

## Educator Permits for Teachers

<a href="#">ARSD 24:28:09</a>	DESCRIPTION
<b>CTE Instructor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows individuals without a teaching degree to teach a limited number of CTE courses.</li> <li>Not considered an alternative route to certification and upon completion of requirements, applicants cannot add endorsements other than the ones available through this permit.</li> </ul>
<b>Expert Lecturer</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows applicants with distinctive qualifications and experiences to teach a specific course which adds unique learning opportunities for students.</li> <li>Not intended to fill a vacant position.</li> </ul>
<b>Performing Artist</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Designed to allow districts flexibility in the areas of art, dance, drama, and music when district is unable to hire a certified teacher.</li> </ul>
<b>International Exchange Teacher</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows teachers from another country to teach in South Dakota for 5 years.</li> <li>Does not allow applicants to receive a full teacher certificate and is non-renewable.</li> </ul>
<b>Native American Language and Culture</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows individuals without a teaching degree to teach the Lakota language and culture.</li> <li>Applicants must demonstrate knowledge of the language and culture.</li> </ul>
<b>Eminent Scholar Language and Culture</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows individuals without a teaching degree to teach the Lakota language and culture.</li> <li>Applicants must demonstrate knowledge of the language and culture and meet requirements for the Eminent Scholar Program.</li> </ul>
<b>American Sign Language Instructor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows applicants without a teaching degree to serve as instructor of American sign language.</li> </ul>
<b>Braille Education Instructor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows applicants without a teaching degree to serve as instructors for blind or visually impaired students.</li> </ul>
<b>Junior ROTC Instructor</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows applicants without a teaching degree to serve as instructors for ROTC assignments.</li> </ul>
<b>Library Science Permit</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows applicants without a teaching degree to serve as a school librarian.</li> </ul>

## Educator Permits for Administrators/Other Areas

<b>CEO Educator</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows individuals without a teaching degree to teach a limited number of CTE courses.</li> <li>Not considered an alternative route to certification and upon completion of requirements, applicants cannot add endorsements other than the ones available through this permit.</li> </ul>
<b>School Business Official</b>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allows applicants to act as a business manager for a district. This permit is not required.</li> </ul>
