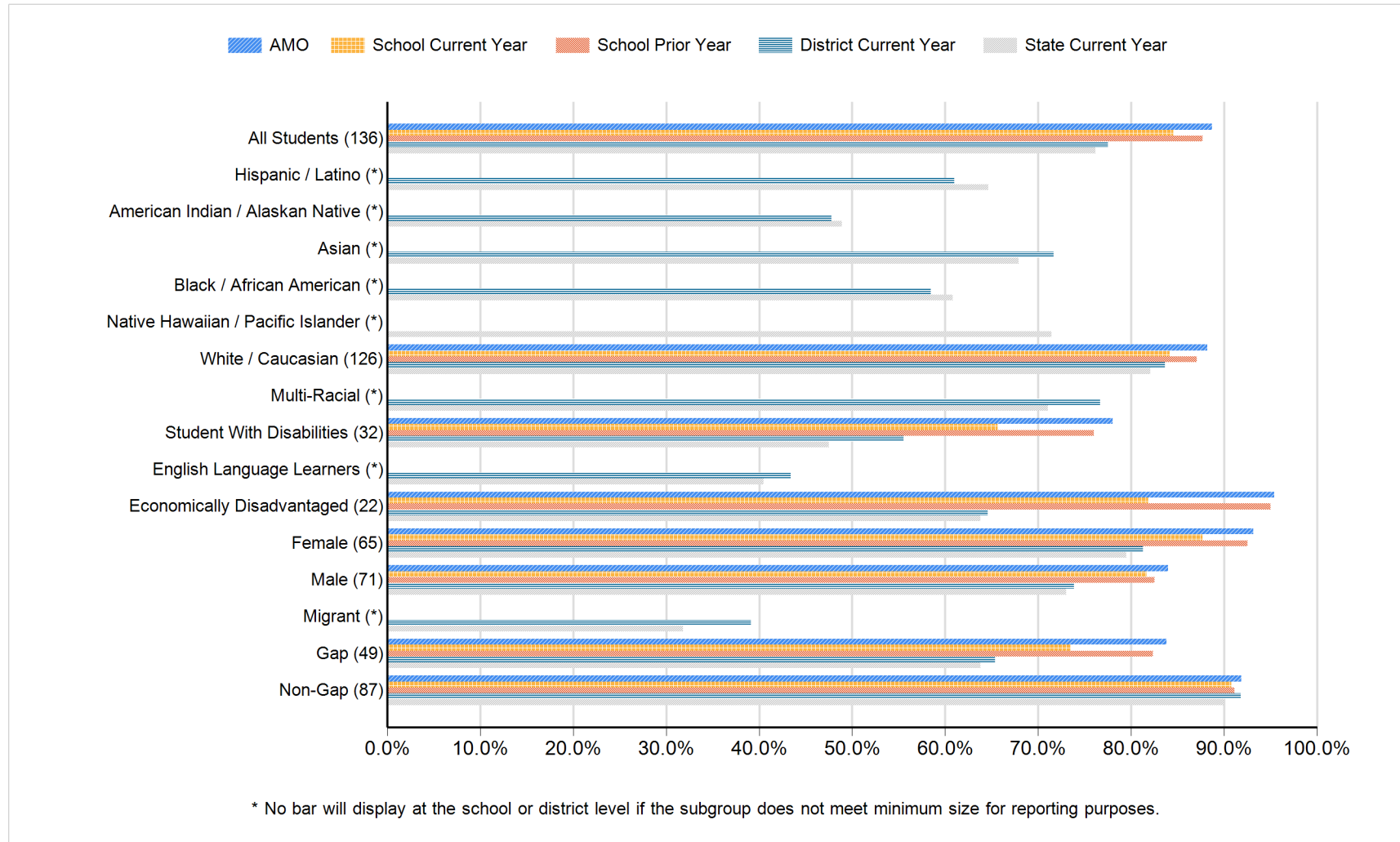
