Information about Mr. Brown to the Accountability Board

In the summer of 2013, Mr. Brown was driving a bus of volleyball players to a camp where he was in an accident with students traveling in a car resulting in a fatality. John tried to avoid the head-on collision; however, was unable to get the bus out of the line of the on-coming car. Following this horrible event, Mr. Brown received a neck injury that has been hindering his health since 2013. Health impairments included: severe neck pains causing numbness to his shoulders and extremities; his neck was almost immobile by the end of a work day in addition to the psychological effect that the student fatality has been on him. He has had several different physicians and various treatments to deal with complications from the accident with little to no relief from the treatments. Though he remained a full time teacher until the year 2015, his injuries prevented him from performing his teaching duties to his fullest capacity. With that being said, he regretfully resigned his duties as middle school science teacher and applied for early retirement through the South Dakota Retirement System. Knowing we may not be successful in finding a middle school science teacher, we had to get creative to fill the position. We asked John if there would be any way possible for him to teach part of the day to help us with our dilemma. As a 30 year science teacher in this district, we knew our students would receive quality education under his guidance. John agreed to "try" to help us out providing he was allowed to leave and rest when necessary, and this is when he came back and help the district in our time of need. Though it remains difficult for him on his half day employment (he works until noon), he has been faithful in helping our district until we find a full time science teacher. Throughout all the changes to his retirement decisions and his disabilities hindered from this accident, John failed to recertify his teaching credentials. He is now working on his letter in intent and teacher recertification.

John is one of those people who gives much time and talent to the students and our school, and retiring was a very difficult decision on his part. We humbly ask that you honor our hardship medical request for this very unusual and life changing series of events.

Attached you will find an October 11, 2016 PRF copy of Mr. Brown's plan of intent documents. The first document lists 03159 which is High School Physical Science that Mr. Brown did not teach. The retirement box was marked, saved, reported and never revisited. The second document, 53239 General Science was also marked as retirement, saved, reported and never revisited and hence no follow up through email as was done with the previous three staff members.

There was no ill will, intent or any reason whatsoever to deceive.

While traveling home from another successful day of volleyball team camp, an experience that has forever changed my life took place. While driving the team bus with 21 student athletes and my assistant coach as passengers, we were struck head on by a vehicle that was rear ended and thrown into my driving lane. Since that summer day of July 22nd of 2013, I have continued to experience excruciating pain in my upper torso, throughout my neck and shoulders and into the cranial region. It has also been an emotional rollercoaster as daily events that occur continue to remind me of that horrifying event.

I was diagnosed with severe whiplash of the 3rd and 4th cervical vertebra. On a daily basis, my neck region will develop a burning sensation and then continue to bleed out through my shoulders and up and down my spinal area. As the day progresses, the burning and pain increases with any activity that I partake in. Working hard with my doctors, school administrators and my family, we have tried everything possible to reach a full recovery. In the end, all treatments have been short term fixes and it has come down to just learning to manage the pain as each day goes by.

The information that I feared to hear came after my spine surgeon examined my x-rays and told me the news. The good news was that surgery was not recommended. The doctor told my family that he could realign my vertebra, but that would not fix my problem. It could possibly do more damage to the neck. The bad news is, there is no fix. He went on to say there is a tremendous amount of nerve damage and the plan was to keep me as comfortable and pain free as possible. I was totally devastated and the challenge was on.

My therapy began with pain killers, cold and heat packs and eventually led to acupuncture and physical therapy. Every treatment was just a short term fix. It would boost my moral for a short period of time and then the pain would be back and seemed to get worse and worse as time progressed. Full days of teaching were just getting to difficult. The pain would begin early in the day and continue throughout the afternoon. Severe headaches and extreme pain from the shoulders down the middle of my back were a daily occurrence. I also had to stop doing all activities; from coaching volleyball and basketball to riding bike, golfing, bowling, just to name a few. The worst time for me today is the winter months. The cold weather irritates my upper torso more than anything else. So, my only answer to assist in my full recovery was to retire from doing what I have loved to do for over 30 years.

I approached my administration with the news and they felt as bad as I did. These people have been in my corner from day one. Their hearts have always been in the right place. The administration and school board have been so compassionate and tremendously concerned with my health from day one. They have bent over backwards for me during my road to recovery. Due to the dwindling number of teachers in the science field, the administration approached me about working halftime. I was totally surprised but extremely honored. This is just one of many examples as to what these fine people do for their educators and students. At that point in time, I was willing to try anything. With that being said and the excitement of possibly working with students again on a part time basis, I completely forgot to renew my certificate by the October 1 deadline.

Today I am still trying to manage my pain levels on a daily basis. From sleepless nights, to excruciating pains throughout the day. Every day is a new challenge. What has benefited me the most is my ability to go home at 12:15 and lay down for an hour or more and allow the burning to bleed out. I can't tell you enough how much I appreciate the compassion and support that I have received from my administration and school board. These are quality people doing exactly what they are intended to do by going above and beyond to assist their staff and students to become the best people they can become.

This situation has filled me with regret and my hope is you will respectfully grant the Clark School District a waiver to avoid any financial penalty.

Attached you will find a PRF copy and three emails of communication between the school and staff members asking for information the DOE needed to complete their plan of intent. The plans were completed by each staff member and all three were filed and accepted by the DOE. This is the process the Clark School District has used and followed the past 16 years when dealing with non – certified staff members.

ATTEST Board Chairperson, Robert Steffen Mary Nelson Business Manager Clark School District Corrective Actions from the November 16, 2017, Accountability Hearing in Pierre.

According to the information from the state, there was a difference of \$68,856 from what the state provided the school district and what was actually spent on salaries during the 2016-2017 school year. The difference was based on absorbing one teacher's salary due to late resignation and a half time teacher's failure to get recertified.

Upon decisions made at the accountability board review, it is our understanding that the salary of the teacher who didn't recertify \$32,187 was deducted from the \$68,856 as this teacher was granted a Hardship Waiver from the state department. This brought our total amount that needed to accounted for to \$36,669.

As stated at the accountability hearing, we spent the money during the negotiations process for the 2017-2018 school year as our teachers' received an extra \$1,000 in salary and an additional \$1440 toward insurance benefits. The \$2440 of offered benefits to the staff took care of absorbing the loss of a teacher concluding the 2016-2017 school year, plus accounted for the cost of living raise provided by the state for this current school year. Please see attached benefit sheet.
