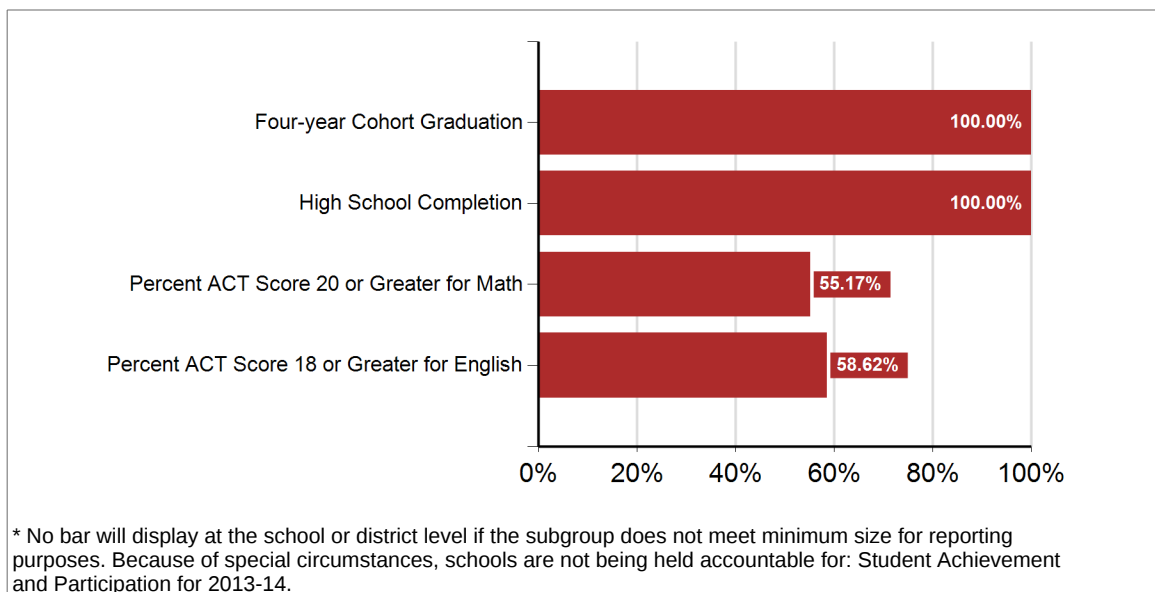

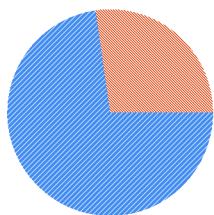

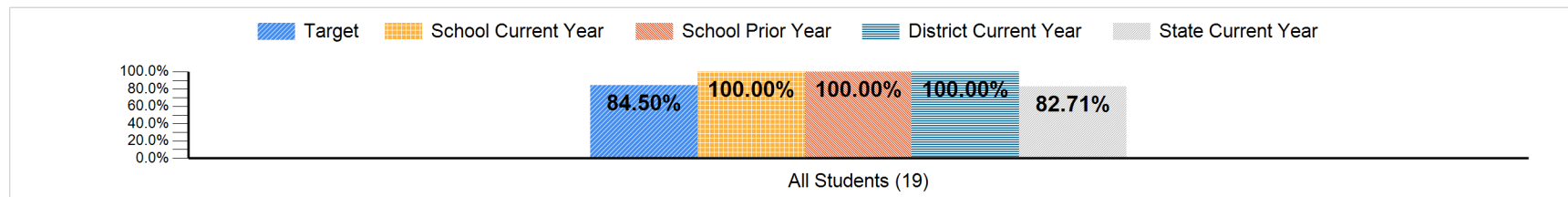

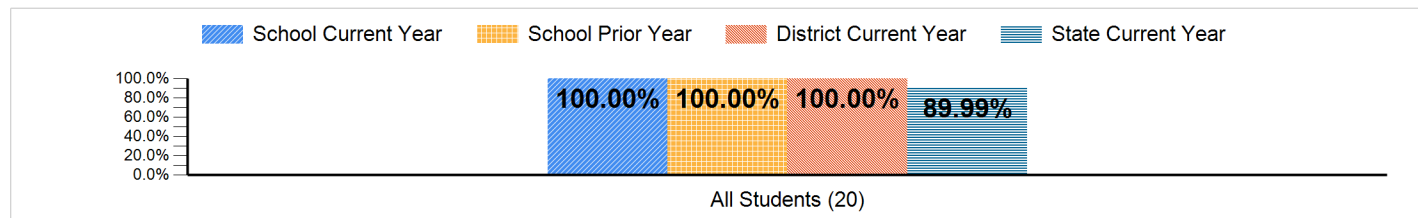

