Description	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Designed to allow districts flexibility in the areas of art, dance, drama, and music when district is unable to hire a certified teacher. Intended for, but not limited to, rural districts.
Duration of Certificate	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> One year
Applicant Eligibility Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> High school diploma or equivalent Minimum of 5 years of occupational experience in performing arts field in which the permit is requested Completion of an approved suicide awareness and prevention training
Fees	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> \$25
District Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Provide documentation district/school is unable to hire a certified teacher Submit performing artist verification form to South Dakota Department of Education, which identifies position to be held by applicant Provide mentor teacher to assist applicant During each renewal, district must submit form to the department recommending applicant for renewal, based on documented performance
Endorsements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> Limited to areas of art, dance, drama, and music
Renewal Requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> .50 continuing education credits (8 clock hours of training) \$25 for 1-year renewal certificate Complete an approved suicide awareness and prevention training.