Student Population

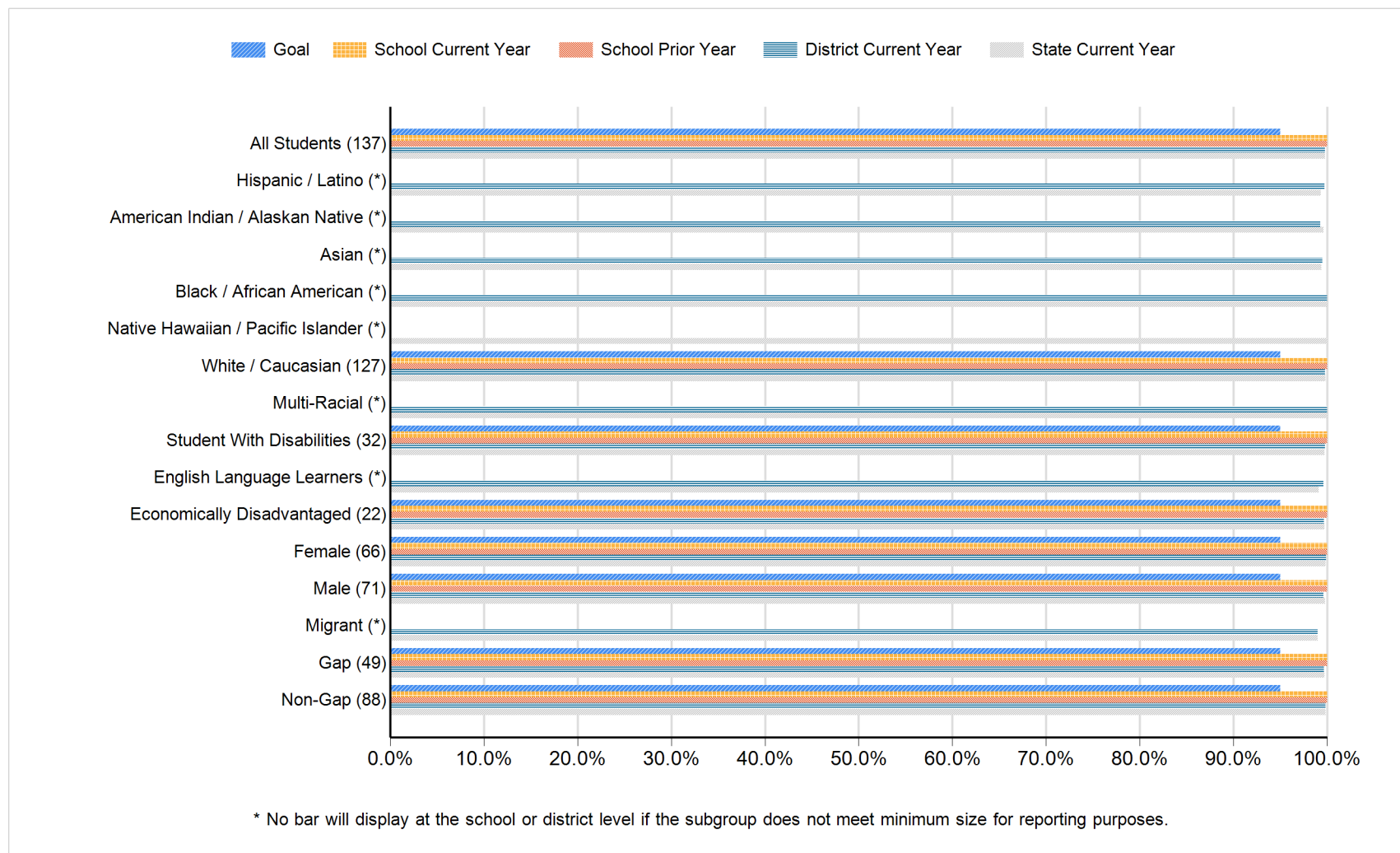

