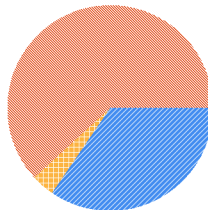

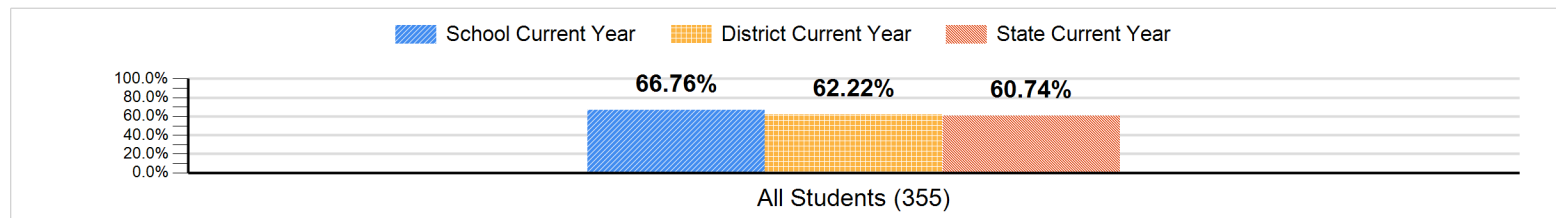
Student Population

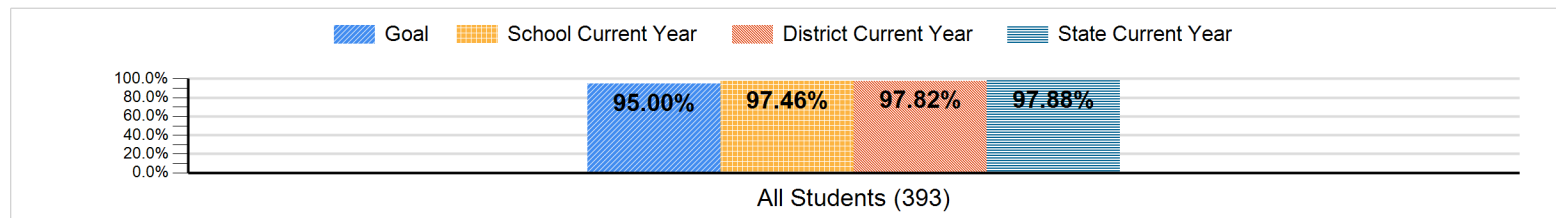

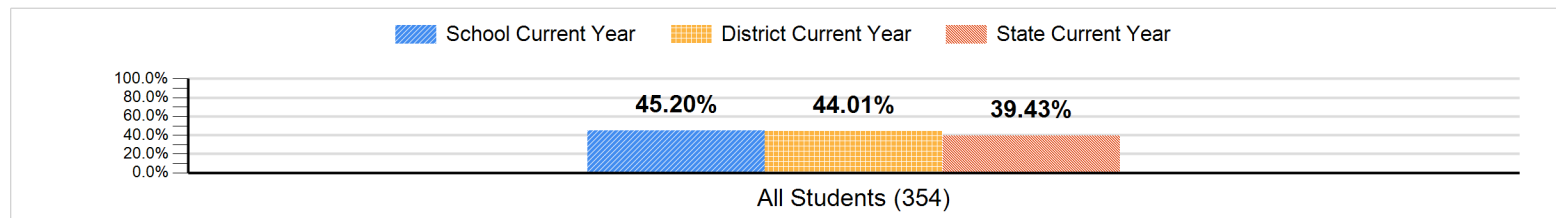

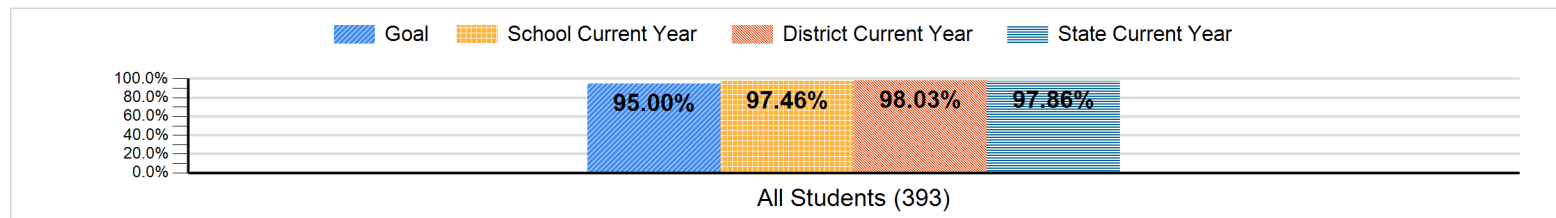

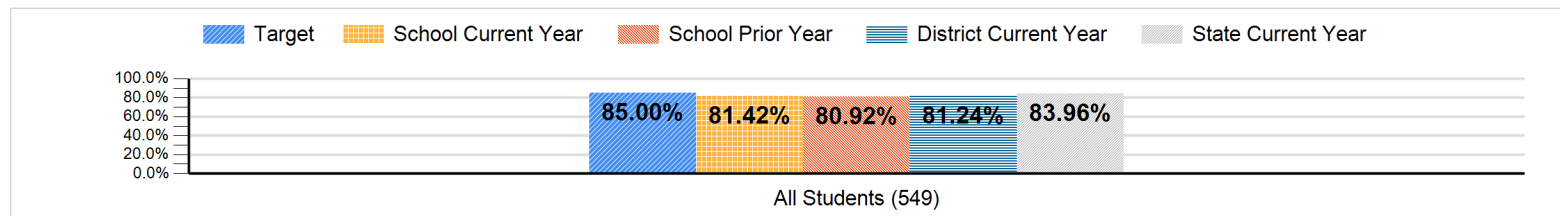

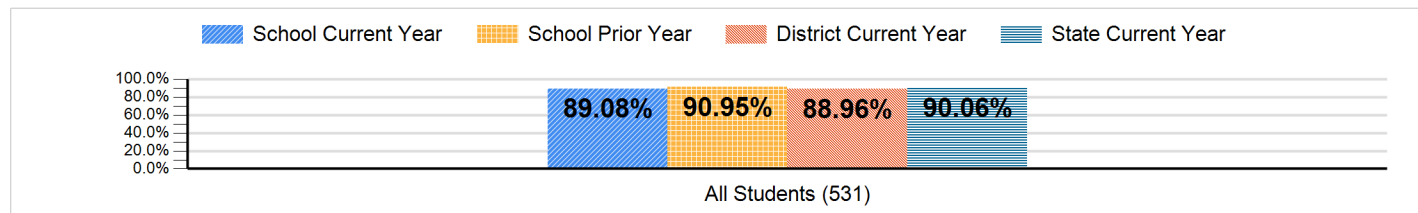
