

South Dakota Board of Education Standards
Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at Holgate Middle School Theater, 2200 N Dakota Street, Aberdeen, South Dakota, on Monday, September 17, 2018, at 9:00 a.m. Central Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules:

Article 24:28 (Educator Certification), Chapters 24:28:01 (Definitions), 24:28:09 (Educator Permit Requirements), and 24:28:17 (Certification Renewal).

The effect and purpose of the proposed changes to Chapters 24:28:01, 24:28:09, and 24:28:17 is to remove the requirements for paraprofessional educators to obtain and renew state-issued certificates.
