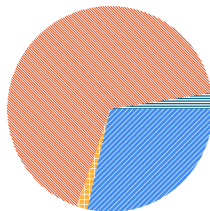

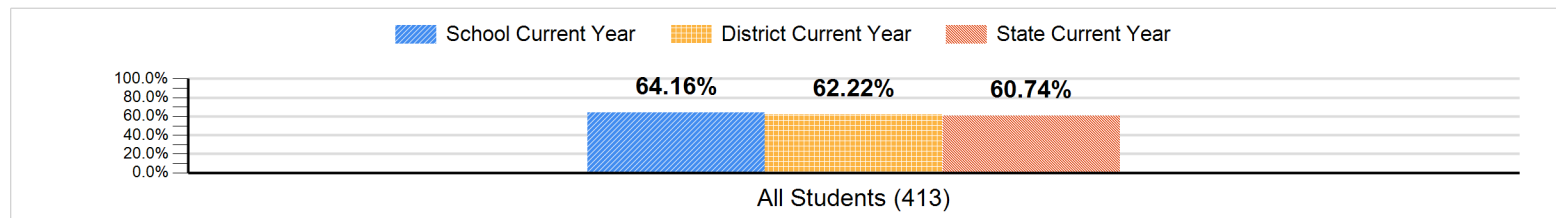
Student Population

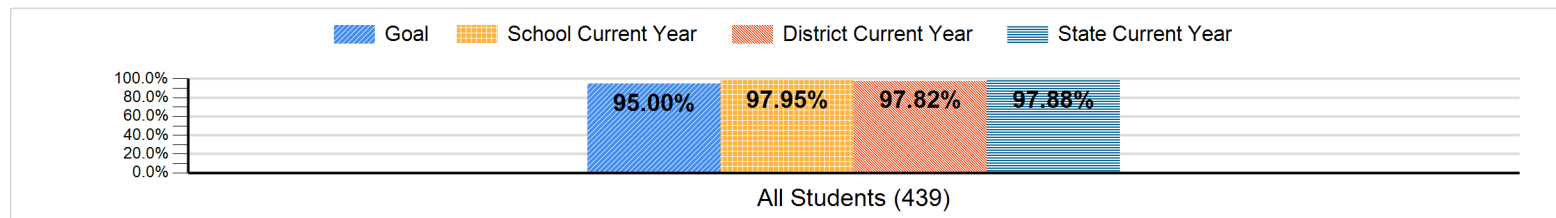

