Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Allows individuals to be certified to teach Driver's Education and sign off on completion of the state-approved driver education course. Does not require a teaching certificate.
Duration of Certificate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Five years Permit expires June 30th.
Applicant Eligibility Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Completion of an approved suicide awareness and prevention training At least 21 years of age High school diploma or equivalent No traffic-related driver's license court suspensions or revocations within the preceding 36 months No convictions for traffic violations that carry a mandatory suspension or revocation of the driver's license within the preceding 36 months No convictions for traffic violations causing a fatal traffic collision No convictions for driving with a revoked or suspended license or driving under the influence of alcohol or a controlled substance within the past 5 years

Endorsements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limited to Driver's Education courses
Renewal Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> 3 continuing education credits (45 clock hours of training) No traffic-related convictions (same as initial certificate) Complete an approved suicide awareness and prevention training.