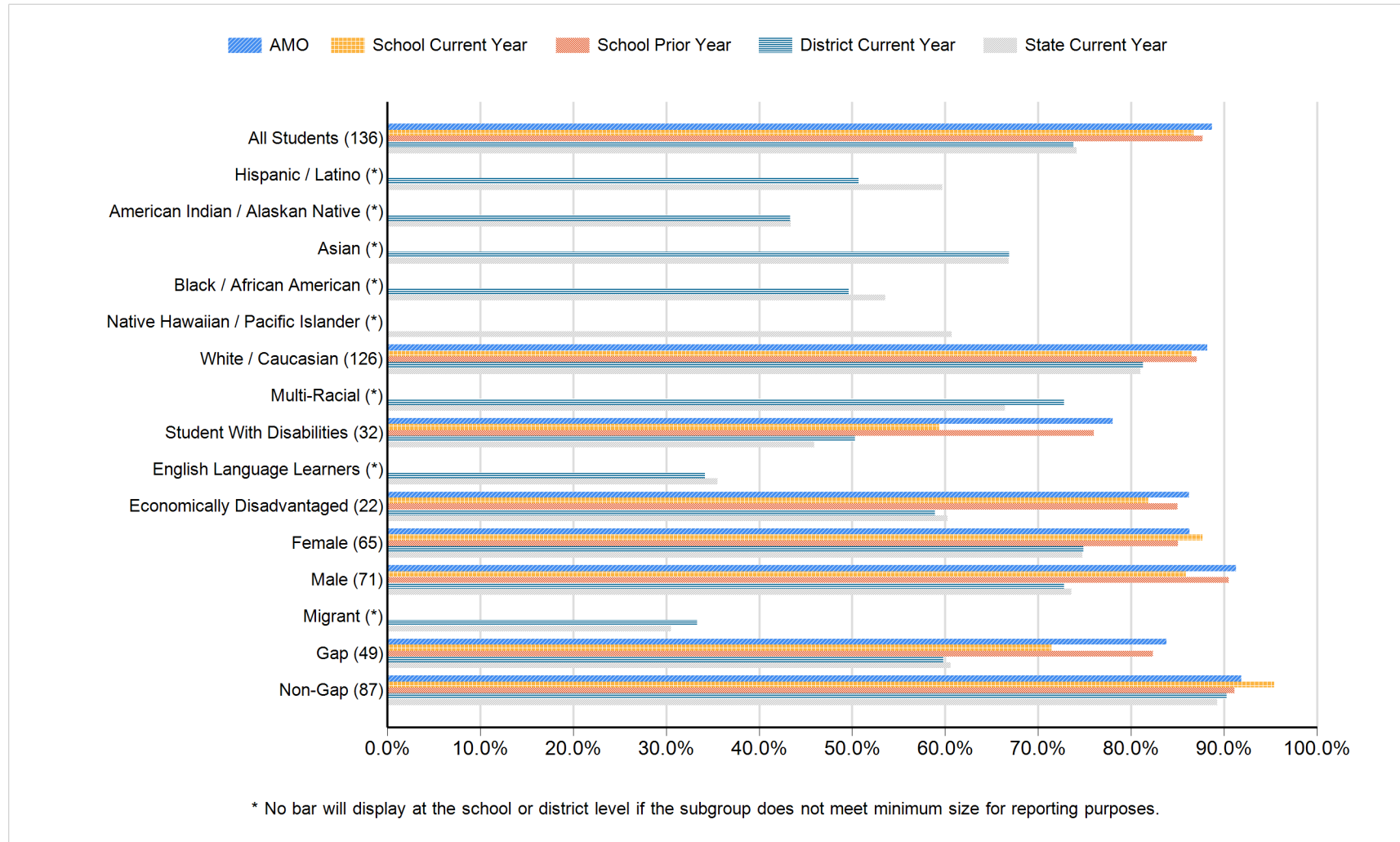