High School Completion



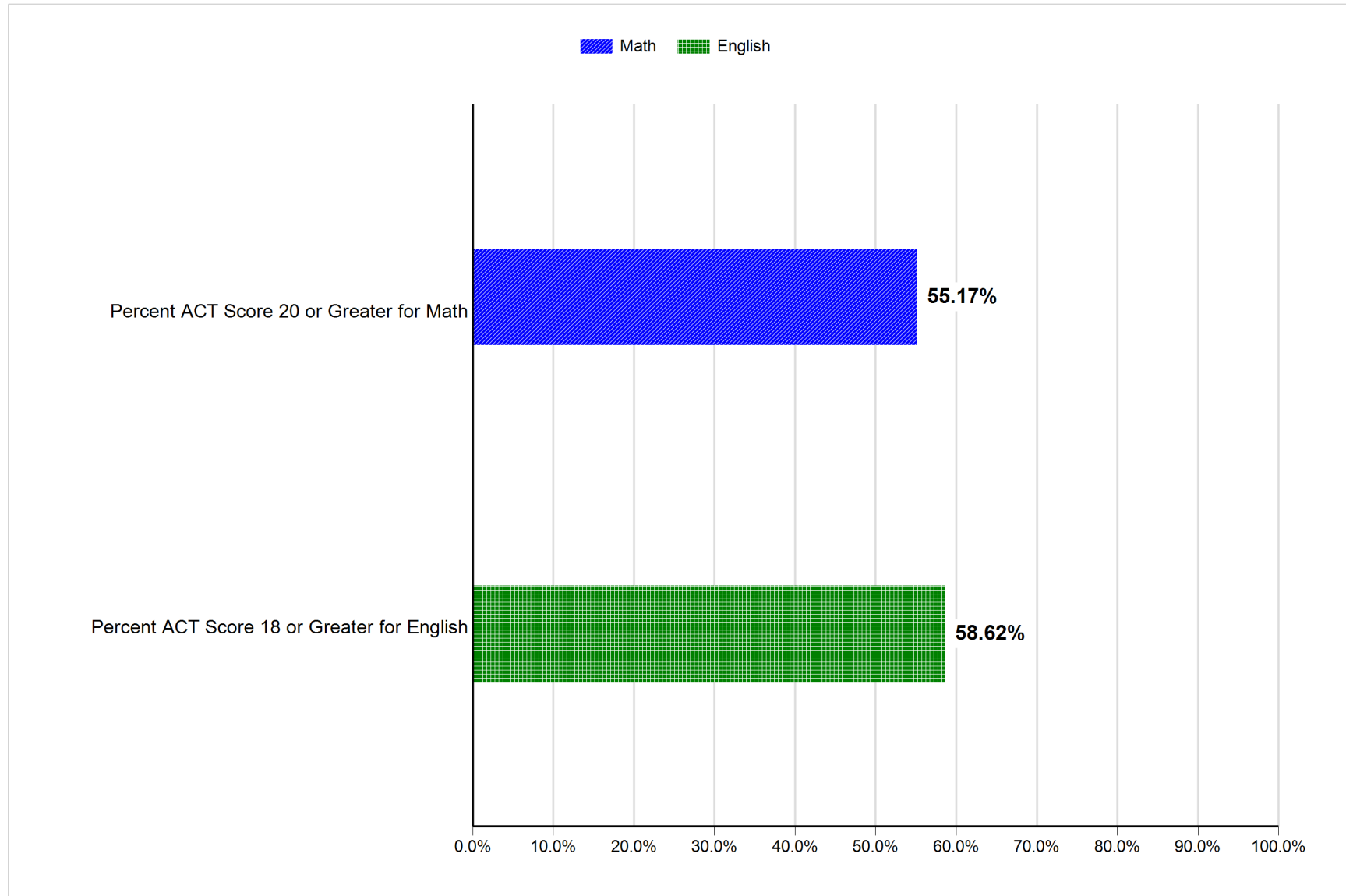

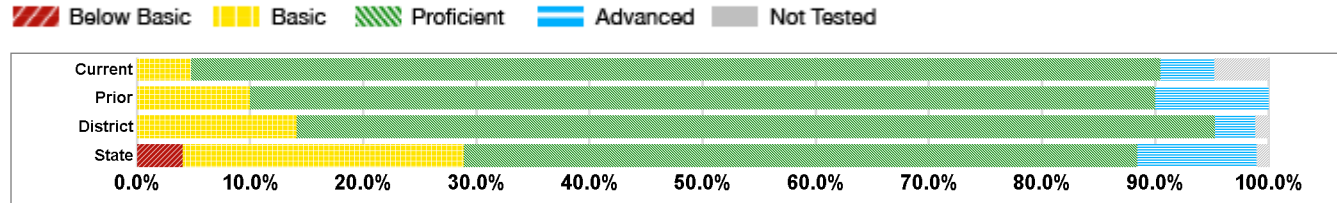

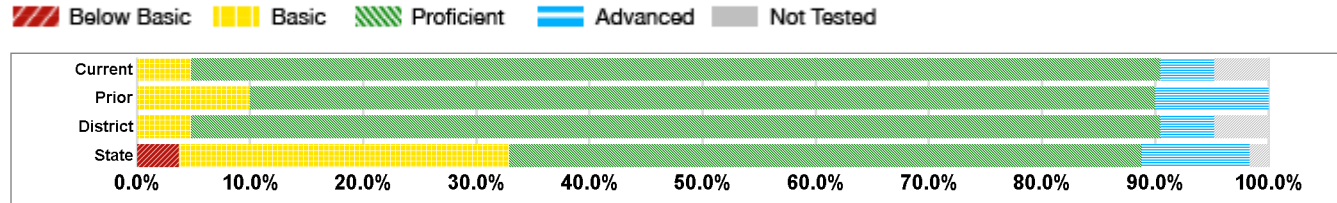
