Download MSAA Test Results before Sept. 5, 2025

South Dakota ELA-Alternate and Math-Alternate spring 2025 results are currently available in the MSAA System. District Test Coordinators must download test results for students in their district **before Sept. 5, 2025 at 5:00 p.m. CT**. Districts are federally required to provide results of individual student state assessment performance to parents. Please print and send MSAA results to parents and share with Test Administrators as soon as possible. The 2025 Score Report Interpretation Guide and MSAA Parent Guides per grade level on the Alternate Assessment Website can also be shared with parents.
