Notice of Public Hearing to Adopt Rules

A public hearing will be held at Western Dakota Technical Institute, Dakota Lecture Hall, 800 Mickelson Drive, Rapid City, South Dakota, on May 20, 2013, at 1:00 p.m. Mountain Time, to consider the adoption and amendment of proposed rules numbered

24:15:03:05

The effect of the changes to 24:15:03:05 will result in higher fees for teachers who apply for initial or for renewing a teacher certificate.

The reason for the changes to 24:15:03:05, which increases teacher certification fees, is due to revenues from the fund not meeting the annual expenditures and the fund balance is decreasing to a point that the fund will not be able to support the ongoing cost of the teacher certification program and professional practices boards.

Persons interested in presenting data, opinions, and arguments for or against the proposed rules may do so by appearing in person at the hearing or by sending them to the South Dakota Department of Education, Attn: Ferne Haddock 800 Governors Drive, Pierre, South Dakota 57501-2294. Material sent by mail must reach the Department of Education by May 17, 2013, to be considered.

After the hearing, the board will consider all written and oral comments it receives on the proposed rules. The board may modify or amend a proposed rule at that time to include or exclude matters that are described in this notice.

Notice is further given to individuals with disabilities that this hearing is being held in a physically accessible place.
