

Teacher/Principal Effectiveness & Common Core Timeline: State Provided PD & Technical Assistance

Jan. 31, 2014	Districts choosing “Full Implementation” and planning to use their own measure of professional practice or student growth must submit a crosswalk to show alignment with state model for teacher effectiveness
January-May 2014	<p>State provides one day of coaching for every district:</p> <p>--“Full Implementation” districts may choose to participate in a state-provided coaching day</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Planning for state-funded in-house district PD for SY 2014-15 & 2015-16• Menu of PD options (menu available after Jan. 1, 2014)<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Examples: Fractions; Standards-Based Report Cards, Text-Based Questioning; or additional teacher/principal effectiveness training <p>-- “Planning for Implementation” districts must participate in Teacher/Principal Effectiveness coaching day and develop plan for capacity building and training</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Top priority: Planning for Teacher/Principal Effectiveness• May also include planning for menu of PD options (available after Jan. 1, 2014)<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ Examples: Fractions; Standards-Based Report Cards, Text-Based Questioning; or additional teacher/principal effectiveness training <p>USD online course: Principal Professional Practices</p>
February 2014	State offers train-the-trainer sessions on Student Learning Objectives; districts may apply to send staff to become trainers
March-April 2014	<p>State offers regional one-day training <u>for administrators</u> (anyone who evaluates teachers) on Student Learning Objectives</p> <p>--March 18, Pierre --April 1, Sioux Falls --April 2, Aberdeen --April 9, Rapid City</p>
Summer 2014	<p>State offers regional training <u>for teachers</u> on Student Learning Objectives</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Grouped by grade level for K-5; by content area for 6-12• Day 1 targets <u>all teachers</u>: Teachers gain an understanding of process and develop high quality SLOs• Day 2 targets <u>teachers who are not using pre-made benchmark assessments</u>: Teachers develop appropriate SLO assessments and/or instruments.• \$125/per day stipend <p>Possible SD Education Association SLO Boot Camps</p> <p>USD online course OR Regional training related to Principal Professional Practices</p>

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SY 2014-15 &
2015 & 16

State provides coaching/training days to districts over next two years; districts choose from menu of options; number of days to be determined

- Menu of PD options (menu available after Jan. 1, 2014)
 - Examples: Fractions; Standards-Based Report Cards, Text-Based Questioning; or additional teacher/principal effectiveness training

NOTE: Menu of state-sponsored professional development for SY 2014-15 & 2015-16 will be available after Jan. 1, 2014. Districts that would like to take advantage of state-sponsored in-district PD must submit the chosen PD option(s) and the entity conducting the PD as part of its plan.

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
