Verbs Defined:

Describe: explain in words

Key terms defined:

Data: facts and figures from which conclusions can be drawn

Simple graphs: graphs using real objects (buttons, M&Ms, etc.)

Pictographs: graphs using pictures to show and compare information

Teacher Speak:

Students are able to describe (explain in words) data represented in simple graphs (using real objects) and pictographs.

Student Speak:

- I can tell what the pictures in a graph mean.
- I can answer questions by looking at information in a graph.
- I can tell which group on the graph has the most.
