Math, ELA, Science, and Alternate Assessment Updates

- MSAA (SD-Math Alt and SD-ELA Alt) Window Opens Monday. The MSAA window is March 11 to April 26.
 This assessment is the alternate assessment for math and ELA and is for students with the most severe cognitive disabilities. A sample MSAA Parent Letter is available for districts to personalize and send to the parents of students who will be participating. Just a reminder, this assessment must be administered one-on-one. - Making Changes to Students in the MSAA System for the math and ELA alternate assessments. Districts
 MUST send changes for MSAA to <u>DOEassessment@state.sd.us</u>. They are not automatic. This includes if you
 receive a new student or if a student leaves.

- May 2-3, 2024 Printed Score reports arrive in district
- o Sept. 12, 2024 Alt ACCESS Scores available online
- o Sept. 24, 2024 Alt ACCESS scores arrive in district
- <u>First Year in Country Students</u>. The following information must be filled out in Infinite Campus for a student to be exempt from the state ELA assessment. This information is found under Census>People>Demographics (To qualify for exemption for SY 2023-24, enrollment would be from May 2, 2023 May 1, 2024)

 - 2. Date Entered US
 - 3. Date Entered US School
 - 4. Home Primary Language
