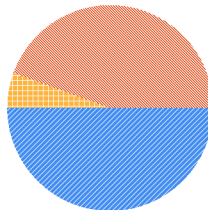

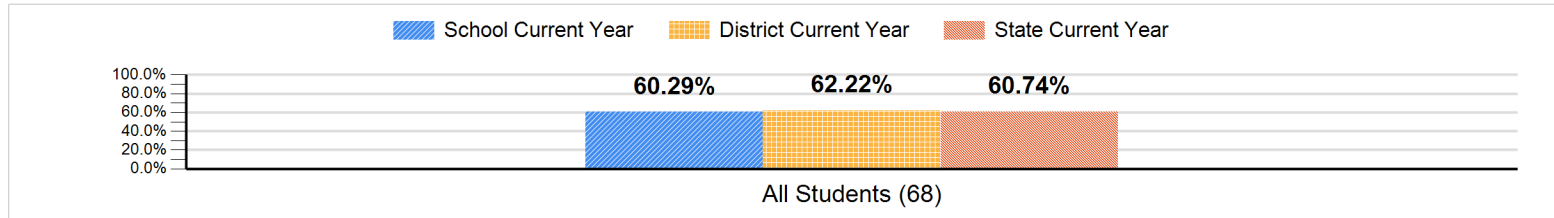
Student Population

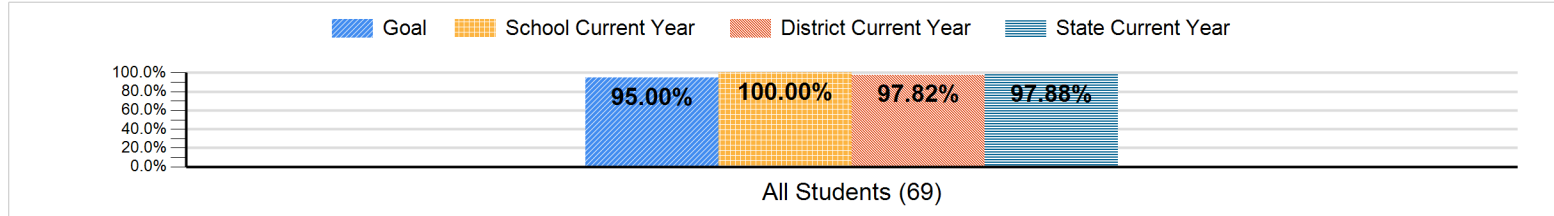

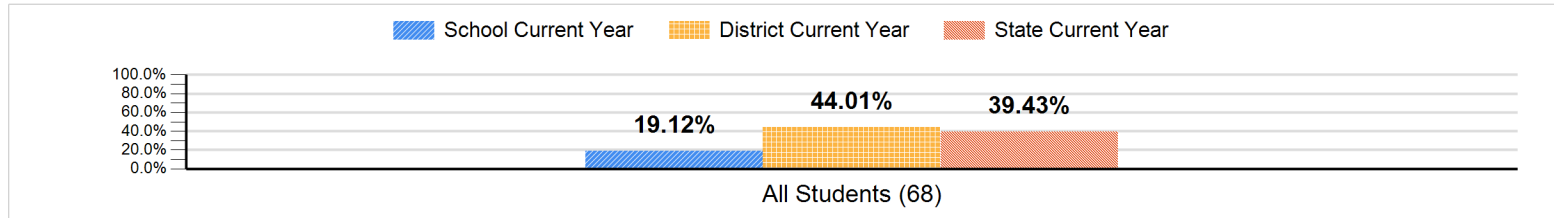

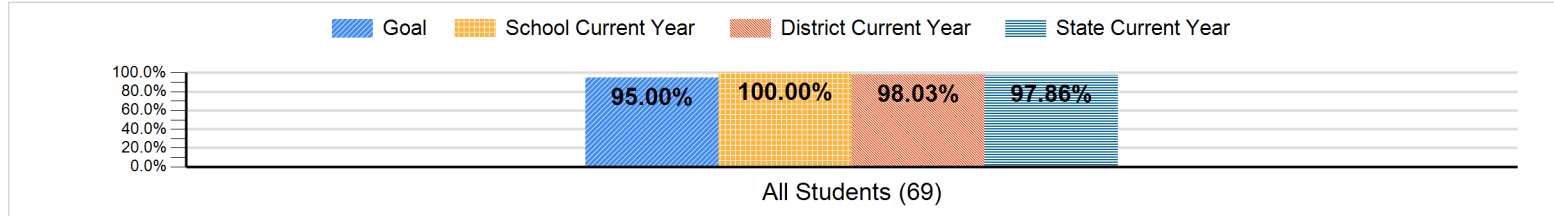

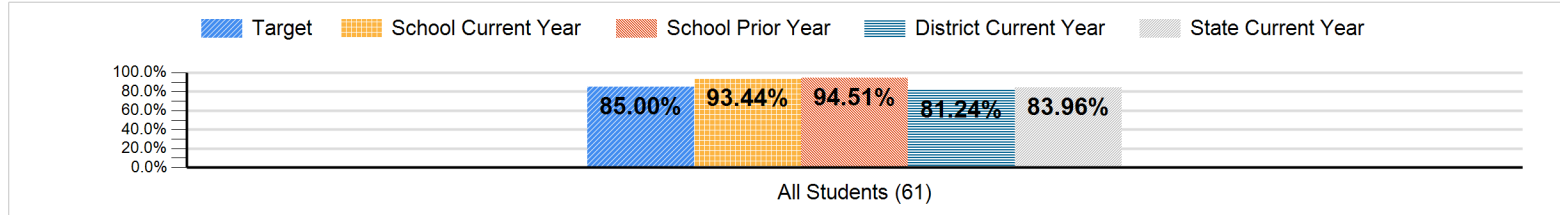

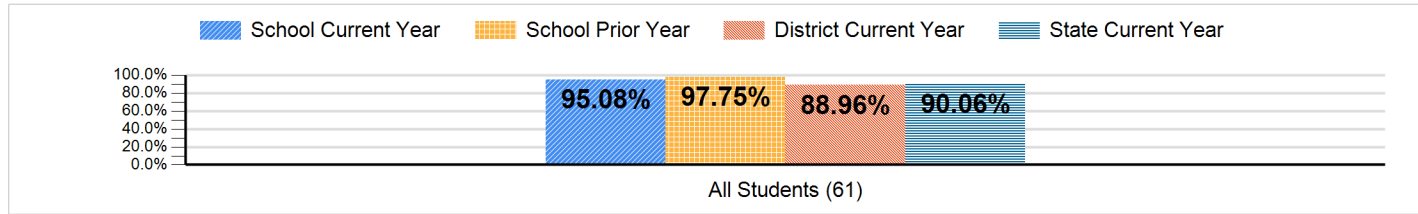
