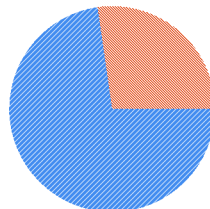

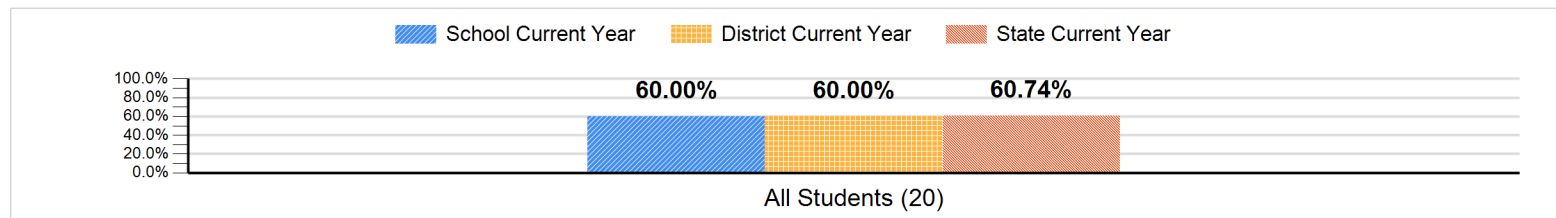
Student Population

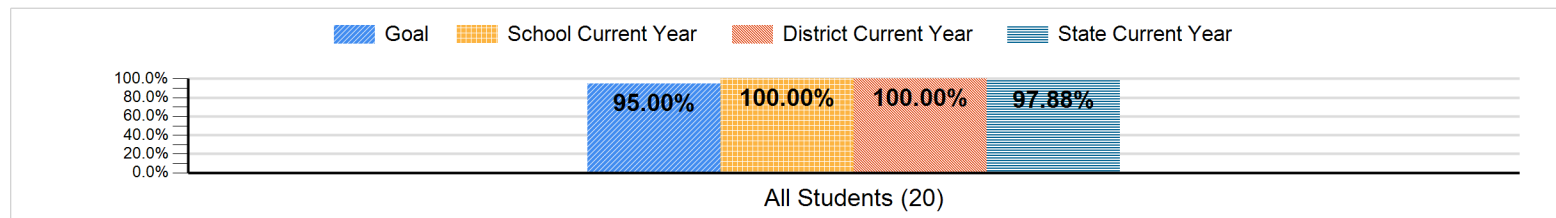

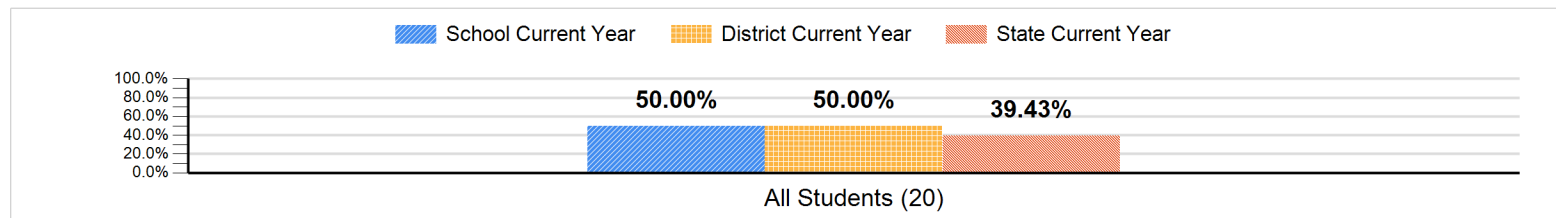

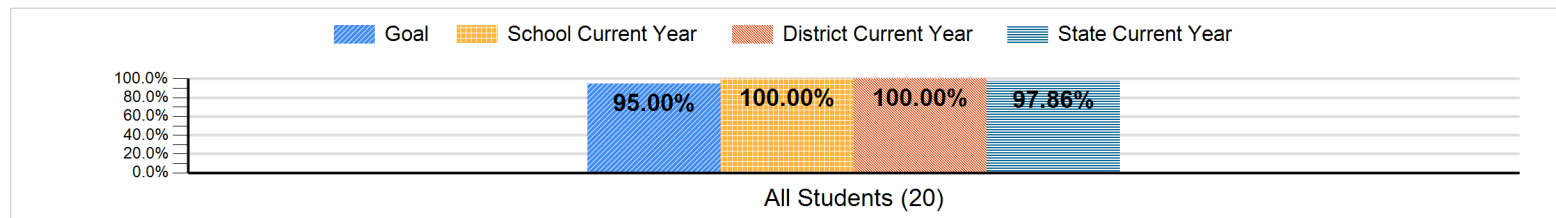

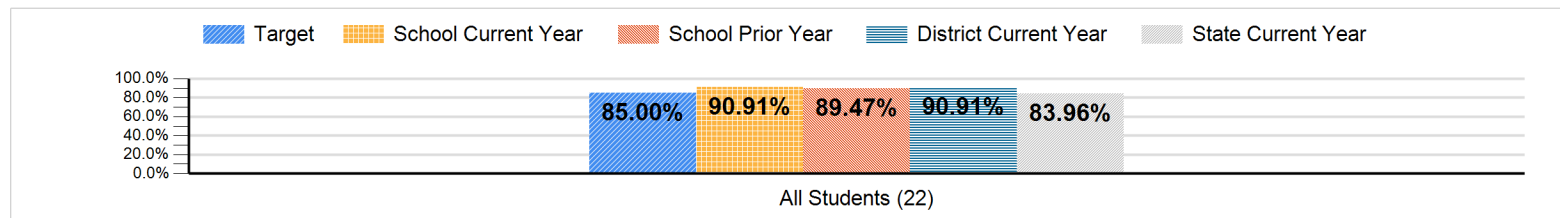

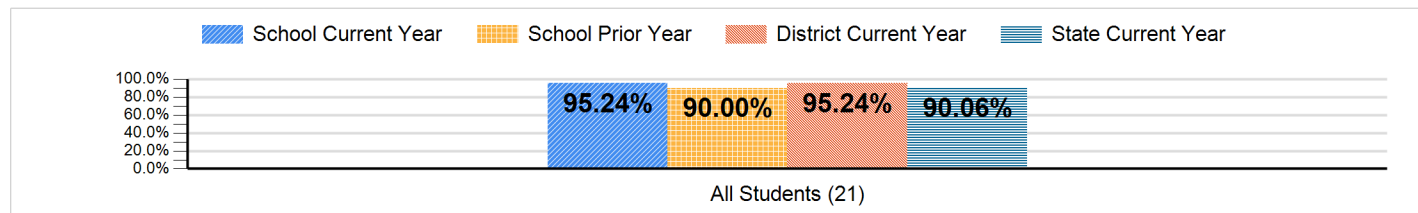
