

REPORT HIGHLIGHTS

Average response rate is 87.78% across all institutions

The top three cluster areas in terms of wages are Manufacturing, STEM programs and Architecture & Construction.

Placement/career outcomes continue to be high, as 96.44% of respondents are either employed, in the military or pursuing continuing education.
