Math, ELA, Science, and Alternate Assessment Updates

- Assessment Coordinators Virtual Training. This <u>virtual training</u> is for assessment coordinators who missed our in-person trainings. - Accommodation Tip: Text-to-speech (text read by the computer) or Read Aloud (text read by a certified teacher) as a designated support should be one or the other NOT BOTH. This helps DOE to understand the needs of the students. If a district chooses Read Aloud by a certified teacher, this could stress resources due to the testing window being shorter and the need for this support to be one-on-one is a separate setting.