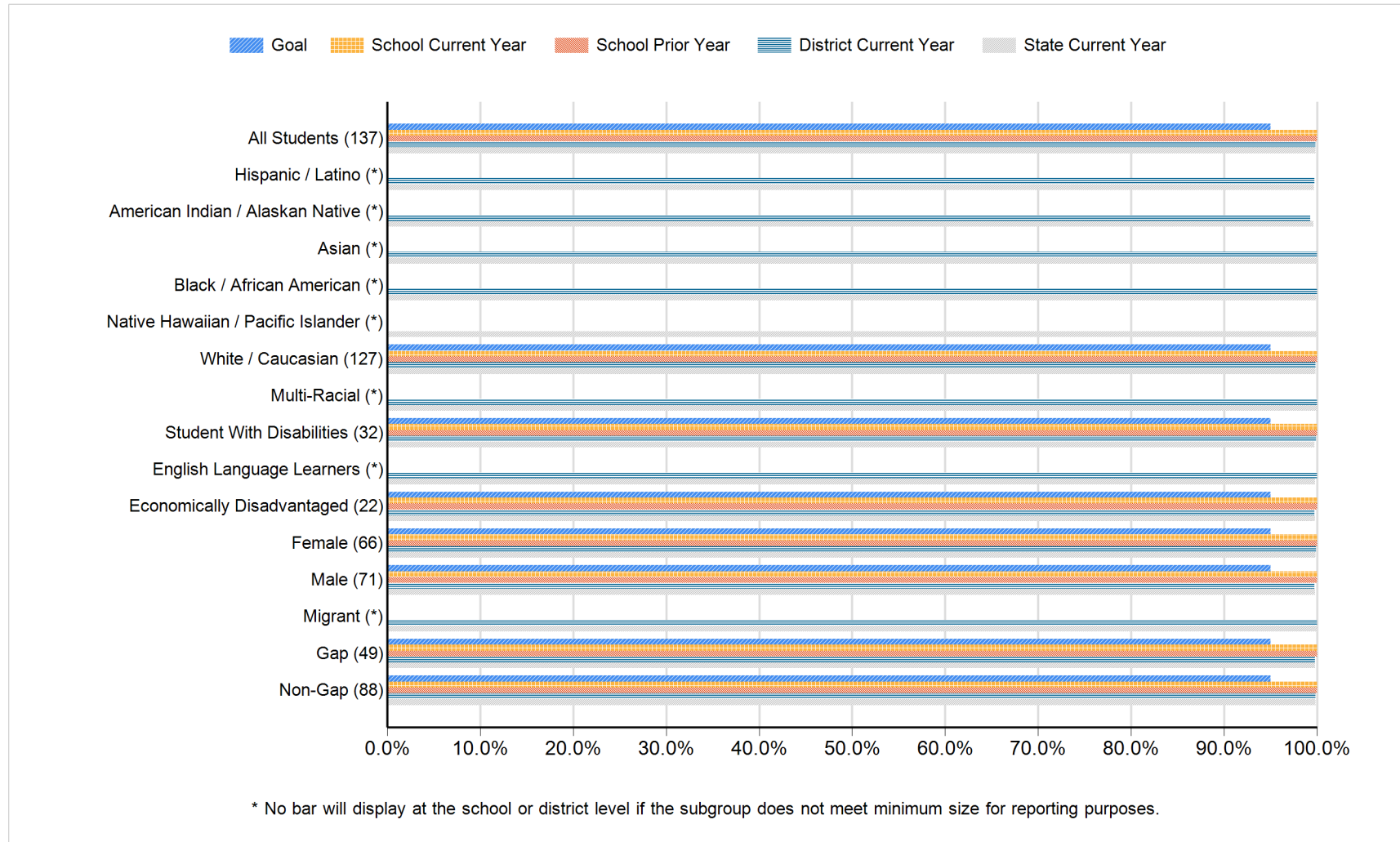

