South Dakota Assessment Portal SDAP

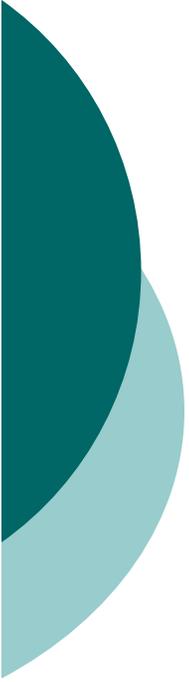
- What is it?
 - **The South Dakota Assessment Portal is an online resource to help educators create, deliver and track formative and summative assessments for their students and is available at no-cost to all school districts across the state.**

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Three Main Components

- **TestBuilder** - used to create items and test forms. Users can also create and publish tests in TestBuilder.
- **iTester** - allows users to manage or create classes, create student groups for testing, and schedule test sessions for students.
- **Data Interaction** – view data from Dakota Step Test, formative assessments, and End Of Course Tests



Why SDAP?

- Items aligned to Common Core Standards
- Pre-made forms by Common Core Standards
- Create original questions and tests
