Math, ELA, Science, and Alternate Assessment Updates

- **FERPA Reminder**. When communicating in email about a student, please only use the students' SSID. Never include both a student's name and SSID.
- Making Changes to Students in the MSAA System for the math and ELA alternate assessments. Districts
 MUST send changes for MSAA to <u>DOEassessment@state.sd.us</u>. They are not automatic. This includes if you
 receive a new student or if a student leaves.
- Accommodation Tip: Calculator reminder. Students in grades 6-8 and 11 are to use the calculator embedded within the testing platform and are NOT to use a handheld calculator. The only students allowed a handheld calculator are those needing a talking or braille calculator (which is an accommodations). Students in grades 3-5 are not to use any calculator as it goes against the constructs of what is being assessed. Please contact Beth.Schiltz@state.sd.usd if you have any questions.