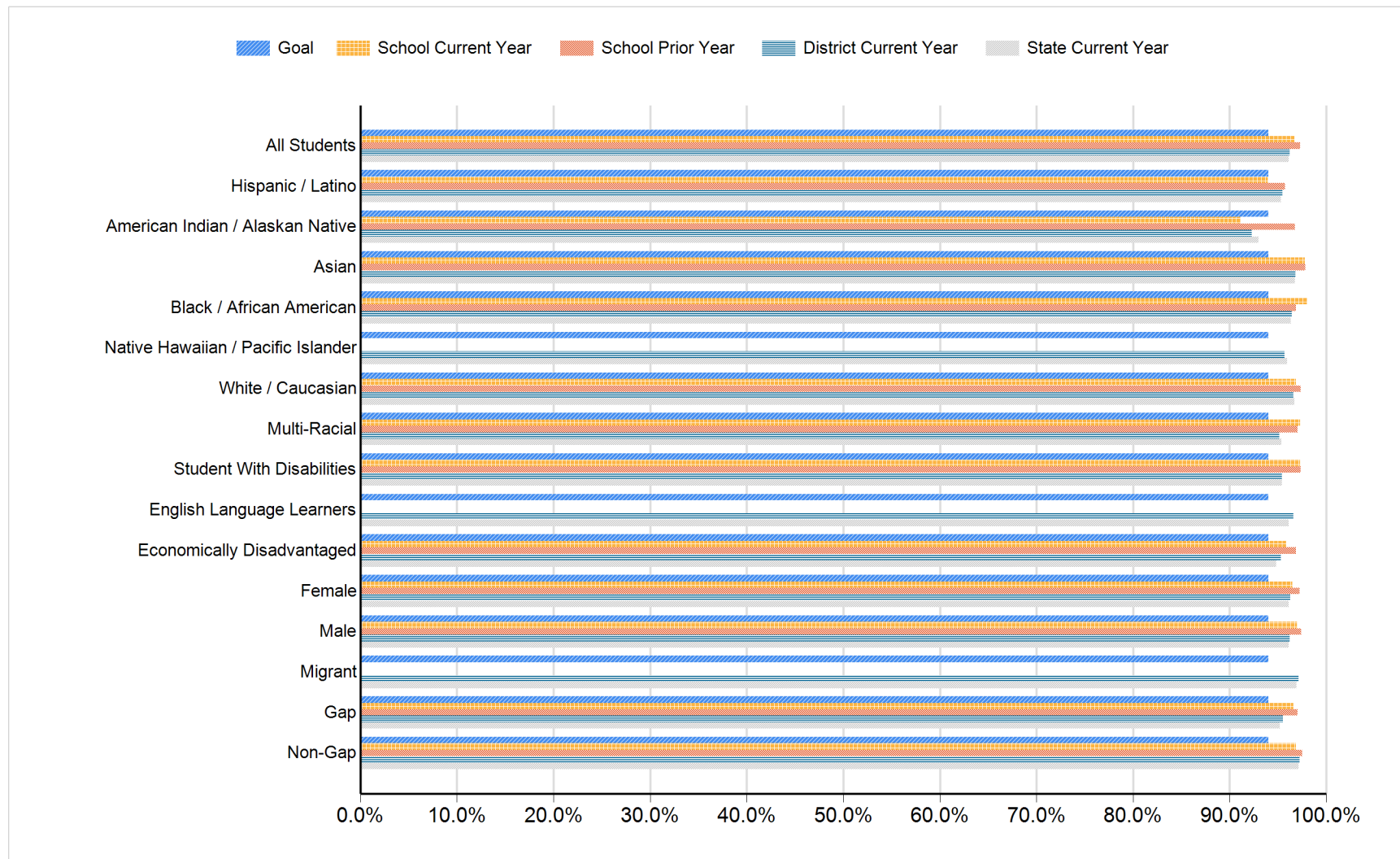

