RE: WIDA Assessment Management System (WIDA AMS) Login and Profile

Your state will begin administering the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Assessment Monday, January 30, 2017 to Friday, March 3, 2017. In order to assist with test management for this assessment, you have been provided with a WIDA AMS account that will allow you to access everything you need to prepare for the online and paper tests.


Your WIDA AMS user account has been <u>updated</u> to the current school year. You will receive an email stating that your WIDA AMS profile has been updated. If you have accounts in your district that need to be deactivated due to transfers or retirements, that is the responsibility of the District Test Coordinator. If you need assistance on how to deactivate, manage, or add user accounts, please review the WIDA AMS User Guide located on the WIDA website (wida.us) or on WIDA AMS (wida-ams.us). Click on General Information and then Documents. Choose Manuals for the Document Type drop-down and click Show Documents.

WIDA AMS Account


WIDA AMS (wida-ams.us) has undergone some enhancements over the summer and will require users to agree to a new security agreement and create a new password to the website upon initial log in.

For the 2016-2017 administration, WIDA AMS will have an updated user interface. The Log In screen will now appear as follows:



NEW: You no longer need to call DRC Customer Support for log in issues. You will be able to reset your own password if you forgot it, or you are having difficulty logging on.

Once you log in to WIDA AMS, the Left Hand Navigation Menu Screen appears horizontally along the top.

Wida.us Account

Please go to the WIDA website (<u>www.wida.us</u>) and log in at the top right hand side of the page to access the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 training course materials for the test(s) you will administer. Please remember, your WIDA AMS account is separate from your wida.us account.



To enhance the training experience, WIDA will provide robust video tutorials with knowledge checks and assessments concerning all facets of testing procedures throughout the ACCESS testing window. These tutorials replace the training checklist that was used for the 2015-2016 school year. Districts and states will be able to monitor the progression of training for any users within their jurisdiction. Training Tutorials include:

- Training Overview
- Ordering Materials
- Managing Test Materials
- Accessibility Overview
- Assigning Accommodations
- Test Scheduling
- Test Practice and Test Tickets (online only)
- Administering the Test
- After Testing

There are two new quizzes on wida.us that new Test Administrators and those required to recertify must pass with a score of 80% or higher. These include an Online Administration Quiz and a Paper Administration Quiz for Grades 1-12. The training tutorials, along with the training course pages, provide Test Administrators the knowledge they need to pass the quiz.

As part of the training, you will be able to review the WIDA AMS User Guide, as well as manuals geared to your role with testing; either the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Test Administrator Manual, or the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 District and School Test Coordinator Manual.

WIDA also reorganized the ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 manuals to streamline and consolidate information. Now, there is one manual for test administrators and another for test coordinators. The Test Administrator Manual contains information for Test Administrators

responsible for ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Online, ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Paper, Kindergarten ACCESS for ELLs, and Alternate ACCESS for ELLs. Administration procedures for all four assessments are located in one manual. The District and School Test Coordinator Manual contains information for individuals responsible for coordinating and managing testing in a school or district.

Many policies and procedures related to testing vary in each state. WIDA is working with your state education agency to create an ACCESS for ELLs 2.0 Checklist. The checklist will include tasks that your state education agency requires you to complete as well as state-specific guidance. Depending on your state's testing window, WIDA will be posting your state's checklist in the training course and on your state page at www.wida.us/membership/states in September or October. Please review your member state page on the WIDA website by selecting the map on the bottom right.
