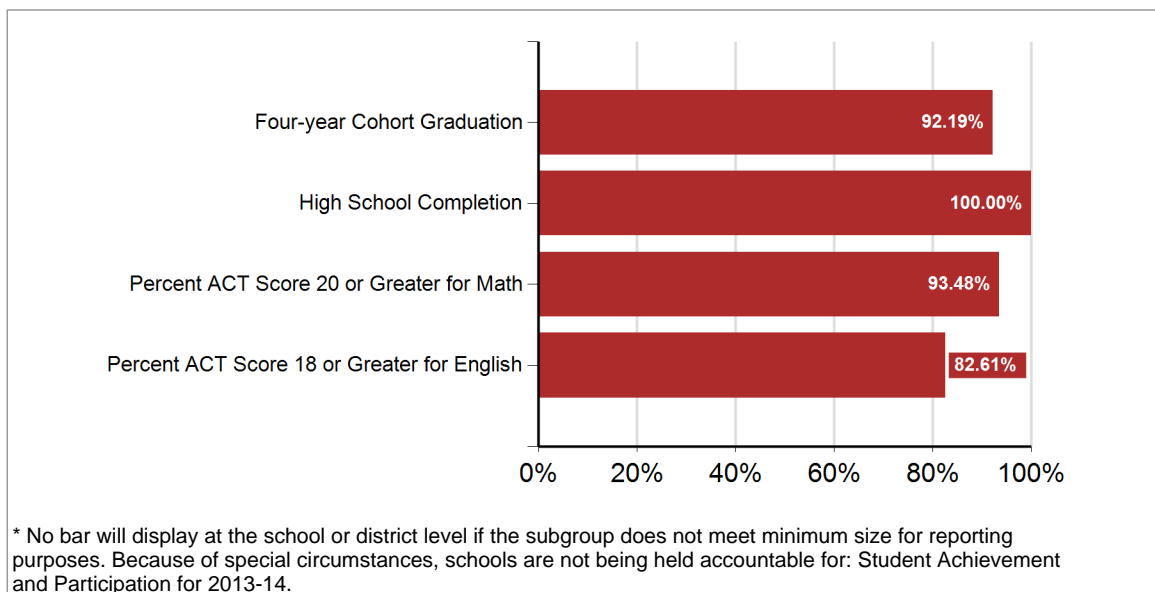

Core Classes Taught by Highly Qualified Teachers




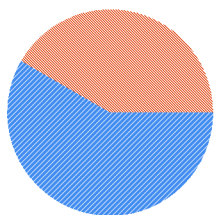

