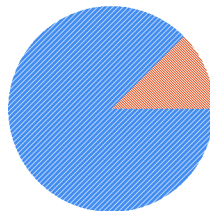

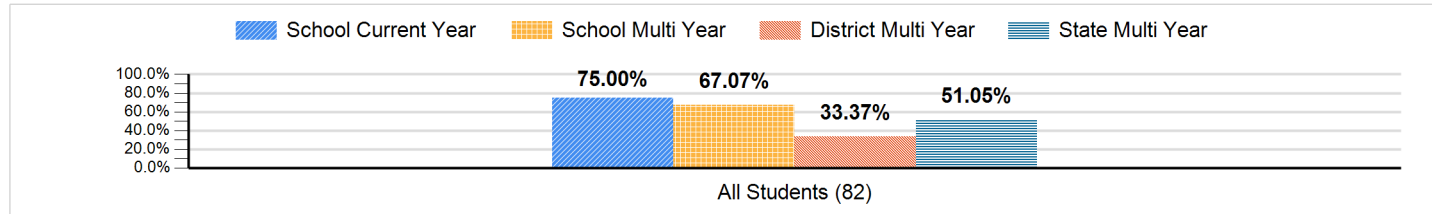
Student Population

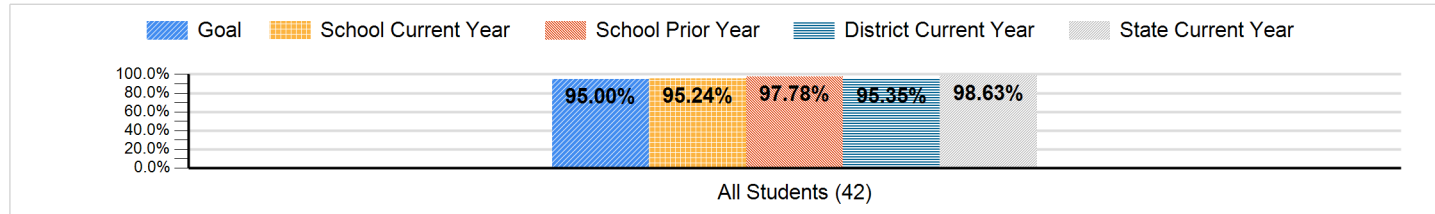

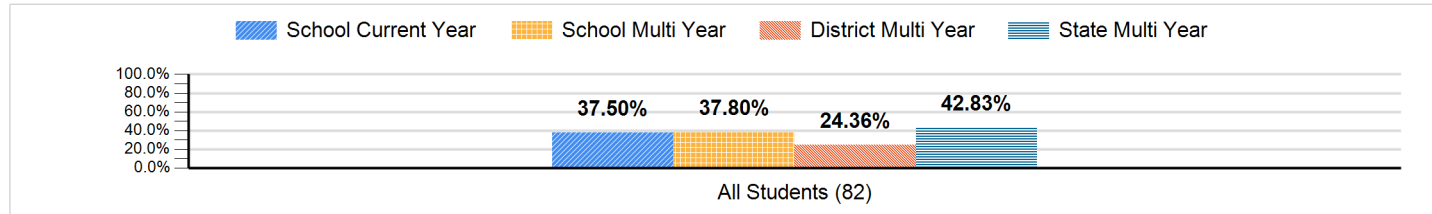

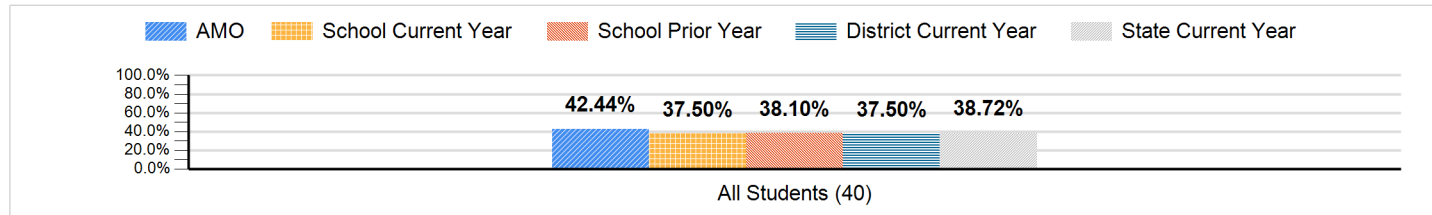

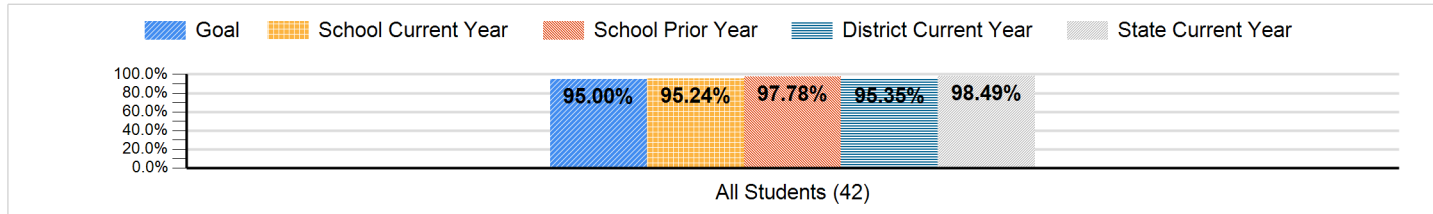

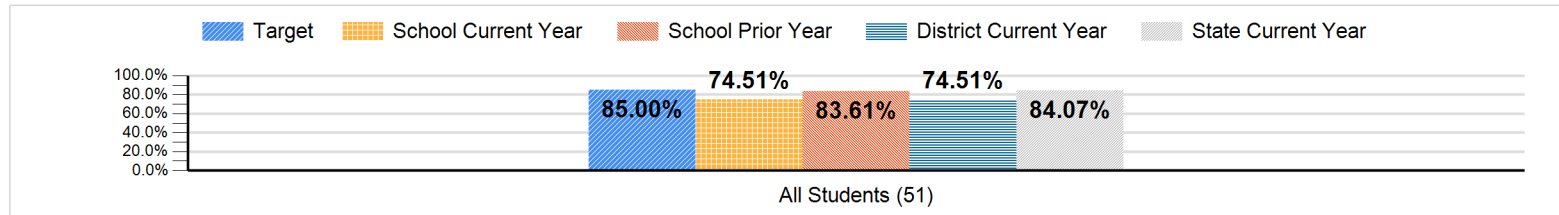

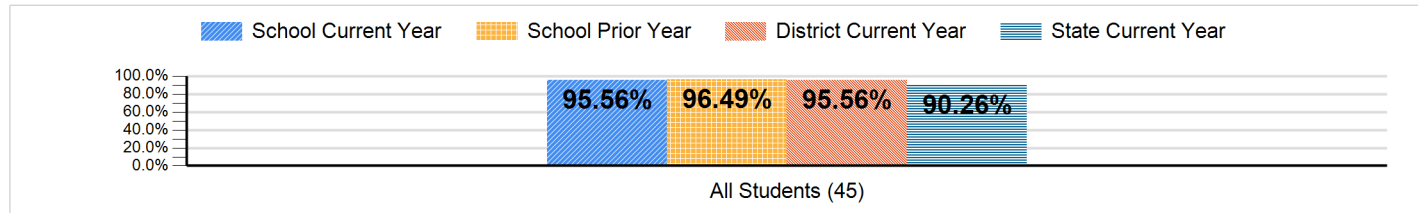
