## **Accessing the Perkins Report Card**

The Perkins Report Card is available in two locations:

**Option A: The public may access the Public Perkins Report Card by the end of January of each year at this** <u>location</u>. Simply enter your district's name in the search box and then select Career Tech Ed on the far right.




**Option B: District leaders may access the Private Perkins Report Card within SD-STARS.** This is a secured data system which allows districts to view unsuppressed student data including student demographic information and performance indicator data. Data is updated annually the first week of January for districts to preview prior to the public release of the Perkins Report Card as mentioned above.


- District personnel with District Accountability already assigned to them within SD-STARS already have access to the Perkins Report Card.

The second section of the Perkins Report Card displays the number of students in each Career Cluster. This section is available for both concentrators and participants.



Perkins V has established performance expectations for approved CTE programs. This section of the Perkins Report Card gives an overview of the district's performance.

Select the **Expectations** button to view the expected levels of performance.
