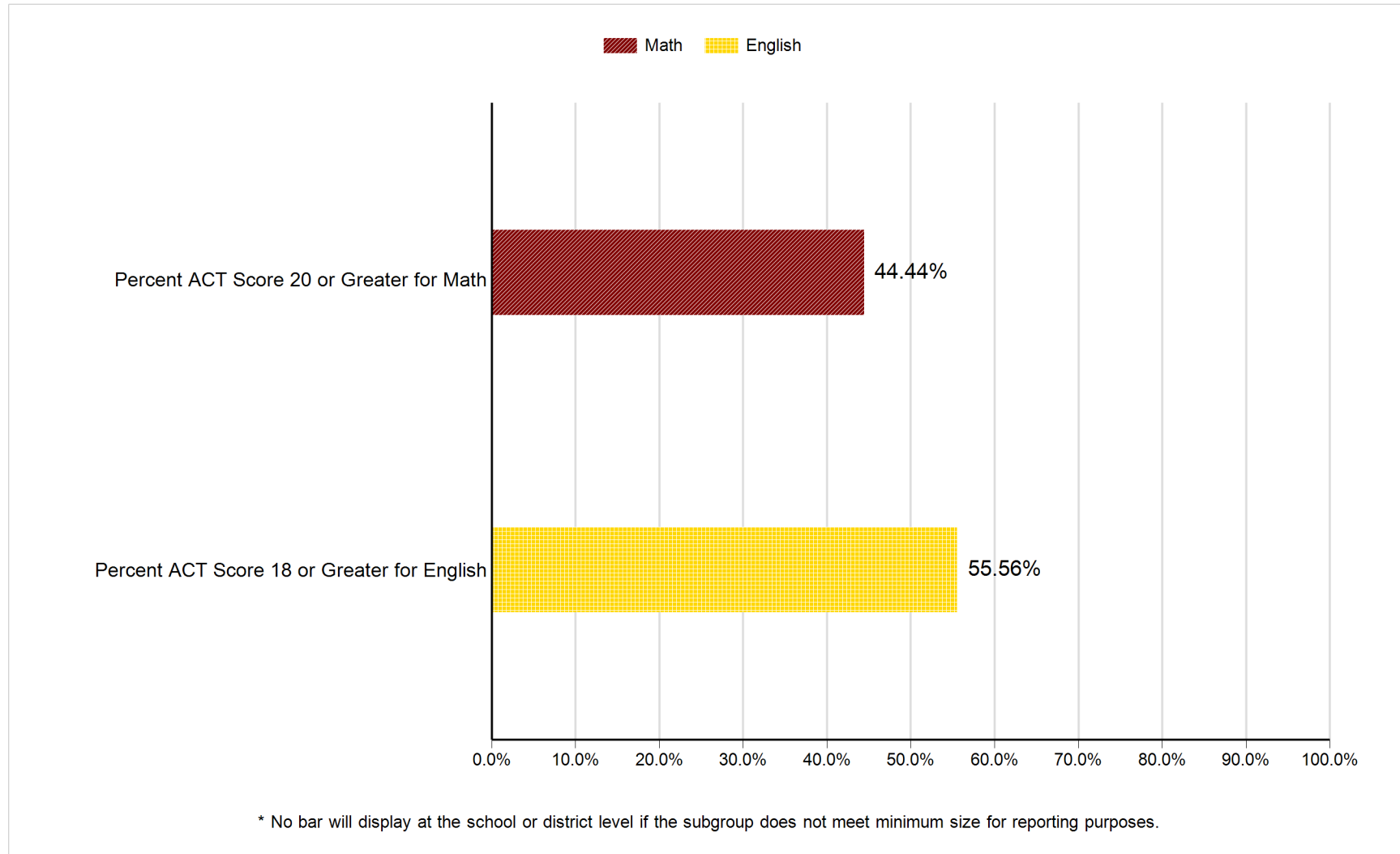