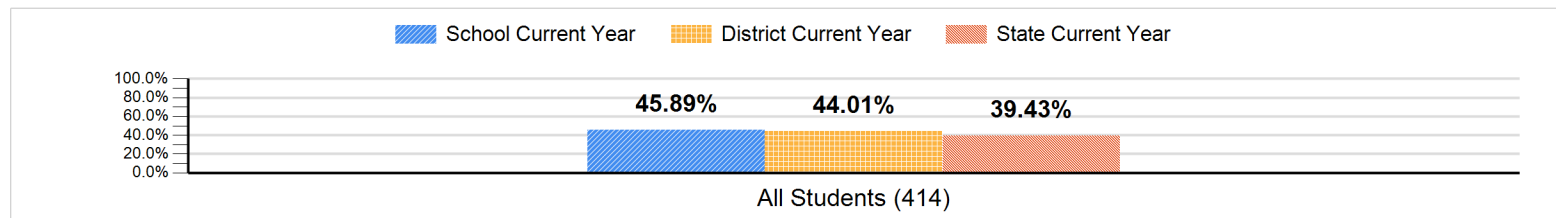

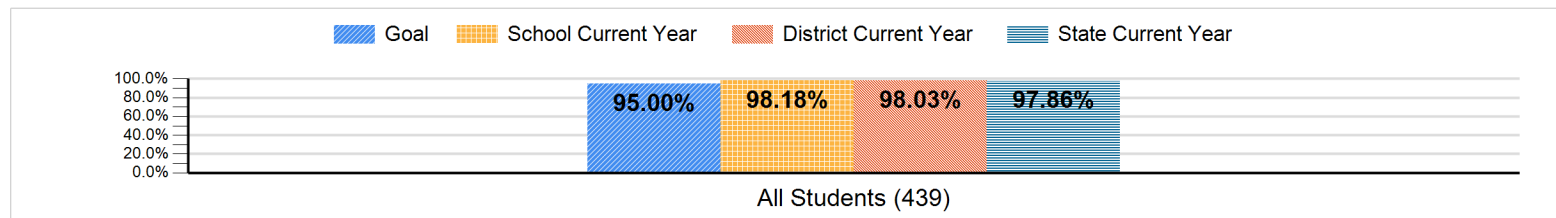

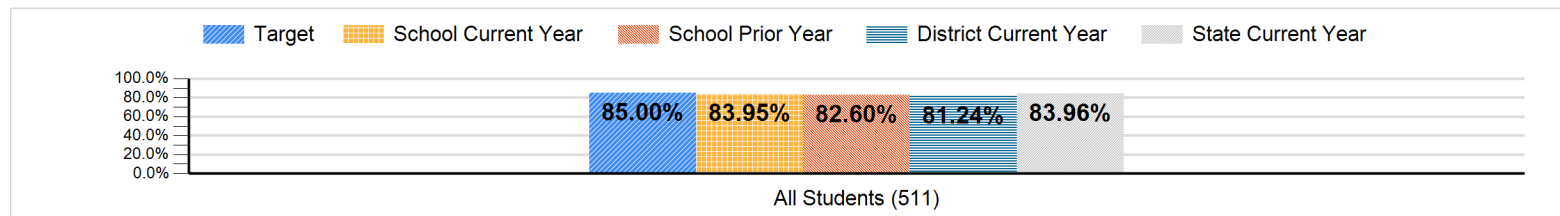

