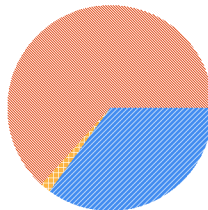

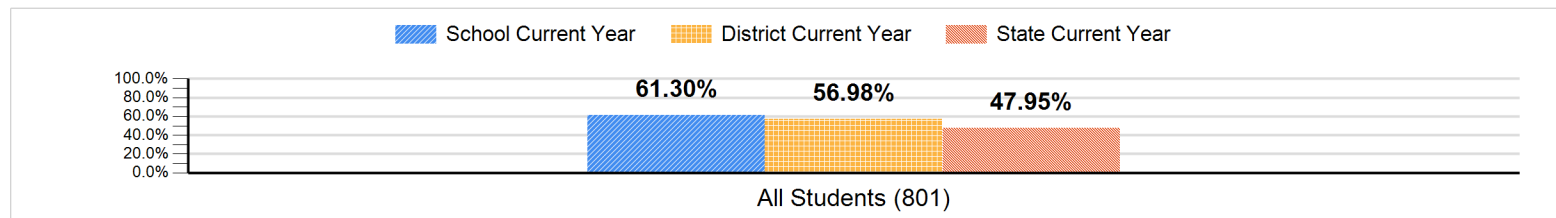
Student Population

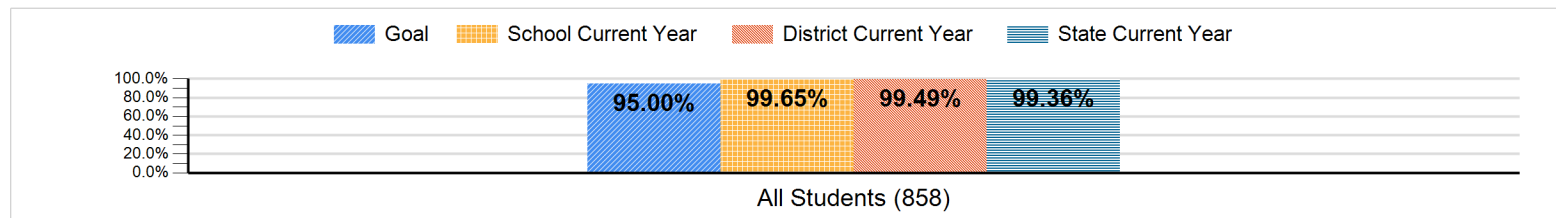

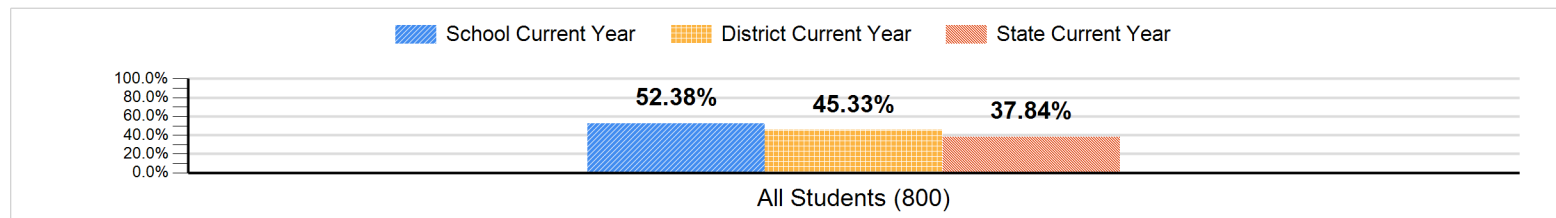

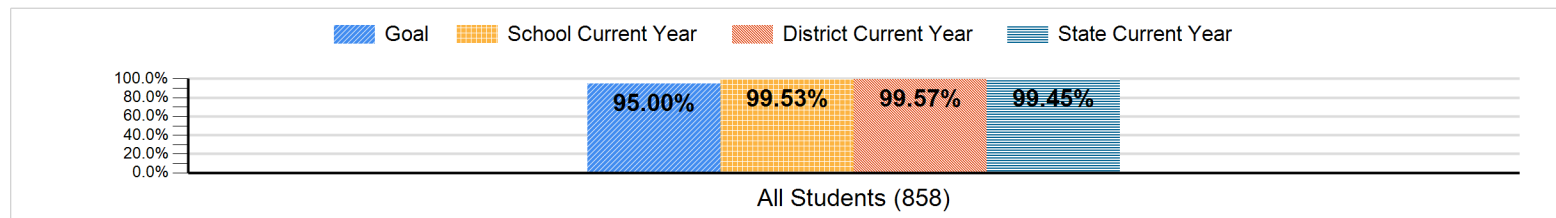

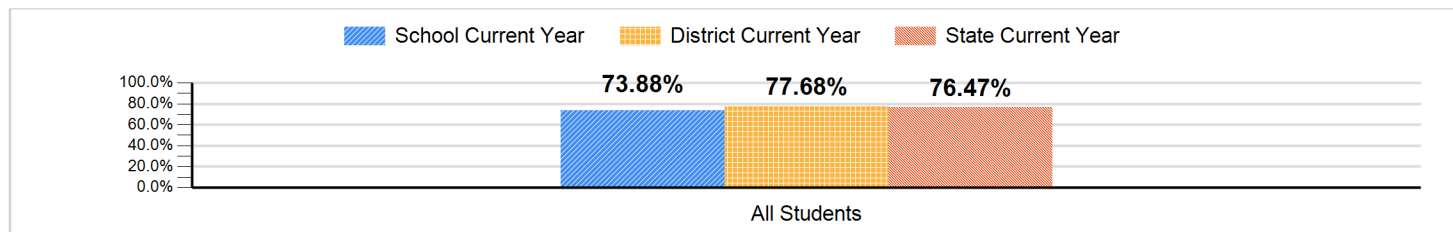
