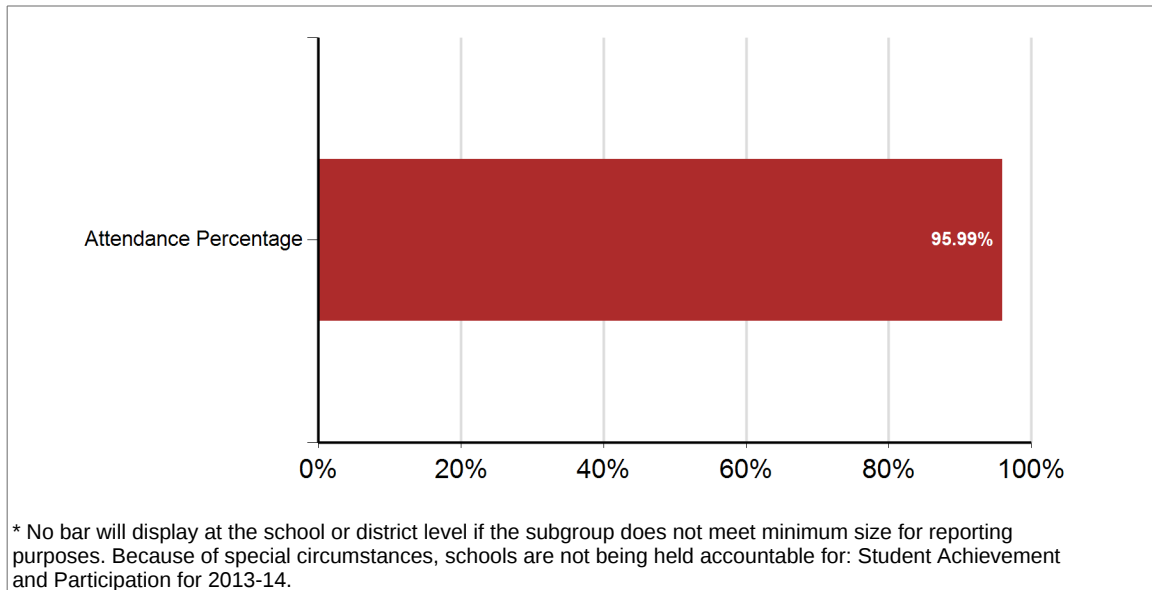

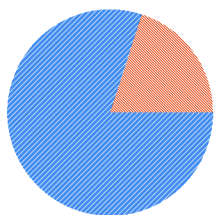

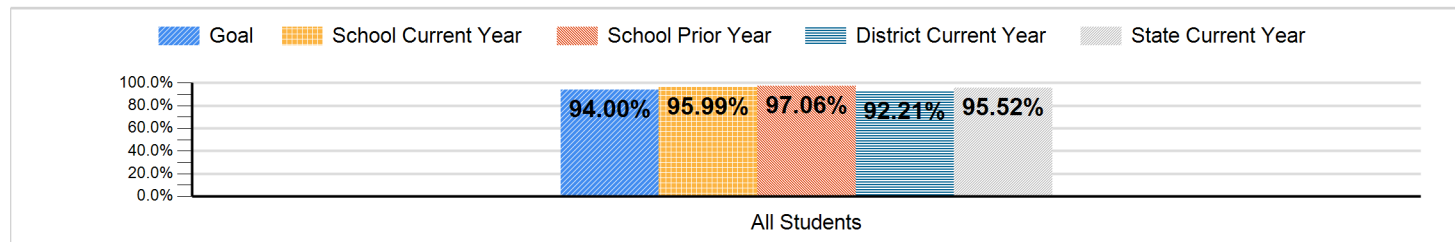

Attendance



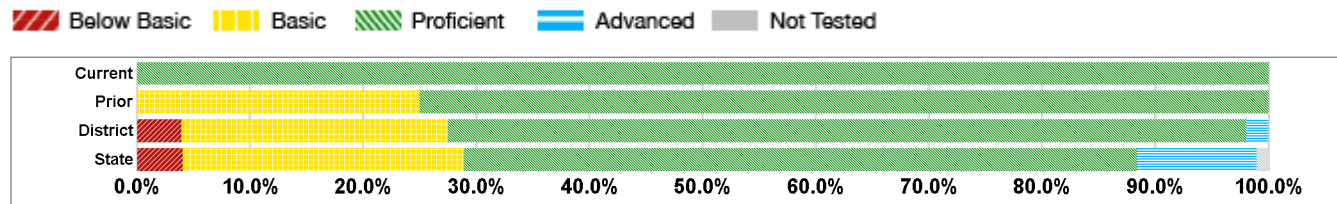

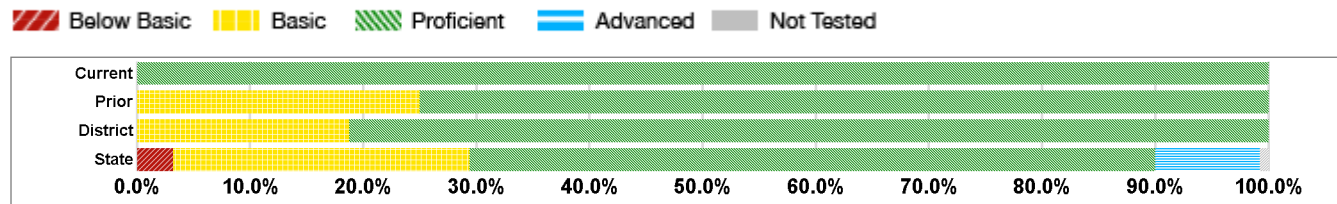