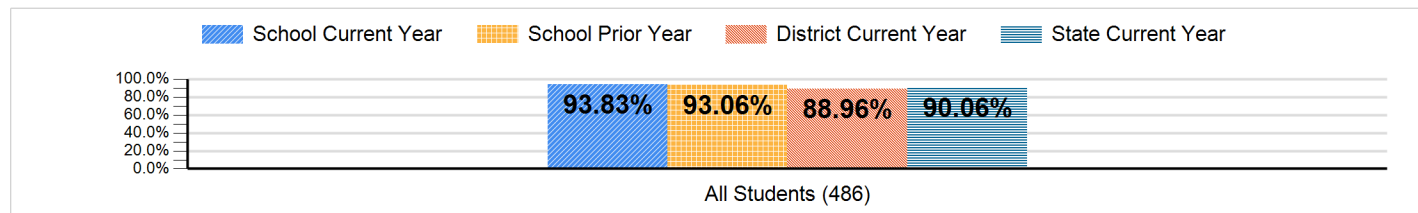

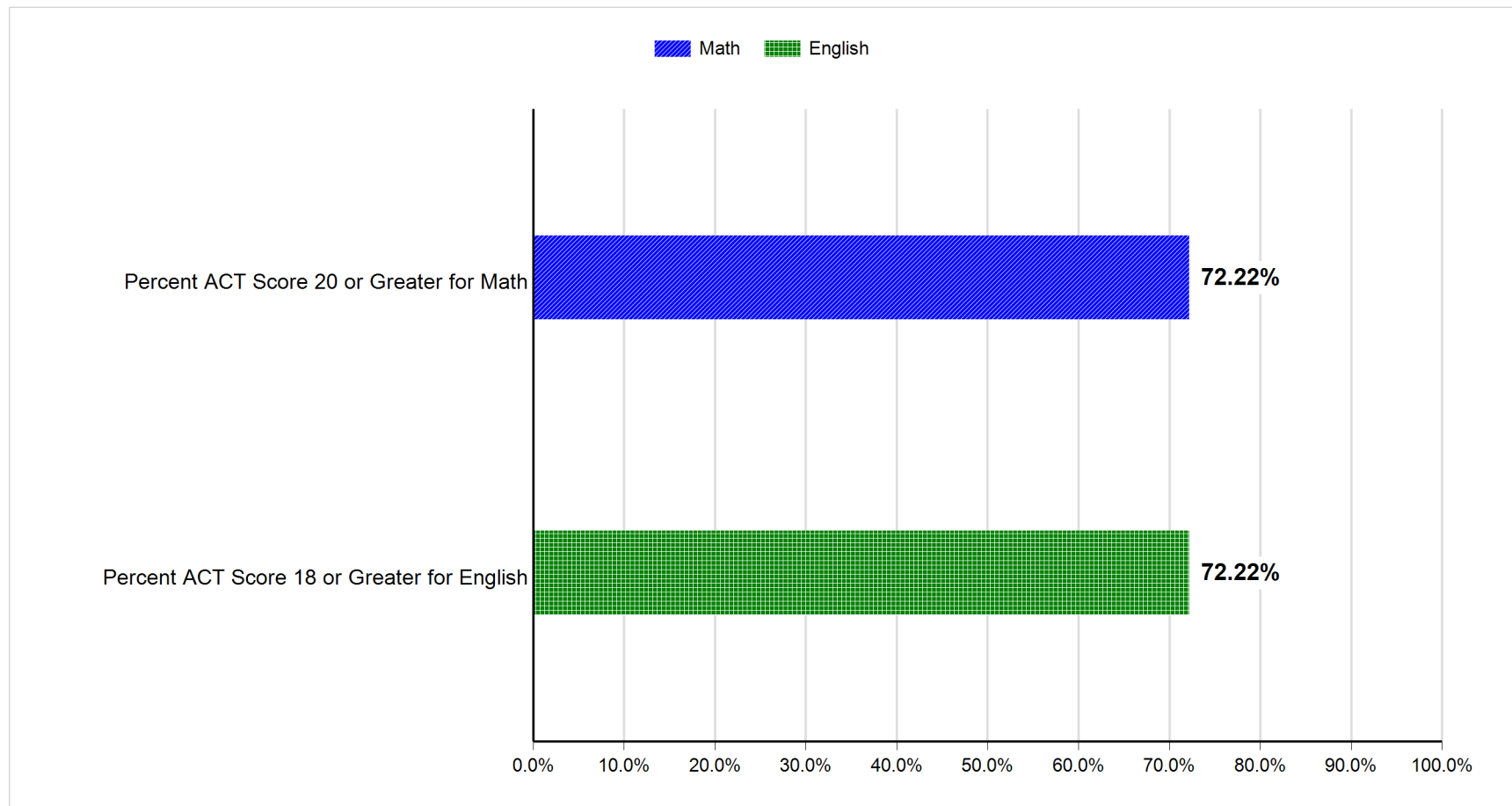

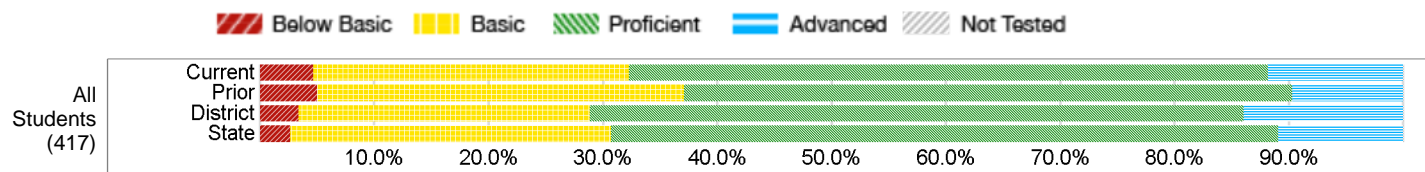