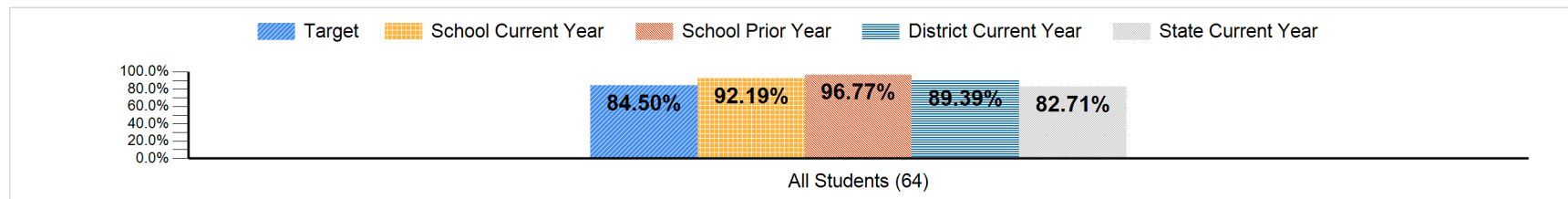

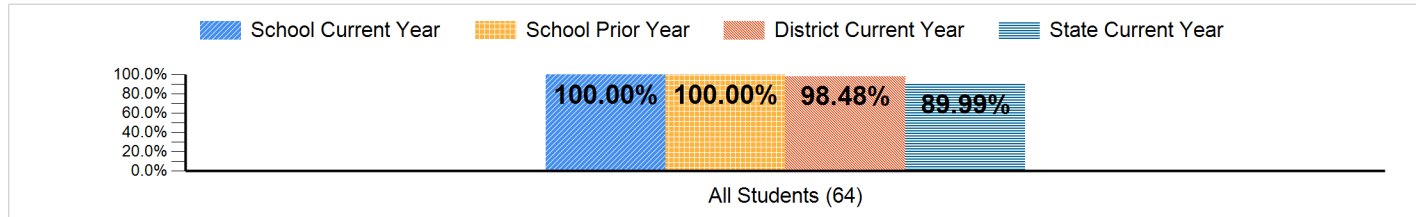

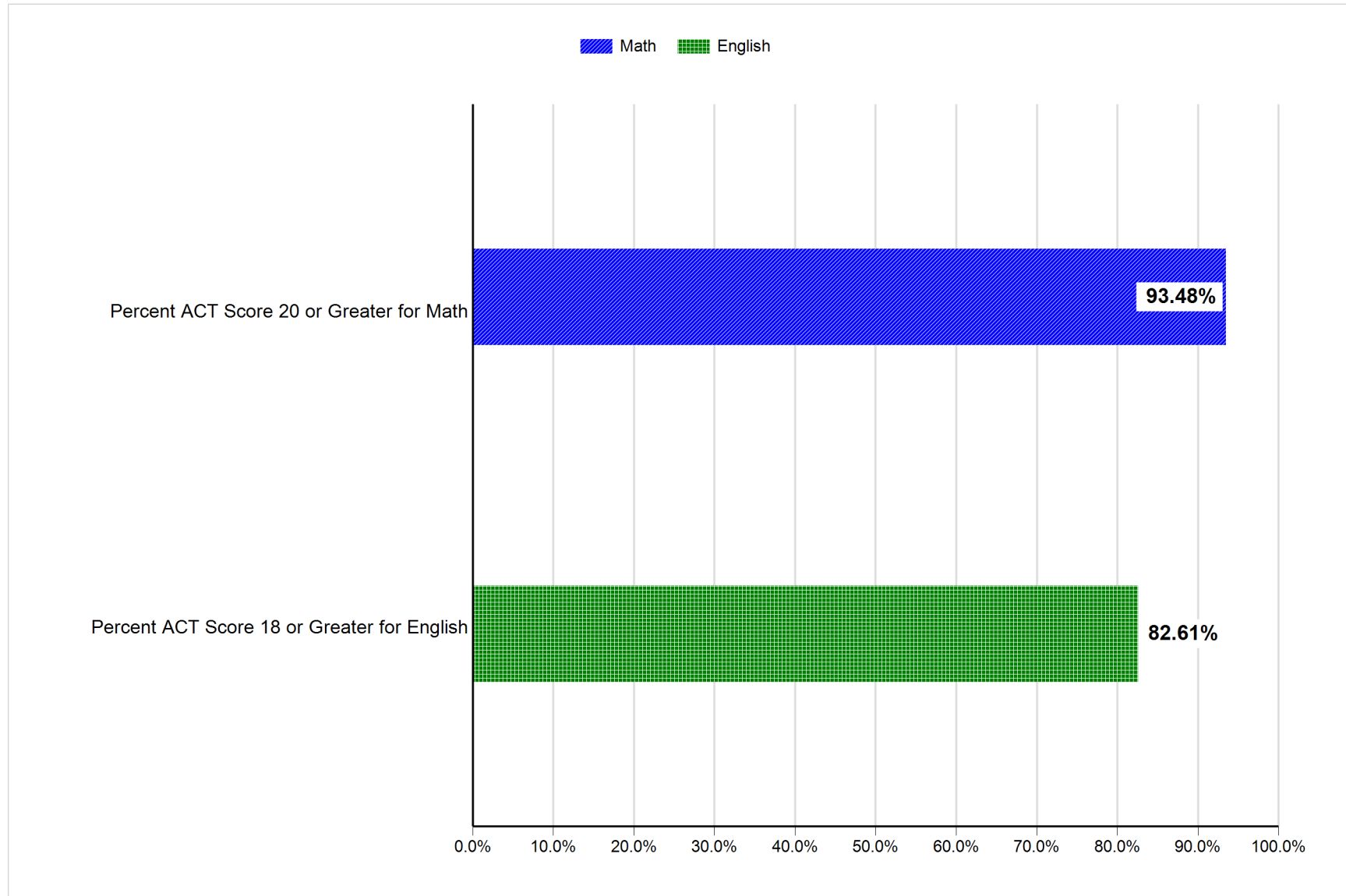
