


School Improvement Directions School Year 2010-11

Add School Improvement Information

The purpose of this screen is to identify the model or type of plan used for School Improvement. You are not required to submit the actual plan.

STEP #1: Open the PRF, Click on Actions, District Information and then Select School Improvement Plan.



STEP #2: You will see the School Improvement Plan Screen. This screen has a table with four columns.

- Attendance Center is populated with the District Attendance Centers.
- Grade Span is populated with the Attendance Center Grade Spans.
- Improvement Plan column will not be populated unless the Attendance Center is Title I Schoolwide.
- Icon that should be selected to add the Improvement Plan.

NOTE: If an attendance center is Title I Schoolwide then the Improvement Plan will automatically default to Title I Schoolwide plan and you will not need to identify a plan for this school.
