Challenges JAG-SD Students Face to Graduation

Economically disadvantaged as defined by public assistance, TANF, or free lunch **76%**

Having inadequate or no work experience **69%**

Has experienced bullying, cyber bullying, or harassment in or out of school **51%**

Lacks motivation or maturity to pursue education or career goals **50%**

37% Family environment not conducive to education or career goals

21% Father did not graduate from high school

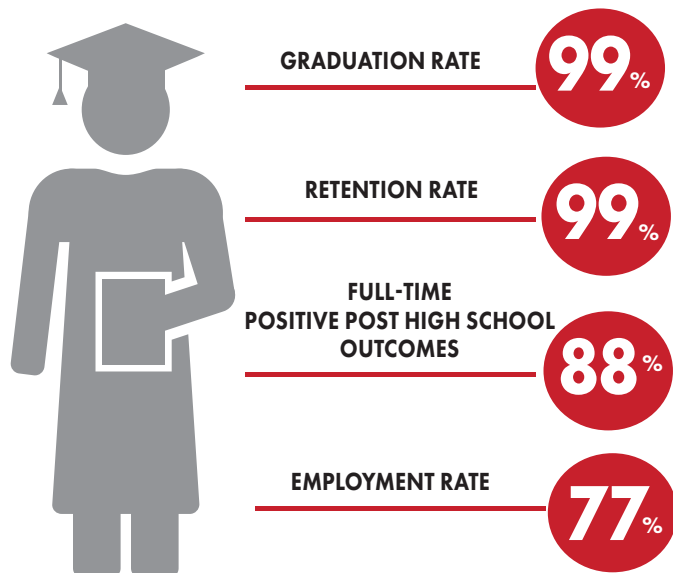
20% Mother did not graduate from high school
