Subject: SIG 1003(g) Elementary Amendment

The Superintendent, Principal, and business manager have met and would like to request the following amendment. We would like to add \$3000 to salaries and \$1000 to benefits for extended learning time. After school tutoring will be held once per week for students who need additional help with reading and math. We would also like to move \$4500 to supplies and \$4000 to equipment needed for reading and math materials. Supplies and equipment that we'd like to purchase include the following: reading series, a subscription to a math enrichment site, subscription to the international reading association and their journal, I pads and/or Kindles for in the classrooms and books.

In the past, we had contracted with Pat Stone and Native American Higher Performance Learning which cost our School District a total of \$25,000. We were able to pay half of those contracted services through this grant. This year, our services with Native American Higher Performance Learning were decreased and therefore decreased our costs. As stated above, we would like to use that \$12,500 to offer extended learning time to our students and purchase supplies and equipment.
