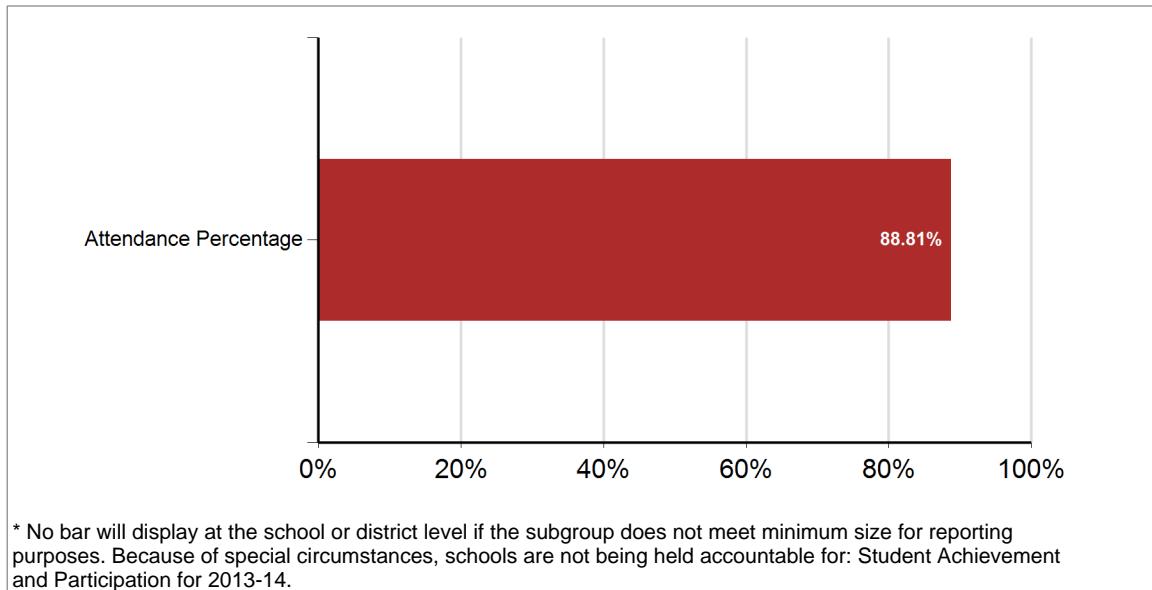

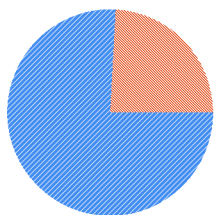

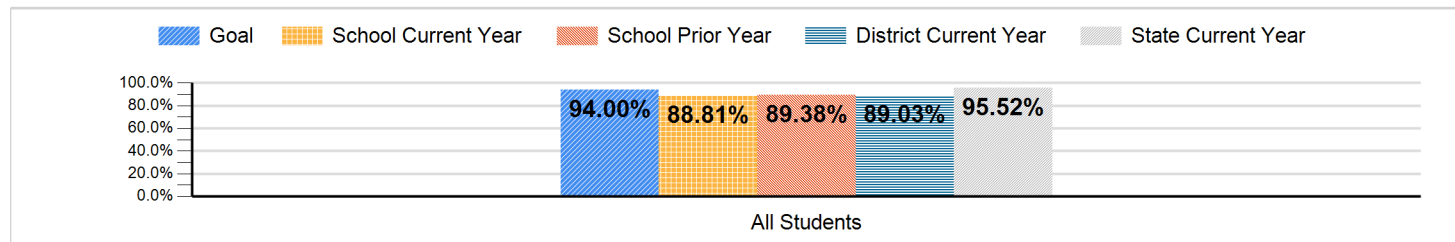

Attendance



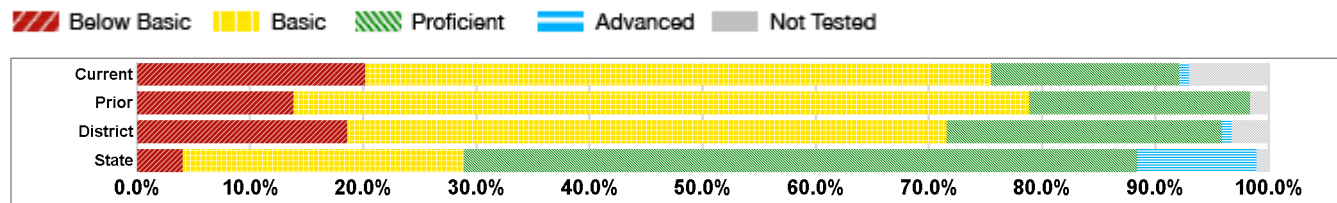

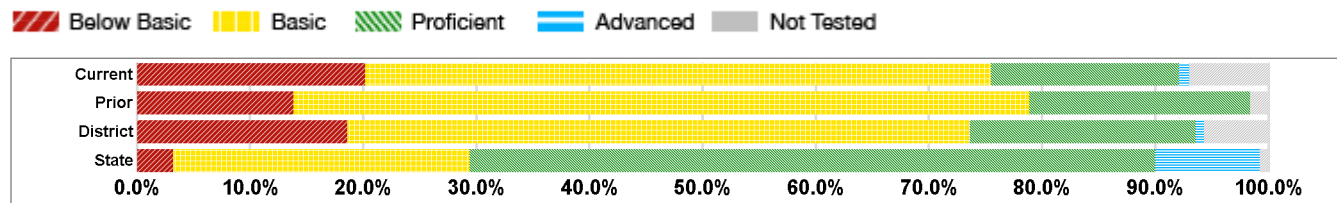