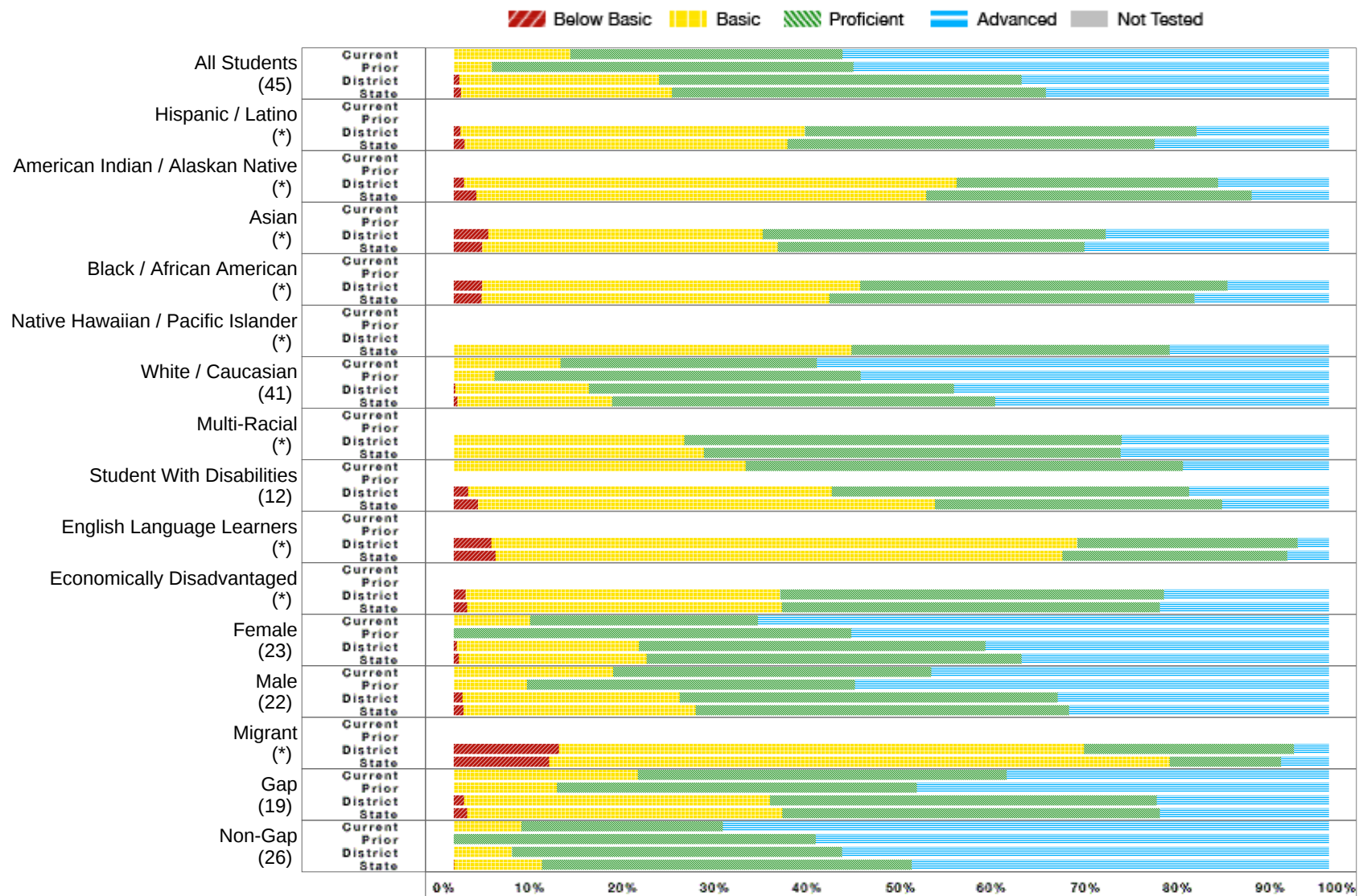
