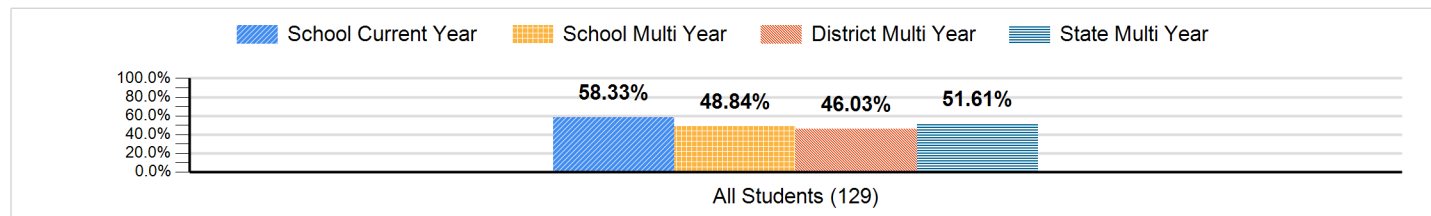
Student Population

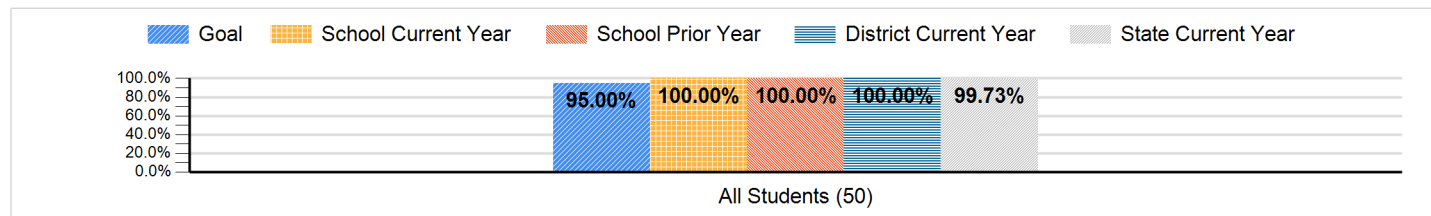

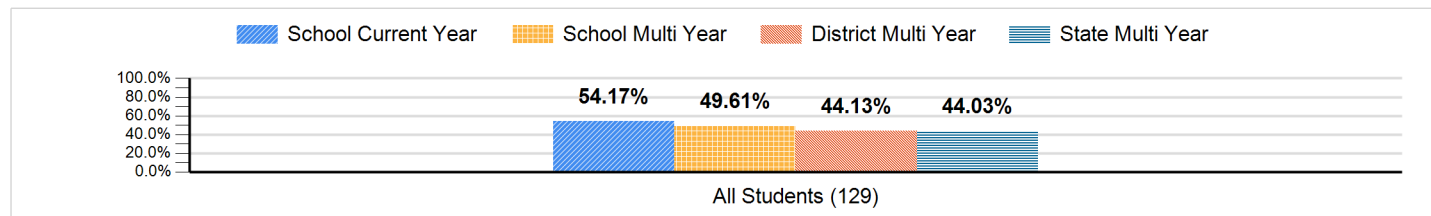

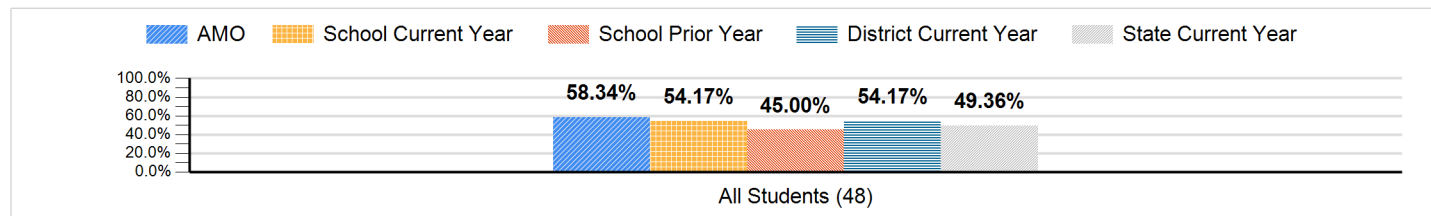

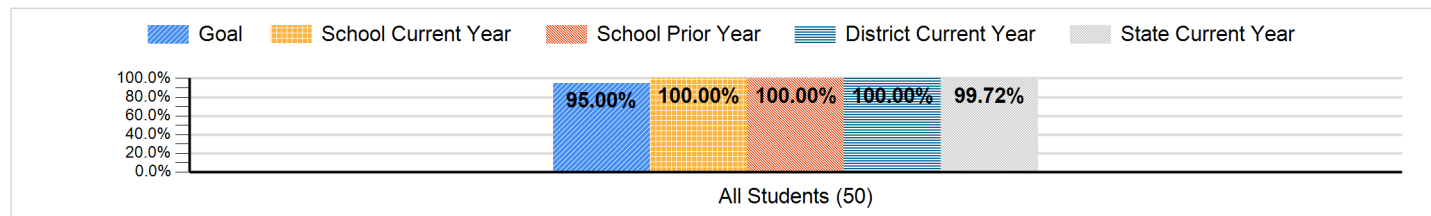

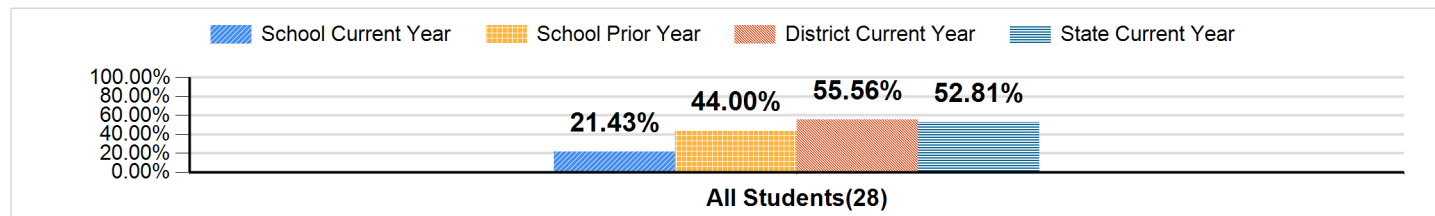

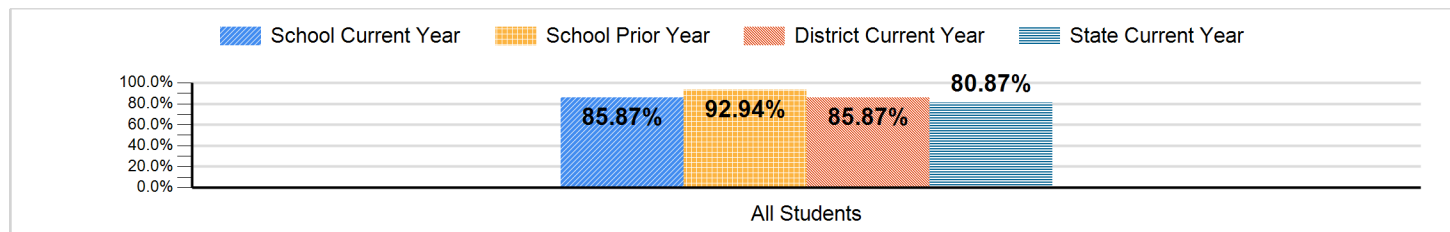
