Special education report now available online

PIERRE, S.D. – Information regarding school districts’ performance on improving the educational outcomes of students with disabilities is now available online. The Special Education Report is released annually.

The report addresses the federal special education program known as Part B. This report identifies school districts’ ability to meet federal requirements on several indicators along with performance targets. It is based mainly on data from the 2015-16 school year.
