

# Explicit Instruction for K-12 Educators


Explore the foundation of Explicit Instruction, as author and educator Dr. Anita Archer outlines in her book "Explicit Instruction: Effective and Efficient Teaching".

This course will help you to design organized lessons, which are focused on strategies, skills, pacing, and content. Explicit Instruction, or direct instruction has a well-developed research base, and is one of John Hattie's noted **effective means of improving achievement**.

In this workshop, you will discover strategies, skills, tools, and more for implementing well-designed, deliberate, distributed, and cumulative practice. We'll explore how to assess student learning through careful monitoring of your students' responses, followed by how to use corrective and affirmative feedback to maintain orderly and positive classrooms.

## Topics Include

- Day 1: Introduction to Explicit Instruction, Delivering Instruction: Eliciting Frequent Responses (engagement strategies)
- Day 2: Designing Lessons: Skills and Strategies, Select Vocabulary for Explicit Instruction
- Day 3: Judicious Review, Providing Appropriate Practice and Effective Feedback
