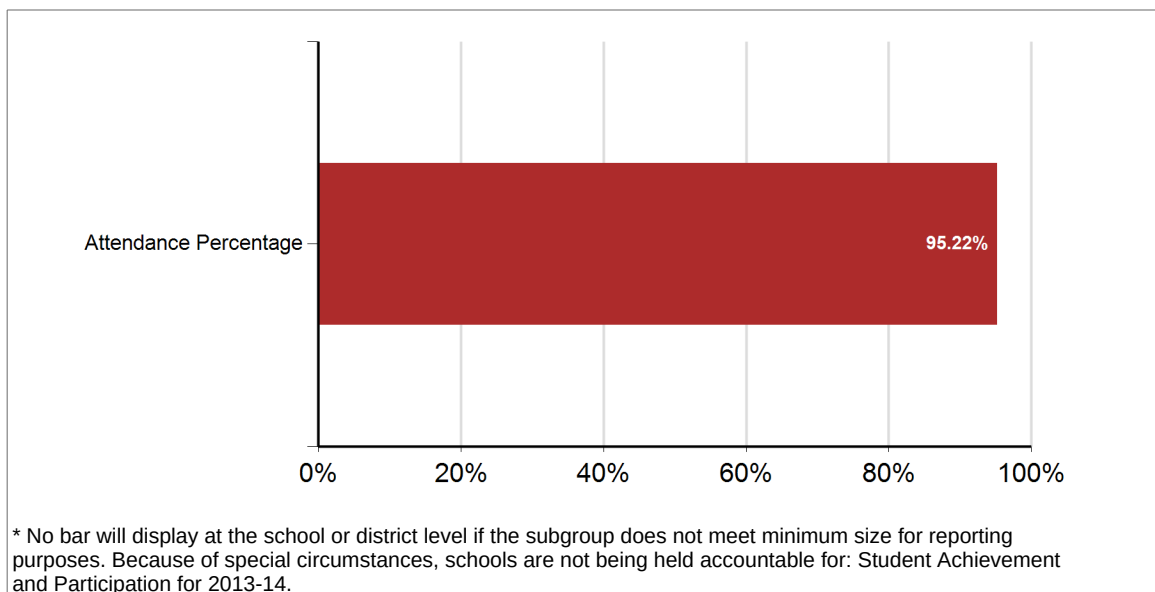

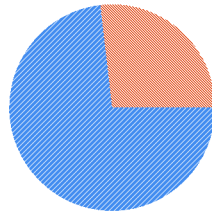

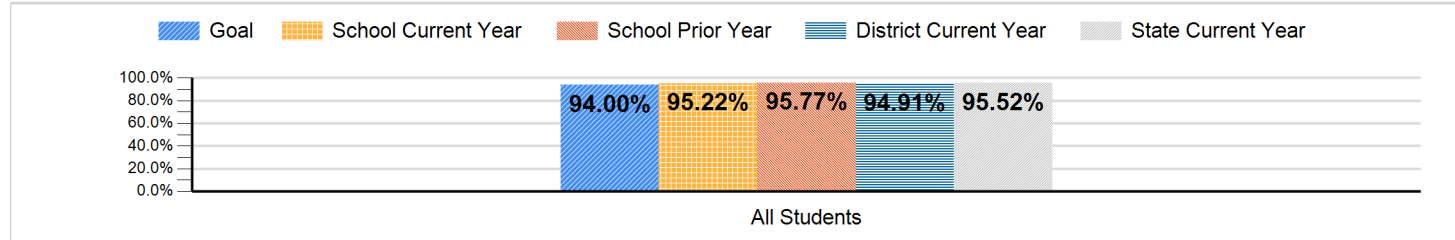

Attendance



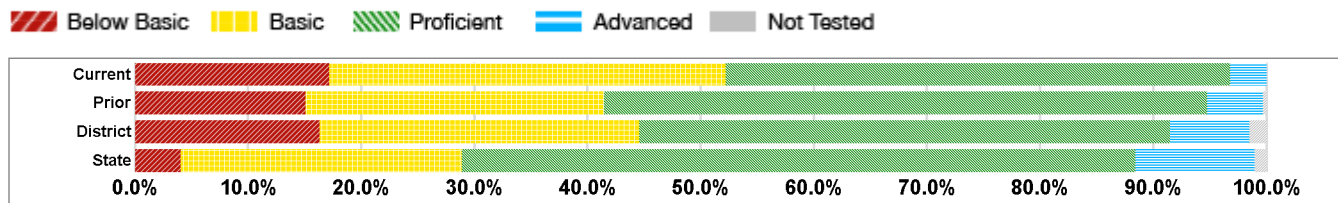

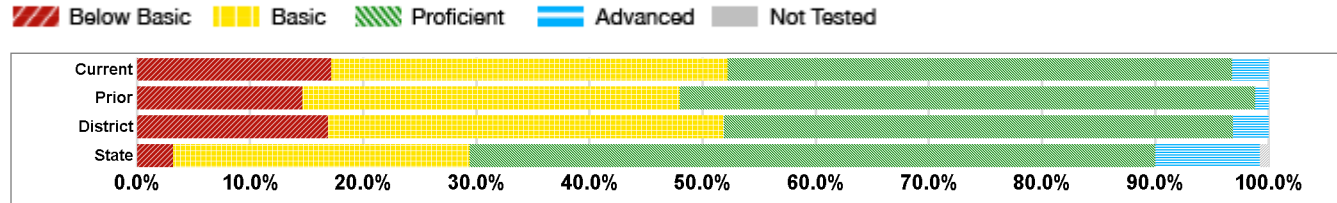
